
Its engine is simple and well designed. That keeps maintenance costs low.


It runs so efficiently that it meets 1975 Federal emission standards (except California) without a catalytic converter or complicated exhaust gas recirculation system.

Four-wheel independent suspension to help keep tires in contact with the road for better control.


An engine which isn't only economical, it's as quick as you'll ever need a car to be.


