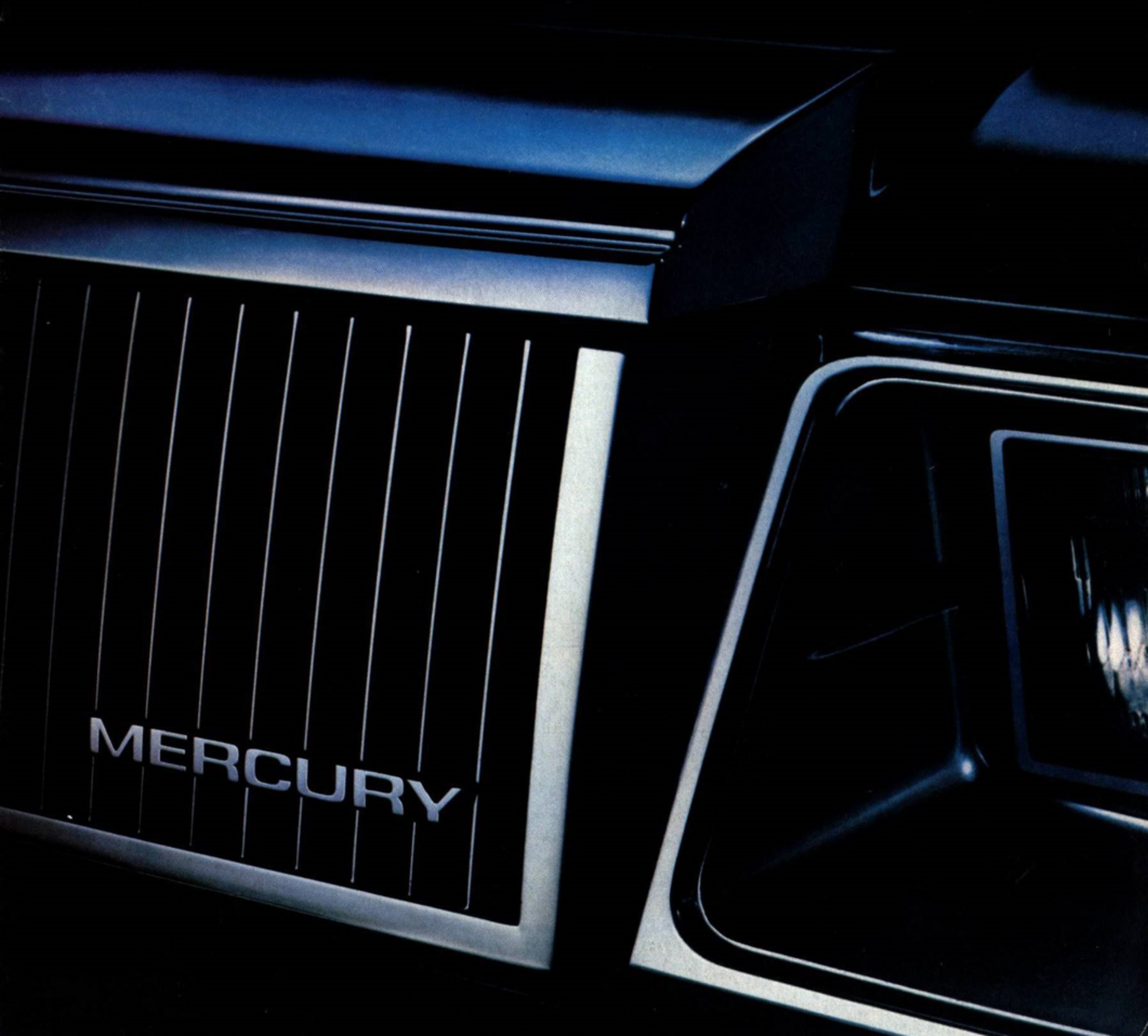

MID-SIZE MAGIC

Mercury Marquis for '83. This is Marquis as you've never known it before. Trim, yet smooth riding. Elegant, yet aerodynamic. Space-efficient, yet a full five-passenger automobile.

In short, this is a Marquis for the '80s. Born of high technology. As dedicated to quality and substance as any Marquis

before it. Carefully built to comfort you in the Marquis manner. Thoughtfully engineered to meet the concerns of contemporary drivers, while still maintaining many of the traditional values long associated with the Marquis nameplate.

The look is classic Marquis reshaped by hours of wind tunnel testing to reach new levels of aerodynamic efficiency. From the fast sloping front end to the distinctive decklid, this Marquis is as clean and fresh looking a mid-size Mercury as has ever touched pavement.

If that pavement happens to be less than smooth, relax. The ride engineers have exercised their expertise in compensating for road surface irregularities.

Sophisticated gas-pressurized struts and shocks work in conjunction with a refined coil spring suspension system to reduce harshness, while a front stabilizer

bar helps keep Marquis on track through twisting roads and tight turns.

There's also quiet to go with the smoothness, thanks to a luxury sound package. It's just one of many standard features that make the 1983 Marquis a brilliantly conceived and executed automobile worthy of both the Marquis name and heritage.

Lincoln-Mercury wouldn't have it any other way. And neither would you.

IMPORTANT APPOINTMENTS

There are many ways of looking at the interior of the new mid-size Marquis. Traditional luxury car owners will see the obvious richness and comfort of the standard Marquis Brougham seating shown above.

There's plenty of room for five in every '83 Marquis. The Brougham covers that room in luxury cloth on the seats and door panels. But every Marquis offers more than enough luxury to suit the most discriminating drivers and passengers.

The carpeting is thick. The headliner, sun visors and headrests are all cloth-covered. The front seats are individually reclining and feature lumbar-type contours for added support. Flocked map pocket bins grace the door panels. And there's a locking, lighted glove box.

People with driving ambitions will admire the "Euro-style" seat design, the luxury four-spoke steering wheel, steering column-mounted controls and the optional high-tech electronic "Tripminder"® computer.

Those of a more practical nature will see the many standard features and the long list of options which allows them to tailor Marquis to their specific needs. To the standard items already mentioned, they can add Automatic Temperature Control air conditioning, power assists... even leather seating surfaces.

People seriously considering a new mid-size car or a luxury sedan should consider that they're really getting both in the '83 Marquis. Who could ask for more?

DEPTH OF CHARACTER

It shouldn't surprise anyone that a great deal of substance lies beneath the surface of the new Marquis. This is a car offering more than just comfort, a commitment to quality and refined aerodynamic styling.

Lincoln-Mercury has always believed that the creation of a fine automobile begins with the basics of design and engineering. For the '83 Marquis that means starting with an up-to-date, mid-

size chassis. A 105.6" wheelbase that's long enough to offer good ride characteristics and room for five. Yet is trim enough to be agile in traffic and exceedingly space-efficient.

The quality design concept continues with a modified MacPherson-type strut front suspension (including stabilizer bar) and a four-bar link rear suspension.

Precise rack-and-pinion steering, low-friction ball joints, gas-pressurized shocks and struts, and P185/75R14 black sidewall all-season radial tires complete the package. The results? Responsive handling and riding comfort.

Still, a truly contemporary automotive design must offer more than ride and handling. A wide range of advanced engine and transmission designs is a must. The '83 Marquis offers a choice of

five power train combinations: the standard 2.3 liter four-cylinder engine with a four-speed manual transmission, the same engine with an optional automatic transmission, an optional propane gas fueled 2.3 liter four-cylinder engine with automatic transmission, an optional 3.3 liter six-cylinder engine with a standard automatic, and the 3.8 liter V-6 with standard automatic overdrive.

Another important facet of Marquis'

overall design philosophy is body shape. You'll notice that Marquis' styling reflects this concern for aerodynamic efficiency, but not at the expense of elegant lines or a maximum utilization of interior dimensions.

Beyond that sleek sheet metal is a big 16-gallon fuel tank. A roomy, well-trimmed trunk. And a spacious interior for five outfitted with some of the finest materials and most thoughtful comfort

and convenience features to be found in the Lincoln-Mercury approach to luxury. Including individual reclining cloth-covered seats, padded door trim panels with cloth inserts and flocked map pocket bins... plus rich, thick 16-ounce floor carpeting.

FUNCTIONAL FASHION

If you want a sneak preview of the direction luxury wagons will be taking in the years ahead, you needn't look any farther than this year's Marquis.

Here's a wagon of decidedly deceptive dimensions. Trim and purposeful from all outward appearances, yet a veritable storehouse for large quantities of

luggage and the like.

Access to the carpeted cargo area can be achieved through the optional flip-up rear window when there are small parcels to pack. Or open the entire liftgate for major items.

You'll find plenty of room inside for many big things or even more little

things... 41.6* cubic feet with the rear seat up, 75.4* cubic feet with it down. And a locking storage compartment for smaller valuables.

So load up. Marquis' gas-pressurized shocks and struts will keep things smooth and easy for both packages and passengers. A standard 3.3 liter six-

cylinder engine and automatic transmission help with the hauling, while a standard "Liftgate Open" warning light and handy cargo area light add to the convenience.

Up front, you'd never know this was a hardworking wagon. The driver and as many as four others are surrounded by

traditional Marquis luxury. Soft seating, thick carpeting, map pockets and more.

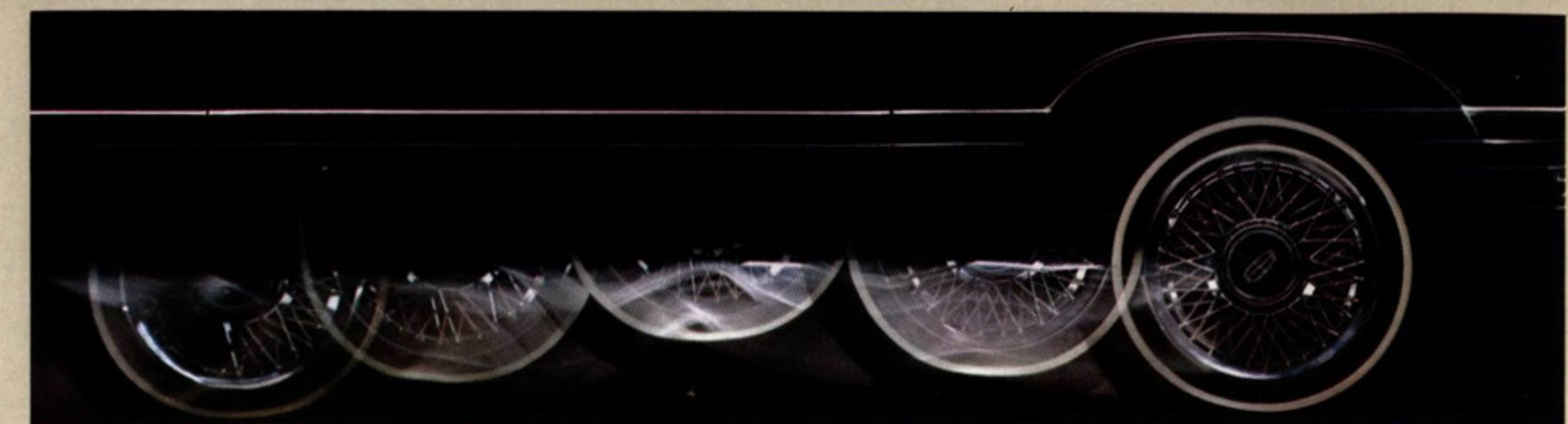

RIDE ENGINEERING



The first time you drive or ride in a 1983 Mercury Marquis, you'll discover what our chassis and suspension engineers have known all along: that a mid-size car can achieve surprisingly high levels of riding comfort.

They began with a proven modified

MacPherson-type strut front suspension and four-bar link coil spring rear suspension. To the front were added new springs, spring insulators and dampers... along with a new stabilizer bar. To the rear, a spring damper and improved upper spring insulators.

The final—and most important—

ingredients in the quest for "premium" riding characteristics are low-pressure, gas-filled front struts and rear shock absorbers. These hydraulic components allow a smoother, quieter ride than can be achieved by a conventional non-pressurized design on the same car.

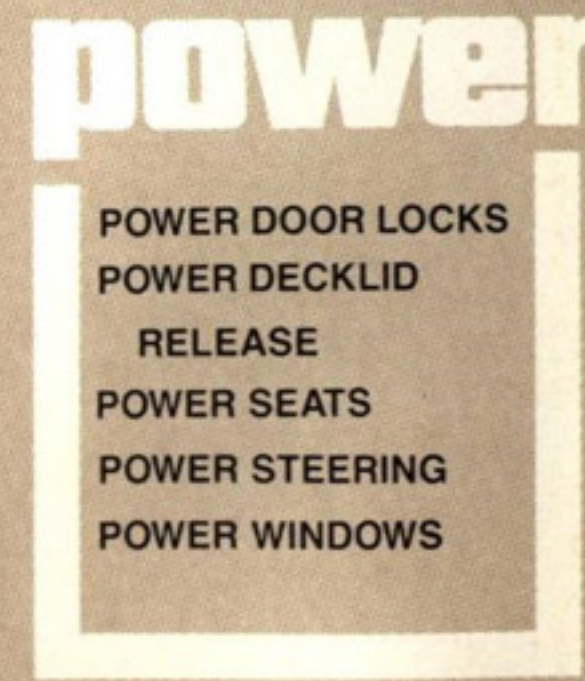

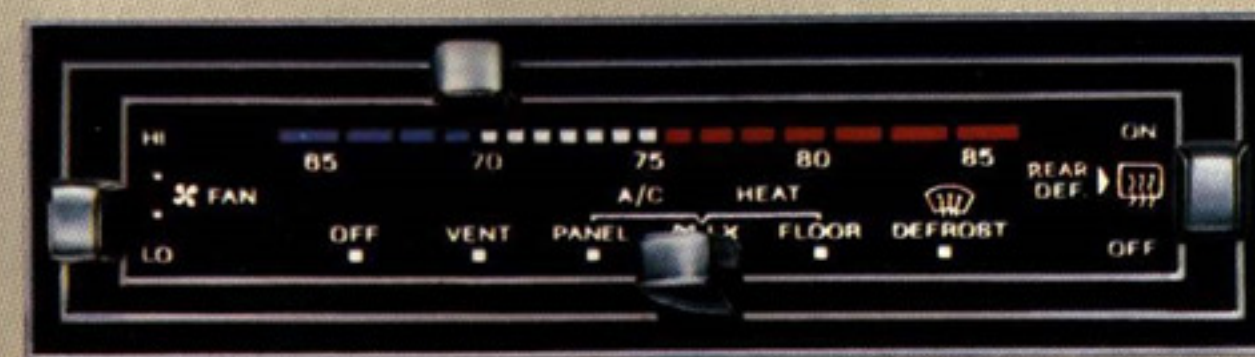

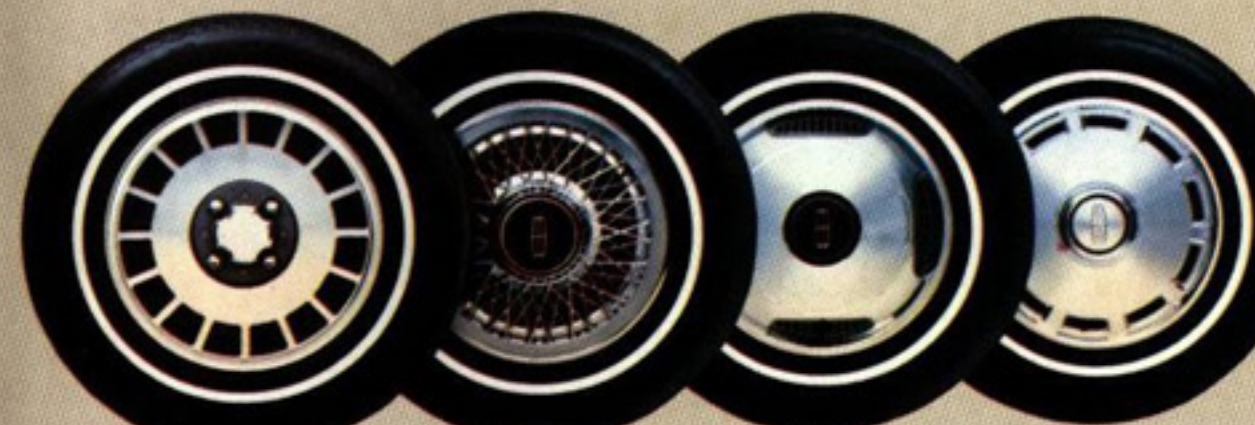

For continued top performance, be sure to specify genuine Motorcraft parts whenever replacement is necessary.

MAINTENANCE SCHEDULE

The Ford Motor Company wants to reduce both the frequency and cost of scheduled maintenance on its cars to an absolute minimum. And compared to just a few years ago, we're making strides in that direction. For example, in 1973, an engine oil change was called for every 4,000 miles. For 1983, Marquis oil changes are recommended at 7,500-mile intervals. Other recommended intervals are now 30,000 miles between spark plug changes; 30,000 miles between air filter replacements; 52,500 miles or three years between engine coolant replacements. We're proud of these improvements, and we're working constantly to make them even better.



Ford Motor Company's optional Extended Service Plan covers certain selected components on new Lincoln-Mercury cars for longer than the vehicle's basic warranty. The cost is so moderate for the protection you get that it could pay for itself the first time you need it. Ask your Lincoln-Mercury Dealer for complete details of the Plan, which is available on cars sold and normally operated in the 50 United States and Canada.

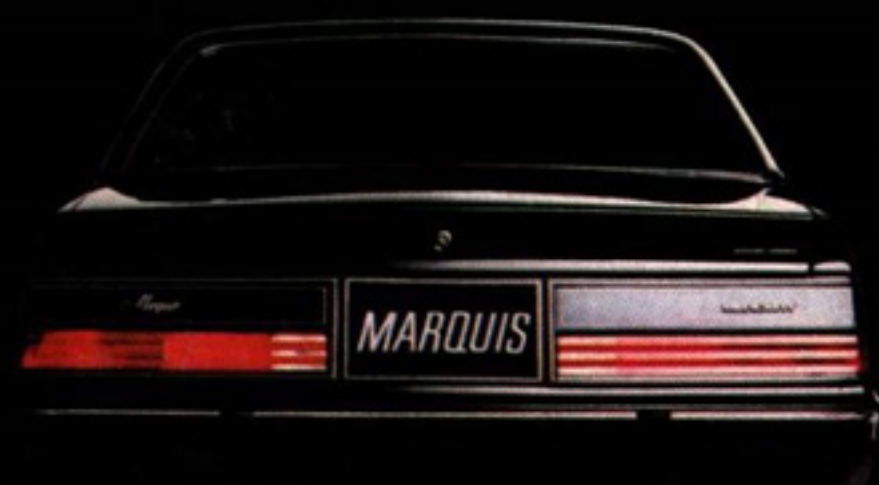
