Honda believe that maximum interior space is vital for both comfort and safety. And to achieve this the engine is mounted transversely, freeing extra interior space for the passengers.

The hatchback features a folding rear seat which extends the capacity of the boot area from 12.95 cu ft to a massive 28.69 cu ft.

Superb handling is ensured by front wheel drive, rack and pinion steering which is light and positive, and all round independent

suspension. Of course the front brakes are discs,

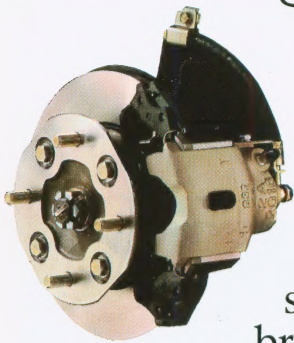
but Honda doesn't make do with fitting superb brakes.

There is also a pressure control valve built into the system to inhibit rear wheel

lock-up during sudden or heavy

braking.

All these thoughtful touches combine to offer you a motoring experience which is a stimulating complement to your own driving skills.





So much of everyday life is far from relaxing. The constant rush, noise levels, traffic queues: all part of life in the eighties.

Honda's engineers were determined to provide a car that was not merely comfortable but

designed with such an attention to detail that it engendered a feeling of genuinely relaxed well being. And how superbly they succeeded with the Accord.

First the big things: the seats are painstakingly designed to offer the body un-

obtrusive support. The front seats recline, and have head restraints. There is an AM radio as standard equipment. The windows contain very slightly tinted glass, reducing

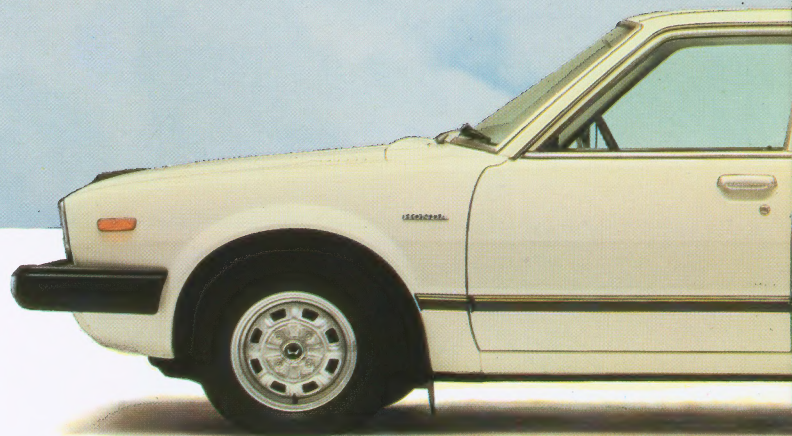

glare and maintaining a stable environment. The standard of finish is impeccable.

Then the small touches; the magazine pockets in the front seat backs, the thoughtful provision of a coin box in the facia and the illumination of the glove box.

All these typically Honda standard "extras" greatly contribute to the comfort of driver and passengers alike.





The achievement of genuine operational economy becomes ever more important, and in the Accord Honda have succeeded in producing a car which makes solid contributions to balancing your motoring budget.

By designing the engine to operate at 8.4:1 compression ratio, Honda allow you to run the Accord on 2 star petrol: an increasingly important aspect these days. Furthermore the Accord's body is very efficient aerodynamically, so it needs less fuel to cruise at any given speed than less thoughtful designs. The manual gearbox option has overdrive fifth ratio, further reducing fuel consumption at cruising speeds.





And maintenance costs are kept to a minimum too. Contained in the speedometer is a set of warning systems which tell you when to rotate the tyres, when to change the

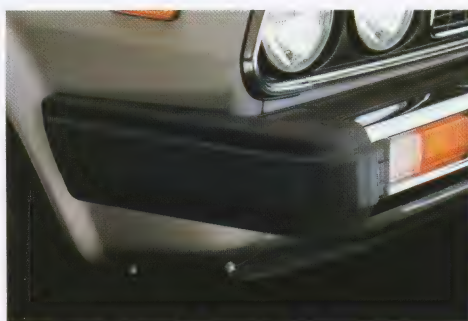

engine oil and when to renew the oil filter.



Lastly, the Accord's body is protected by wrap-around bumpers, and rubber fenders along the entire

sides of the car. So you are far less likely to suffer the expense of minor knocks and scrapes. All in all the Accord looks after your pennies with the greatest care.

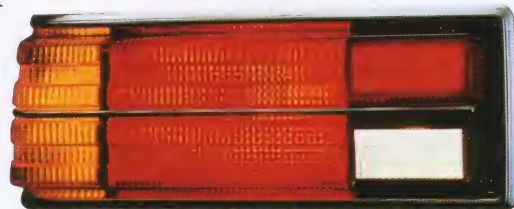




Whilst aiming to provide a real value-for-money motor car, Honda were determined to incorporate all the latest safety features in the new Accord.

Furthermore Honda have re-designed the rear light cluster, making you more



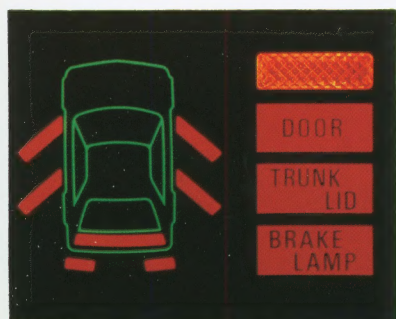
visible to other road users at night. Another thoughtful contribution to safety is the provision of a cluster of warning lights in the
