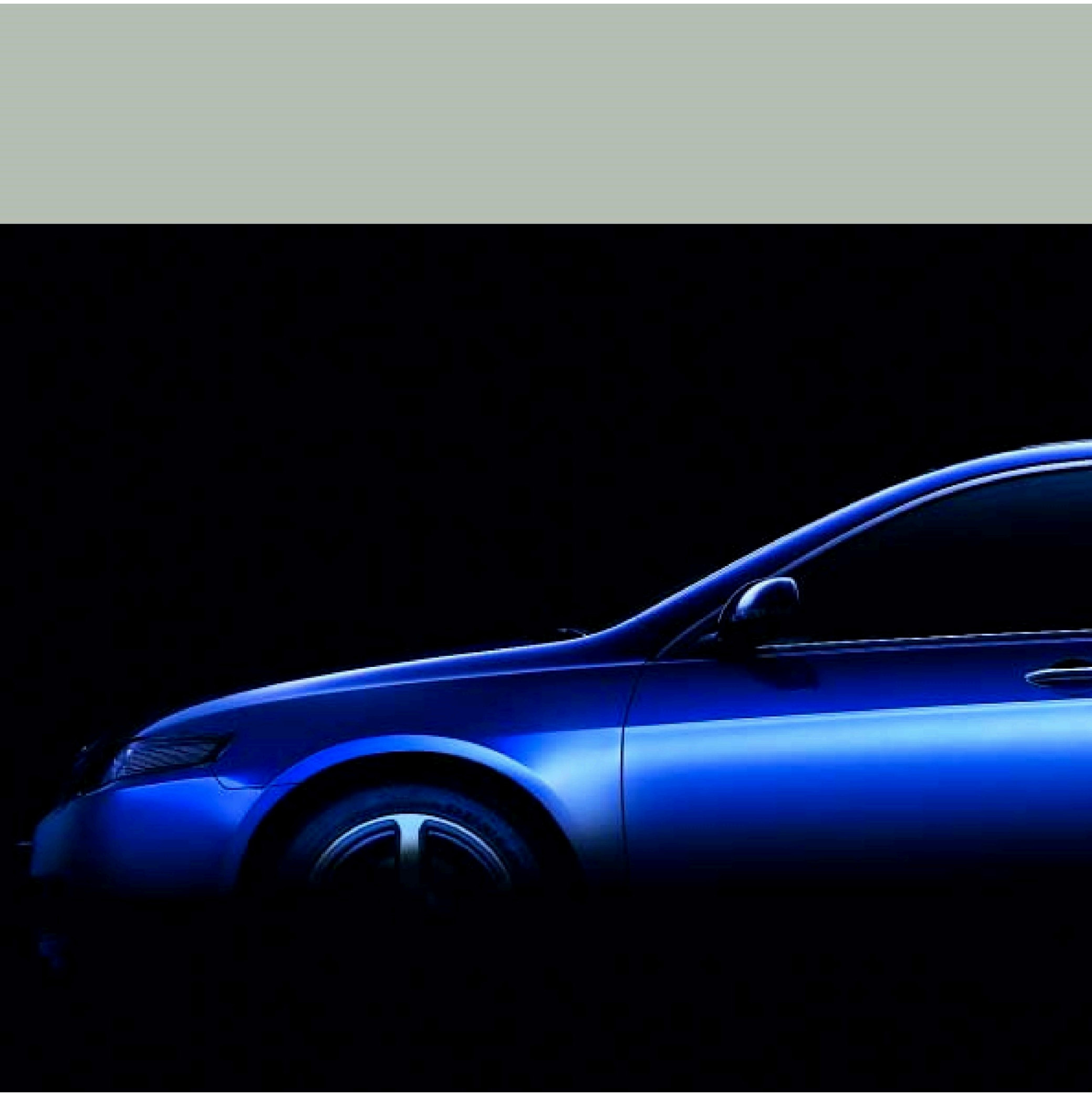


# The New Accord





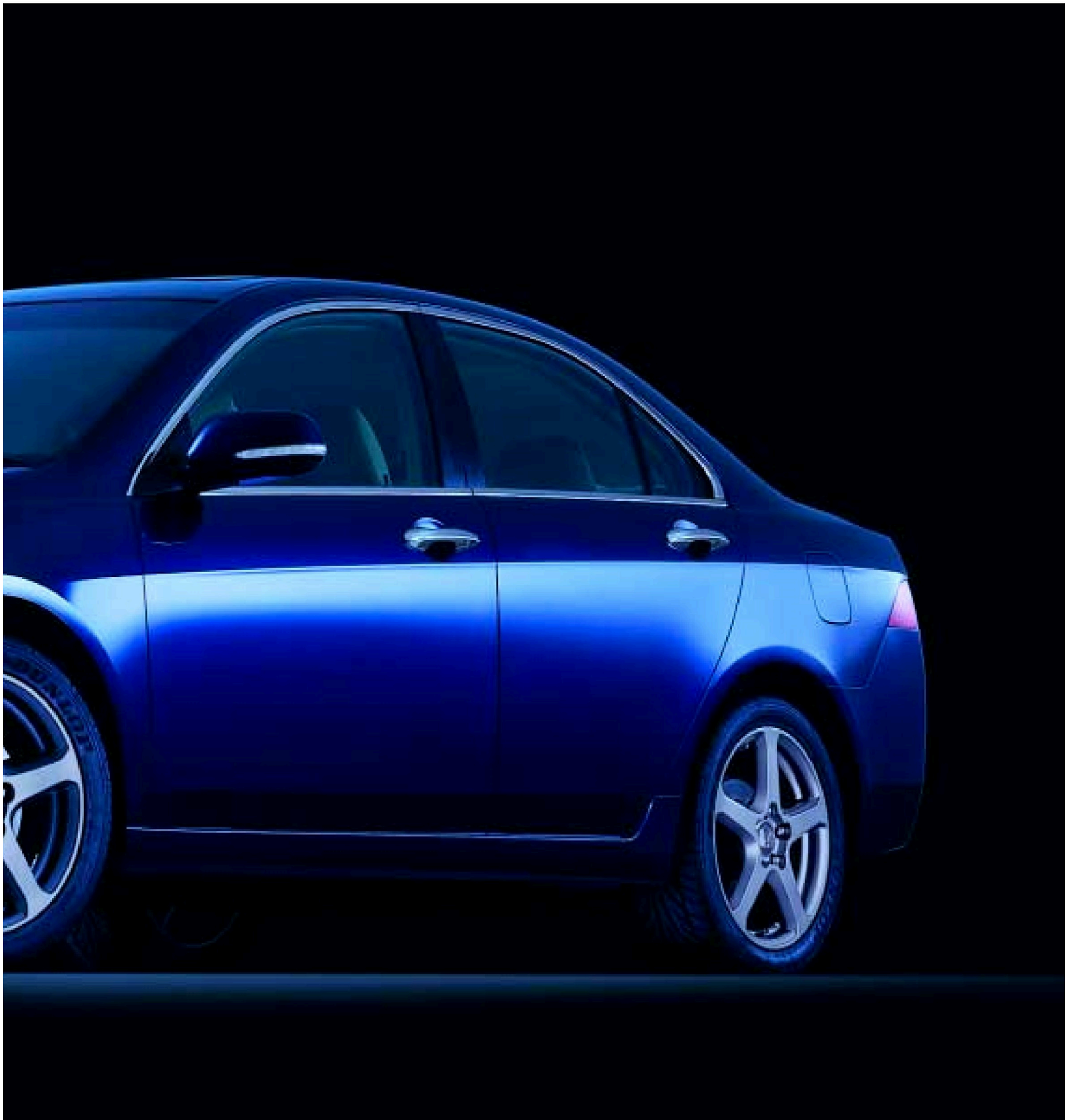
**?Do you believe in the power of dreams**

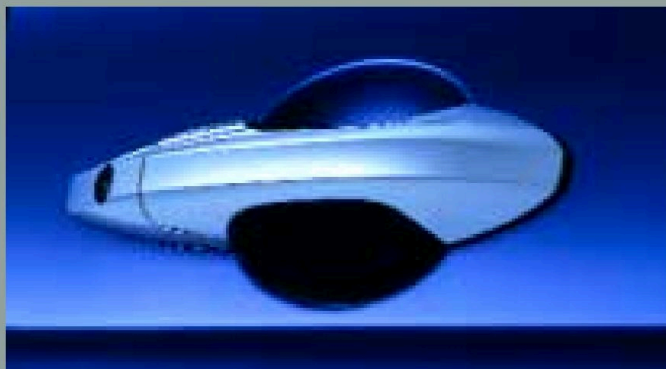

**?Does lowest drag co-efficient ( $C_d=0.26$ ) of any car in its class mean anything to you**

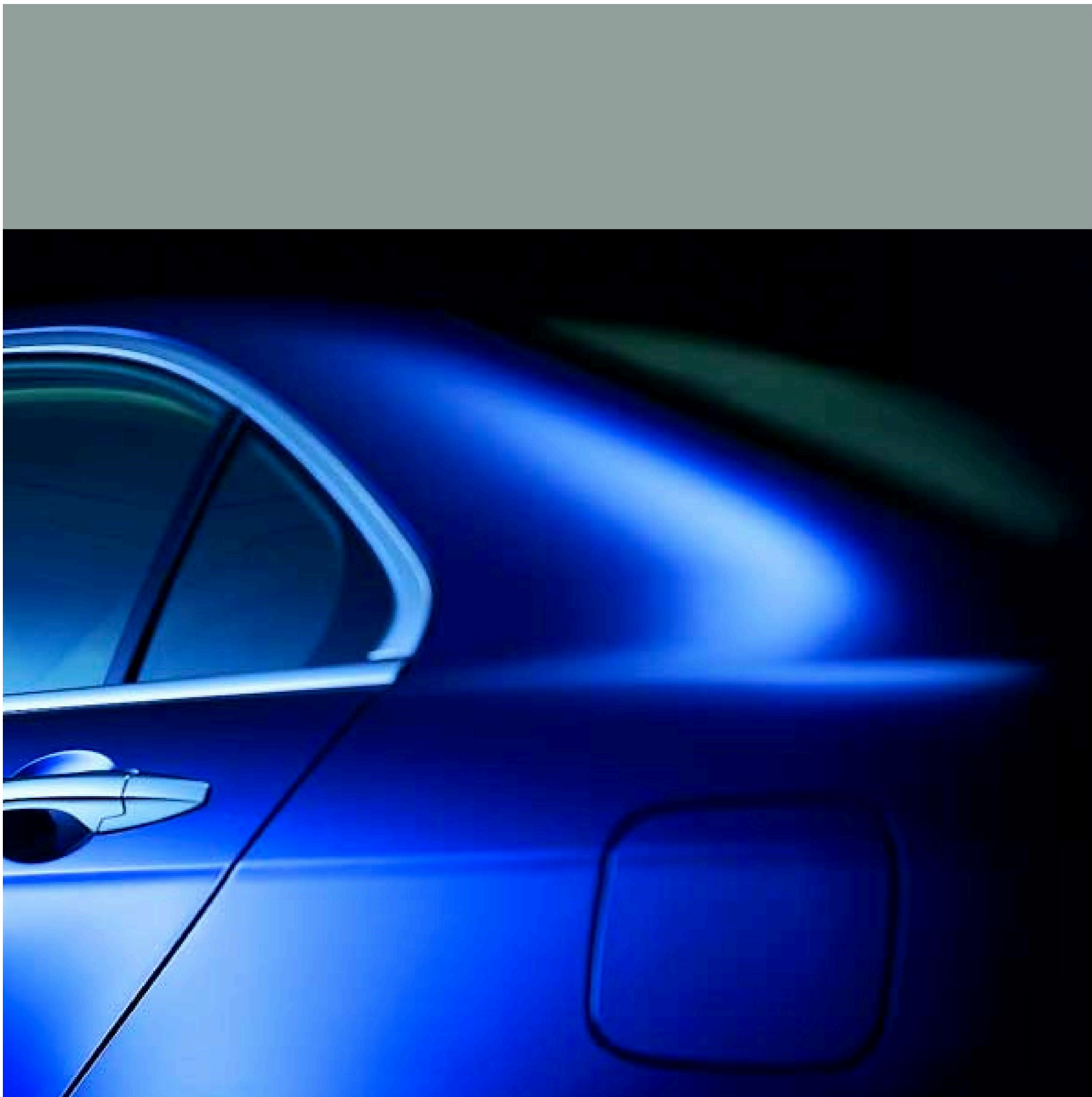
How about this?

Not so far as we know. But indicators. Now those things speak loud and clear. And the more visible they are, the safer the drive. So why not put them on the wing mirrors?





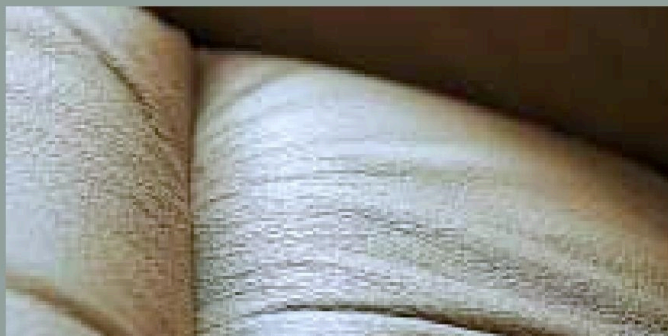


### **?Why can't intelligence be fitted as standard**

We've added a multi-function steering wheel with both cruise and audio controls. We've also fitted a cutting edge touch screen satellite navigation system to guide you quickly and safely to your destination. And talking about safety, the Accord has the biggest curtain airbags in a car of this class.

This exhilarating switch is controlled electronically, providing a smooth yet rapid response to changes in your driving demands. It all adds up to breathtaking performance. Yet both our 2.0 and 2.4 litre engines exceed emission standards due to be enforced in 2005, making them some of Europe's cleanest, most efficient and powerful engines.

As well as incredible engine performance, there are also loads of other features to make driving more enjoyable.

The rigid chassis dynamics – inspired by racing wishbone suspension – makes for precise, agile handling. We've also added innovative new drive by wire technology on the 2.4 litre engine to give it an even faster throttle response. This allows the engine control management to interpret out your driving style and use the engines ability to the full. And because of the Accords multi-channel anti-lock breaking and Vehicle Stability Assistance system, you know the car will optimise road holding in all conditions.
