



The Executive L and Cartier L models come equipped with illuminated **rear passenger vanity mirrors**—proving Town Car's luxury isn't just for the driver.




Town Car's **power-adjustable brake and accelerator pedals** allow drivers of varying heights and stature to assume the most comfortable driving positions. Pedals can travel over two inches, and the driver's preferred positions are retained in the available memory system.



The electronic fingertip speed control on Lincoln Town Car's available **wood- and leather-trimmed steering wheel** allows you to set your preferred speed without taking your eyes off the road.

An **Electronic Automatic Temperature Control** and message center provide comfort, and it conveniently allows the driver to monitor data such as outside temperature, average fuel economy, miles-to-empty and average trip speed.



Available on all 2002 Town Car models, the **Vehicle Communication System** includes a Motorola Timeport™ wireless phone. The required Sprint PCS® service plan features voice-activated name or digit dialing for hands-free use. It also enables the satellite-based Global Positioning System, which offers Safety and Security services, Route Guidance and Point of Interest Location information.



Town Car offers drivers a choice of two levels of powerful V8 engines. A **4.6-liter V8** with 220 horsepower is standard on Executive, Signature and Premium Signature models. Or for those driving enthusiasts who require a little more power under the hood, a 4.6-liter V8 with a potent 235 horsepower and dual exhaust is available.

All-Speed Traction Control helps improve Lincoln Town Car's handling and traction on a variety of slippery surfaces by electronically and automatically distributing brake pressure between the rear wheels, modulating engine torque and adjusting the ignition.

Cartier L, a long wheelbase version with 7.8 more cubic feet of passenger volume, helps improve ride characteristics. In addition to its larger interior area, Cartier L includes rear illuminated vanity mirrors, heated rear seats, a folding rear armrest with storage bin, rear seat 4-way head restraints, an electrochromic mirror with compass and other fine luxuries.

In the unlikely event of a complete coolant loss, the **fail-safe cooling system** will still allow Town Car to be driven for a short distance¹ by invoking a reduced cylinder firing sequence.

Even in bad weather, Town Car's **four-wheel disc Anti-lock Brake System** contributes to improved control during hard braking on a surprisingly wide variety of road surfaces.

Town Car is built on a **full-length ladder-type frame**. This type of construction, along with rear load-leveling air suspension, provides Town Car with additional rigidity and stability.

One of the more unexpected luxuries on Lincoln Town Car are **heated exterior mirrors**, which quickly melt away bothersome ice and snow for better visibility and enhanced safety.

Another amenity that makes Cartier Town Car so luxurious is standard **heated front seats**, which allow the driver and passenger to adjust their individual seat cushion temperature to any of five settings—an absolute must for those living in colder climates.

The available **HomeLink® Universal Transceiver** allows the Town Car driver to quickly and easily program the universal remote (engineered right into Town Car's visor) to activate a garage door plus two additional home-based devices, such as patio or driveway lights.

The highly intelligent coil-on-plug integrated **ignition system** provides dependable spark sequences while also eliminating the need for spark plug wires. Combined with platinum-tipped spark plugs, this helps make Town Car's 100,000-mile tune-up¹ interval possible.


A standard, **Remote Keyless Entry system** provides both fingertip lock activation as well as a panic button, which sets off the horn and marker lamps in case of an emergency. In addition, Town Car's autolamp feature keeps headlamps lit after the vehicle is shut off.

The **SecuriLock™** passive anti-theft system uses a specially encoded key to help protect the 2002 Lincoln Town Car against theft. If a nonencoded key or ignition bypass is detected, the ignition automatically disables itself—helping to further thwart any unsavory behavior.

Front and rear nitrogen-pressurized shock absorbers—precisely tuned to compliment the **Short- and Long-Arm front suspension**—deliver a quiet, comfortable ride, in spite of many road imperfections you might encounter while driving the 2002 Lincoln Town Car.

A wonderful match for Town Car's powerful engine, the **Watt's linkage rear suspension** improves straight-line tracking and handling. This, along with the many other fine Lincoln luxuries, makes Town Car an absolute pleasure to drive—especially over long distances.




