

## INTRODUCING ACURA. PERFORMANCE FOR PERFECTIONISTS. BY PERFECTIONISTS.

Just over 6 years ago, Honda gathered together a top group of automotive engineers, designers, enthusiasts and perfectionists to challenge the existing order of automotive thinking.

They were given a mandate to create a new generation of precision-crafted, performance-oriented automobiles for a new generation of drivers.

It was then that Acura, an entirely new division of Honda was formed.

### ENGINEERED BY ENTHUSIASTS. ACCLAIMED BY EXPERTS.

It was not surprising that the development team was able to meet, and surpass, its ambitious goals. Virtually every member of this international group is a driving enthusiast.

Therefore, it should come as no surprise

that automobiles created by such enthusiasts should generate such high praise.

And the praise is resounding. For 1987 MOTOR TREND rated the new Acura Legend Coupe 1st and the Acura Integra 2nd in its annual Import Car of the Year competition. CAR and DRIVER has named the Acura Integra Sports Coupe to its annual list of Ten Best Cars.

On only one other occasion has a single manufacturer with multiple entries been able to post a clean sweep, placing all its candidates in the top finishing position. The year was 1984. The manufacturer was Honda.

### ONE FROM THE HEART.

By definition, performance will be very much at the heart of any automobile designed by enthusiasts. And the Legend Sports Coupe is

not an exception. It is simply exceptional.

Its heart is an aluminum alloy, 2.7 litre, 24-valve SOHC fuel injected V-6 engine that develops an outstanding 161 hp at 5900 rpm and 162 lb-ft of torque at 4500 rpm.


The engine employs high performance technology gained from a racing program that captured the coveted Formula 1 Constructor's Championship for the Honda powered Canon-Williams team on the Grand Prix circuit in 1986.

Four valves per cylinder increase the fuel/air flow to and exhaust flow from each combustion chamber. Centrally positioned spark plugs improve combustion efficiency. A Variable Intake Control System is designed to optimize intake air volume for different operating conditions. In particular, this means improved performance at low engine speeds, for eager response.

A 90° layout, single overhead camshafts and a system of finger-type cam followers with self-adjusting hydraulic adjusters help keep the V-6 profile low, contributing significantly to outstanding exterior aerodynamics.

Two transmission choices are offered; a crisp-shifting 5-speed manual (standard equipment), or an all new 4-speed electronically controlled automatic (optional). The automatic transmission offers the driver a choice of two different operating modes—a normal mode for efficient, unhurried cruising, plus a Sport mode to enhance performance driving—and also employs a Programmed Lockup Torque Converter. The converter lockup function, managed by a sensor system, minimizes converter slippage for improved efficiency in either mode.

For optimum efficiency, the V-6's PGM-FI sequential port fuel injection system is controlled by an 8-bit microprocessor monitoring seven operating parameters—another legacy of the Williams/Honda experience on the Formula 1 racing circuit.
