The engine in the Mercedes-AMG S 63 Cabriolet is built by hand in the AMG engine manufactory in accordance with the philosophy “One Man – One Engine”. The engine, hand-built by one single technician, delivers 430 kW (585 hp) and maximum torque of 900 Nm, making the AMG 5.5-liter V8 biturbo engine one of the most efficient production V8 engines in the world, based on power, torque and fuel consumption.

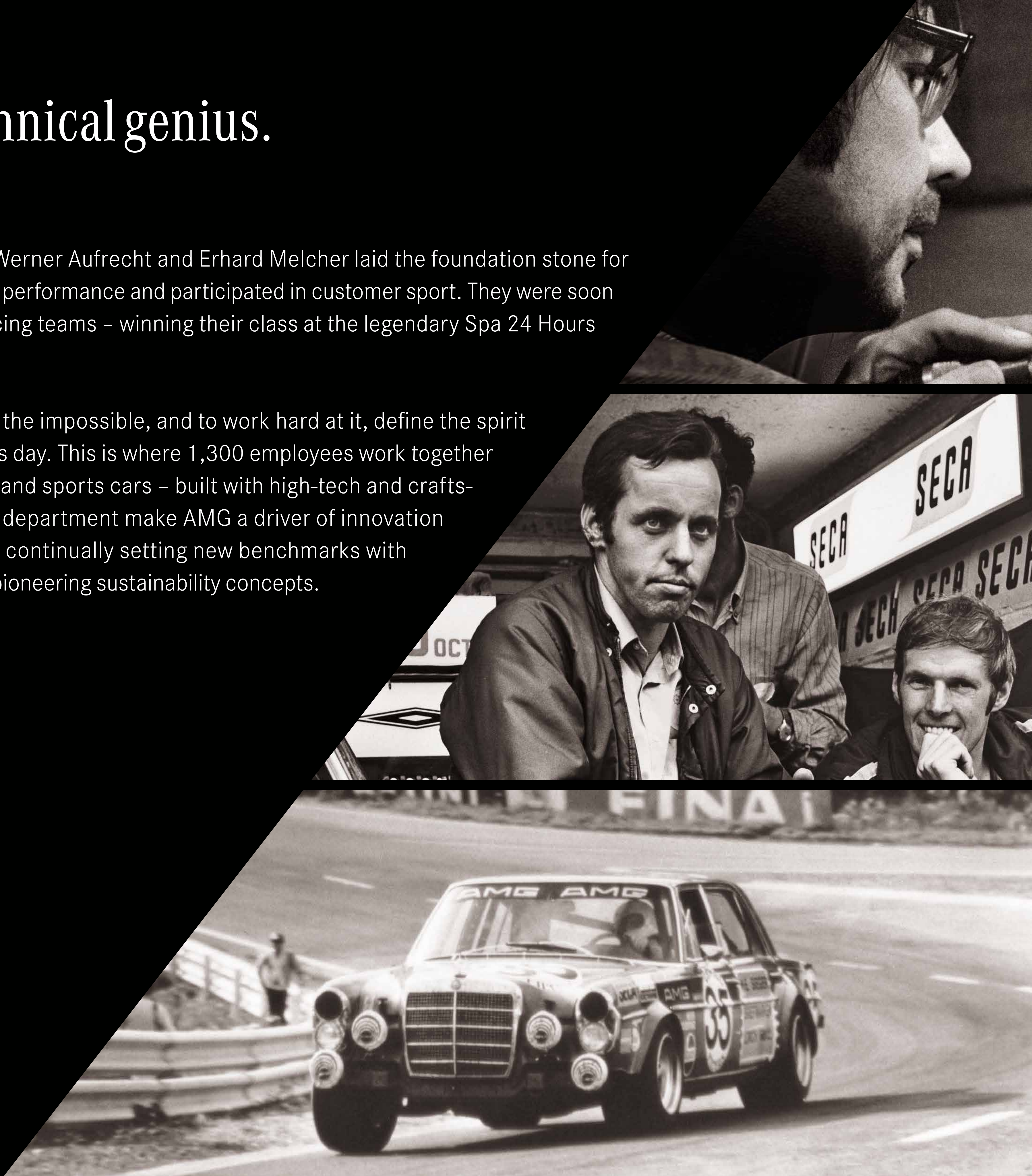




# Supremacy needs technical genius. And a home.

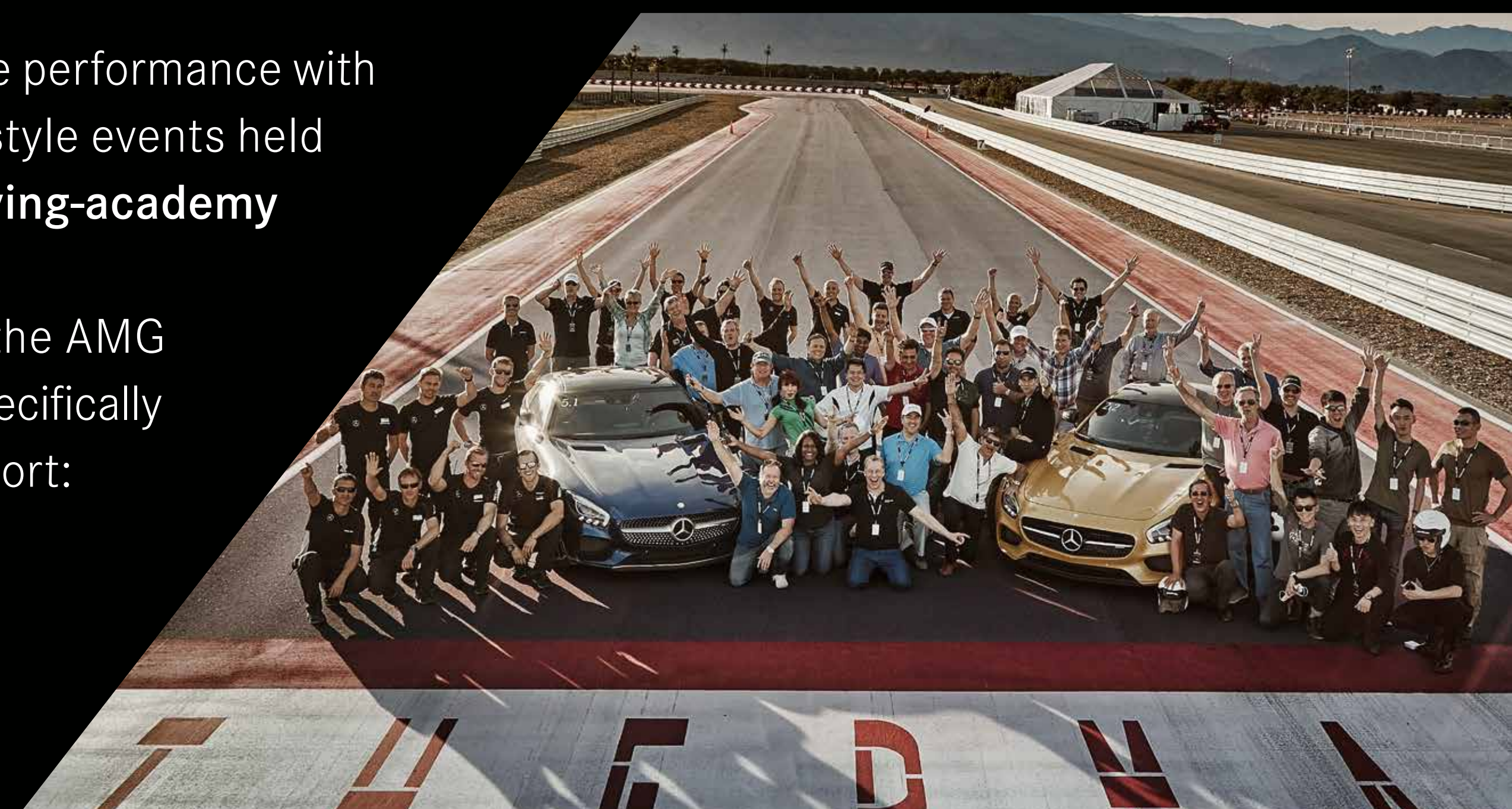
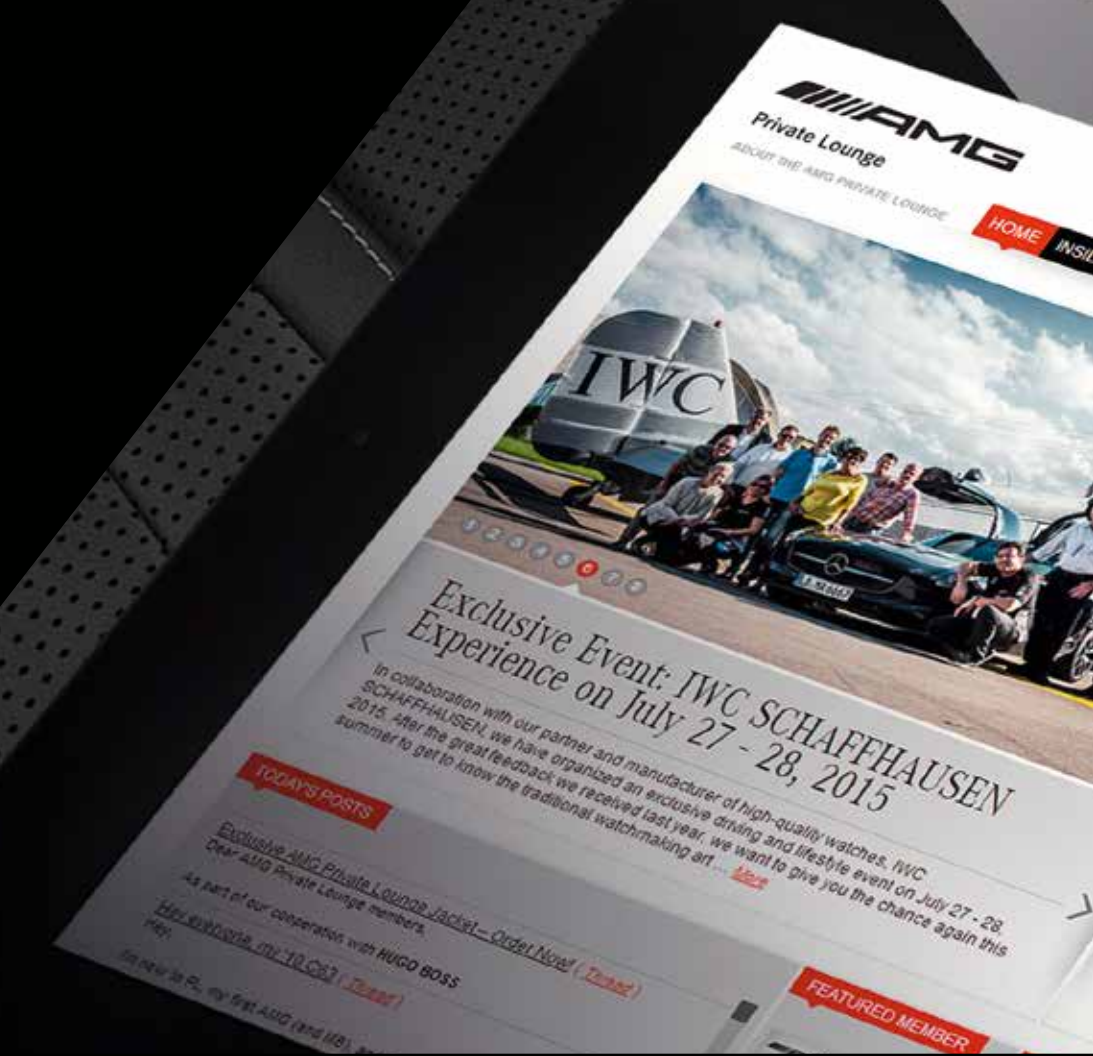
