






Alfa Romeo does not equate luxury with velour and plush, but with quiet, comfort and control.

The doors close with quiet authority—in two stages actually—because they are double sealed. There is virtually no wind noise, thanks to a body design and fit so clean and precise, it has aerodynamics close to those of a racing machine.

Extensive acoustic insulation substantially reduces road noise, so that all you hear is a distinctive and decidedly musical sound when the engine accelerates. And that, as an


Alfista will tell you, is a sound no one wants insulated away.

The 164 is, even by luxury standards, fully equipped. Everything you see is there for a reason and within easy reach. Nothing is there simply for appearances. The 24 service and indicator lights arrayed across the instrument panel are all business. The automatic temperature controls are extensive and logical. The steering wheel telescopes to help you find the perfect position; the firm, supportive

four-way power seats keep you comfortable for hours on end. Cruise control, power windows, power-assisted steering, a premium six-speaker sound system, and more are all standard on even the least expensive 164.

It is an interior that adds greatly to the unique experience of driving an Alfa Romeo. An environment created by a company that obviously understands and encourages the close personal relationship between people and cars.

In a car less capable, less well balanced than this, the amount of power available in the 164 might be unnerving.

But here, it is exhilarating. The 3.0-liter Bosch fuel-injected V-6 is a masterful combination of computer-accurate precision and hand assembly. As testimony to what 80 years of racing knowledge and high performance engine building can do, it generates 183 horsepower (200 in the Sport version) and 140+ mph top speeds on the test track without turbocharging or similar gadgetry.

Coupled to either the standard five-speed manual

overdrive transaxle, or an optional four-speed automatic overdrive, power comes on predictably, evenly, and steadily.

Handling and cornering in the 164 are stable and solid, with a feeling of control that is so complete it actually makes you feel like a better driver. Which, to the Alfa Romeo way of thinking, is precisely the way it should be.

Control and capability also describe the 164's braking, with power-assisted four-wheel disc brakes standard

on every model and computer-controlled Bosch antilock braking on the Luxury and Sport versions.


