




Tough Technology.

Jeep ruggedness and Jeep power—two traits that lie at the very heart of Cherokee and make it a vehicle of exceptional ability.

Cherokee ruggedness begins with Jeep's sophisticated four-wheel drive systems—technology that's backed by over 45 years of experience in off-roading. Standard on four-wheel drive Cherokee (NA Limited) is Jeep's part-time four-wheel drive system—Command-Trac®. With on-the-fly shifting between two- and four-wheel drive, this system makes Cherokee especially adaptable to varying road and weather conditions.

For full-time four-wheel drive, there's optional Selec-Trac® (standard Limited). Once the new five-position shifter is set in "4 Full Time," the vehicle

will operate indefinitely in four-wheel drive—without excessive wear of drivetrain components or loss of fuel economy. With this system, an open differential in the transfer case itself


allows torque to be distributed automatically to both front and rear axles. And no matter what the weather or driving conditions, Selec-Trac's convenient on-the-fly shifting between two- and four-wheel drive ensures that you're always prepared.

In addition, both Command-Trac and Selec-Trac feature a four-wheel drive low range. A shift to "4 Lo" directs maximum power to front and rear axles, providing you with the needed traction under the most demanding conditions.

This choice of four-wheel drive systems is joined by an optional Trac-Lok rear differential that automatically distributes torque to the rear wheel that has traction and thus helps reduce wheel spin caused by the loss of traction in the other wheel.

Cherokee powertrains provide ruggedness and durability to meet the toughest driving situations. Standard power is a 2.5 litre 4-cylinder engine with throttle-body injection. With this system, electronic sensors automatically adjust ignition

and fuel injection timing, ensuring precise fuel delivery.

In addition, the 2.5 litre delivers 121 horsepower @ 5,250 rpm and 141 foot-pounds of torque @ 3,250 rpm, making it the most powerful standard 4-cylinder engine in its class—and one that provides you with an impressive balance between performance and fuel efficiency.

For even more power, there's Jeep's optional 4.0 litre 6-cylinder engine—the Power-Tech Six. Standard on Cherokee Limited, this engine provides 177 horsepower @ 4,500 rpm and 224 foot-pounds of torque @ 2,500 rpm, making it, too, the most powerful engine in its class.


The advanced design of the Power-Tech Six includes sequential multi-port electronic fuel injection and integrated ignition for performance and fuel efficiency, as well as smoothness and durability.

These two engines are joined by a variety of transmissions. There's a 4-speed manual floor shift (standard Base and Pioneer), optional


5-speed manual overdrive floor shift (standard Chief and Laredo), and optional 4-speed automatic overdrive floor shift (standard Limited), which features electronic shift control and a lock-up torque converter for improved highway fuel economy, plus two shift schedules—"Comfort" for normal driving and "Power" for times when increased acceleration is needed.

Roadability.


Cherokee's ability to perform equally well both on road and off is due in great part to its tough Quadra-Link® suspension—a system that tackles the rigors of the road with ease and maintains riding comfort.

With this unique solid axle system, four locating arms keep the axle at its optimum position, while a front track bar controls lateral motion. Durable coil springs absorb road shock and provide more than five inches of suspension travel. In addition, front and rear stabilizer bars control body sway, and dual-action shock absor-

ers further contribute to ride smoothness. With Quadra-Link, you're assured of precise steering and handling, as well as a comfortable ride—qualities you'll really appreciate when the going gets tough.


Cherokee's potential is enhanced even more by standard front disc/rear drum brakes, optional power steering (standard Laredo and Limited), and an optional 20.2-gallon extra-capacity fuel tank (standard Limited).

If serious off-roading is what you have in mind for Cherokee, there's an optional

heavy-duty suspension (NA Limited) that features heavy-duty springs and shocks—front and rear. Plus, an optional skid plate package provides pro-

tective skid plates for the fuel tank, transfer case, and front suspension.

And for the true off-road enthusiast, there's an optional Off-Road Package (NA Limited) that features high-pressure gas shocks (front and rear), stiffer front and rear springs and jounce bumpers, P225/75R15 Goodyear Wrangler® OWL all-terrain tires (including full-size spare), and a larger front stabilizer bar. Also included are protective skid plates for the fuel tank, transfer case, and front suspension, along with tow hooks (2 front, 1 rear).

Cherokee's rugged mechanics find some tough support from the body itself, resulting in a vehicle of exceptional strength and durability.


Cherokee features UniFrame construction—an integrated frame and body unit that is lightweight, for improved acceleration and handling, yet strong enough to

support the drivetrain and payload as they undergo the forces of driving. In addition, UniFrame is an extremely rigid structure that resists weight transfer in the suspension and helps maintain precise handling. And with Quadra-Link, it allows Cherokee to boast 8.8 inches of running ground clearance—more than any domestic 4x4 in its class.

To protect the body itself and ensure its lasting tough-

ness, Cherokee receives extensive corrosion protection treatments. Galvanized steel is used on all body panels, and before priming, all surfaces are cleansed in a phosphate bath.

To resist corrosion in joints and seams, sealants are applied, and the entire body is then dipped in a primer coat that is electrostatically bonded to the sheet metal. A second primer coat is applied, along with a urethane coating on



the lower bodyside that protects against stone damage.

Further protection during everyday driving is ensured by the undercoating of the chassis and inside doors, as well as by the use of plastic on front fender liners, fender flares, front grille, and rear liftgate. When

Comfort Zones.

One look at the Cherokee interior, and it's easy to see that this vehicle's ability to perform doesn't stop with what's under the hood. Instead, you'll find that Cherokee's unerring attention to comfort, convenience, and driving functions is a perfect match for its rugged Jeep character.



Cherokee comforts begin with front rocker/recliner bucket seats (NA Base) with adjustable see-through headrests (Chief and Laredo only) and a folding rear seat with removable seat cushion—all covered in fabric or vinyl, depending on the model. Cherokee Laredo interior shown.



For added convenience and a touch of luxury, there's an optional leather-wrapped, three-spoke sport steering wheel (standard Laredo and Limited; NA Base).



Cherokee seats are designed to provide outstanding comfort for both driver and passengers.

Cherokee's commitment to total comfort and convenience begins with unique front rocker/recliner bucket seats (NA Base) with adjustable headrests and a rear folding seat with removable seat cushion. Or, you can choose the optional six-way power front bucket seats (standard Limited; NA Base). All seats are covered in leather on the Limited, or in fabric or vinyl, depending on the model.

In addition, there are standard front and rear grab rails for

easy entry and exit. And for convenient storage of small items, there's a utility bin below the locking glove box, which also serves as a storage area. A mini-console is standard, or you can select the optional full console (standard Laredo and Limited) that includes armrest, storage box, rear ashtray, and rear heating and cooling ducts.


All passengers will enjoy Cherokee's standard tinted glass and climate control system with power ventilation and side window defrosters. For further convenience, there are options such as air conditioning, power door locks and windows, and for a hint of open-air riding, a sunroof (NA Base).






Further driver conveniences include optional cruise control (standard Limited), tachometer, tilt steering column (standard Limited), and leather-wrapped steering wheel (standard Laredo and Limited). And for added safety, there are optional fog lamps, power door locks and windows (NA Base), and remote-control locks (all standard Limited).








Practical Pleasures.

The ability to travel anywhere, anytime, with confidence and ease—that's the freedom of Cherokee. Add to this an especially high level of versatility and choice, and you've got an exceptional vehicle for both on road and off.



Standard stowage bins on the door panels (NA Base) are especially convenient for maps and other small items.



With the rear seat folded, Cherokee offers 71.8 cubic feet of cargo space—more than any domestic 4x4 in its class—and it's easily accessible from the swing-up liftgate.


Cherokee is the only domestic vehicle in its class with room for five adults. This is due to its long wheelbase—the longest in its class—and to the placement of the rear seats *in front* of the rear wheel-houses, which provides room for three adults. Also contributing to rear seat passenger comforts are pedestal-style front seats that provide increased rear legroom and lower as they're adjusted rearward for increased front passenger headroom.

From spacious and comfortable seating, Cherokee goes on to boast an outstanding capacity for cargo. With the rear seat in place, there's a generous 35.7 cubic feet of space. Or, you can fold the rear seat for 71.8 cubic feet of cargo room—more than any domestic 4x4 in its class. And with the optional swing-away tire carrier outside (NA Limited), there's even more room for cargo.

Further convenience and hauling ease are provided by standard cargo area tie-down hooks (NA Base), skid strips on the cargo floor (Laredo and Limited only), and an optional retractable cargo cover (standard Laredo and Limited). Plus, you'll find that the cargo area, rear seatback, and liftgate are carpeted (optional Base). And


there's an optional roof rack (standard Limited). All of this enables Cherokee to boast a maximum payload of 1,150 pounds, making it an exceptionally versatile vehicle.

From comfort and style and versatility to ruggedness and strength and performance, Cherokee delivers. And you can be sure that whatever demands the road makes, Cherokee is ready to meet them.



With the longest wheelbase in its class, Cherokee is also the only domestic vehicle in its class with room for five adults, and it handles cargo with equal ease. 


