*Abarth 750 Pininfarina cars were specially built to break records - between 24<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup> July, 1957, 11 records at Monza were broken over 5000 km in 3 hours with Cabianca, Cattini, Guarnieri, Manfredini and Poltronieri.*

## 1962-1967

*Six consecutive victories in the World Manufacturers' Championship with sports cars and saloon cars between 1962-1967. A period of great success with competitive cars in all categories and in all countries, giving numerous drivers a chance to savour a first place victory.*

*The banked racing circuit at Monza: four wins in the European Touring Car Manufacturers' Championship with the Fiat Abarth 1000 TC: 1965 with Ed Swart, 1966 with Giancarlo Baghetti, 1967 with Willi Kauhsen and 1969 with Marsilio Pasotti.*



## 1972-1975

*The rallies and the Abarth 124 spider Rally which won the European Championship in 1975 with Maurizio Verini (in the photo at the rally on the Island of Elba), who also finished second three times in the World Championships 1973-1975.*



## 1969

*At Imola in 1969, the introduction of the Abarth 2000 SE Sport, of which 25 examples were made, let numerous private race drivers achieve victories in both circuit racing and time trials. In this car, debuting the climb of the Ampus, Peter Schetty was the winner.*
