


# AT HOME IN THE CITY, IN ITS ELEMENT BEING BATTERED BY THE ELEMENTS.

Suzuki has asked me to take the new Kizashi for a road trip and then write about it. Starting and ending in Manchester, I'll be touring the Lake District for a few days seeking out some of Britain's most challenging roads.

Slipping into the driver's seat for the first time, what strikes me is the feel and wonderful smell of leather. It gives the car an exclusive feel right off. A good start, I like it already. I spend the next few miles familiarising myself with the cockpit. Everything seems to be at my fingertips and the displays are bright and clear. Before I know it open space surrounds me, and the city suburbs are a memory in the rear view mirror.

I'm starting to enjoy myself. The 2.4 litre engine quietly purrs as we snake through the increasingly stunning landscape. A crosswind lashes the bodywork as we (me and my Kizashi) accelerate out of a tight right-hander, the 4-wheel drive keeping us stuck firmly to terra firma. The Kizashi's athletic good looks and contemporary styling are certainly at home in the city, but out here it feels like freedom. The road offers nothing but possibility and I follow it just because I can.










# GREAT DESIGN IS THE PERFECT BALANCE OF FORM AND FUNCTION.

Great design is the heart and soul of the new Kizashi. It's without doubt a car that will turn heads, equipped with its sweeping lines and contemporary sophistication. Some people actually give me a double take, and believe me, that doesn't happen often.

With design in mind it's appropriate that our first stop en route is an overnight stay at Dome House, Windermere. Dome House is not your ordinary run of the mill building. Its modern design shows amazing attention to detail, not unlike the Kizashi. I park up outside the building and jump out. The Kizashi really looks the part in front of the beautifully designed structure.

I grab my bag from the ample boot and walk along the passenger side taking in the cars elegant profile. Boot spoiler, 18-inch alloys and sport side-sill covers. I pause briefly in front of the sporty front end and wipe away an unfortunate insect from the headlamp just above the headlamp washer. I'm not normally such a perfectionist.

After a restful night in the Orange Room and a hearty Dome House breakfast on the balcony, it's time for a challenge. The Hardknott Pass is the steepest road in England reaching a peak of 393m (1,289ft) with a 33% gradient at its steepest point. Why do this? Because it's fun and because I can.

The last time I travelled this route was at less than walking pace on a bicycle with several hundred other lunatics. The 2.4 litre engine and 4-wheel drive make the whole experience much less painful. The Kizashi handles the numerous hairpin bends, avoids on-coming traffic and carefree sheep with panache, sticking to the road like it were on rails. The climb and descent really give me a chance to see what the Kizashi can do, and it doesn't disappoint.









## A PLACE FOR EVERYTHING AND EVERYTHING IN ITS PLACE.

After the Hardknott pass, ordinary roads seem a little mundane, so I set the cruise control.

I start pressing buttons to see what they do. All the controls are conveniently close at hand with the leather multi-function steering wheel.

The in-car entertainment system, complete with MP3/WMA compatible CD tuner and USB socket, blasts out my favourite driving tunes in sumptuous stereo. I sing along out of key because I can and because no one can hear me. My second overnight stop at the Woolpack Inn is only a few miles off. Time to lubricate the vocal chords.



## WHEN YOU'RE CLOCKING UP THE MILES, LUXURY GOES A LONG WAY.

I ease back in my seat feeling the comfort of the leather upholstery as it surrounds me. With 10-way power adjustable seating and 3 position memory settings it's a breeze to find my perfect driving position. I love this feature. If my wife drives my car it takes me from Land's End to John O'Groats to perfect my seat position again. It's roomy in here too. There's plenty of elbow and leg room for five adults. The display panels are thoughtfully positioned and well illuminated while the rain sensing wipers keep my vision clear. The power steering guides me around every curve delivering me safely to my destination.








## FLY LIKE THE WIND, STICK LIKE GLUE.

The Kizashi is a good looking car for sure. But the longer I spend behind the wheel, the more I realise it's what you don't see that makes this car such a blast to drive. Under its bonnet the 2.4 litre engine delivers all the power I need.

It's capable of 127 mph, but of course I stick strictly to the speed limit. When I accelerate the cars response is instant and impressive. Always smooth, always confident. This is helped in no small part by the CVT (continuously variable transmission). This clever technology keeps the engine running at its most efficient RPM, maximising both performance and fuel economy. Or when I feel like it, I can use the shift paddles to manually change up and down through the six pre-set gears with positivity.

With its selectable 4-wheel drive the Kizashi seems to relish every twist, turn, peak and trough the Lake District can throw at it. Some of the road conditions we've encountered are not for the faint hearted but nothing is a problem for the Kizashi with its can do attitude. Wet and slippy, mud, loose gravel, potholes and no doubt snow, the Kizashi takes them all in its stride. What the car delivers is a thrilling drive, not a white knuckle ride. Just the way I like it.



# IF THE UNTHINKABLE HAPPENS EVERYTHING HAS BEEN THOUGHT ABOUT.

Thankfully I don't have first hand experience of the multiple driver and passenger airbags but if the Kizashi's ability to stop in a hurry is anything to go by, I'm in safe hands.

On one of the Lake District's many twisty roads I came out of a blind bend only to stare straight into the eyes of a solitary sheep, the four legged fuzz ball obviously thought standing in the middle of the road was his right. I hit the anchors and the Electronic Stability Program (ESP®)\* and anti-lock brakes with Electronic Brake-Force Distribution did their stuff. No harm came to man, beast or car. My wooly friend gave me a sheepish look and wandered off underwhelmed by the encounter. 'Mint sauce' I muttered to myself.

If it's not livestock, it's the weather. Out here is predictably unpredictable. What starts as a blue-sky day can in minutes become dark and foreboding, then before you know it it's raining. A few spots quickly become sheets of water lashing the windscreen. Again the Kizashi comes up trumps. The rain-sensing wipers keep my vision clear, automatically becoming faster as the rain becomes heavier and easing off as the sun begins to glint through stubborn black cloud. Time to switch off the High Intensity Discharge (HID) headlamps until the next downpour.





# COLOUR OPTIONS.

The Kizashi I've been driving is Premium Silver Metallic. However, most of the bodywork is currently mud brown. So it's time to visit a car wash on my way back to the bright lights of Manchester. I want to finish my road-trip in style. I chose the colour of my Kizashi from the four stylish finishes available.




