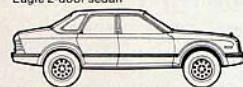

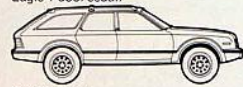

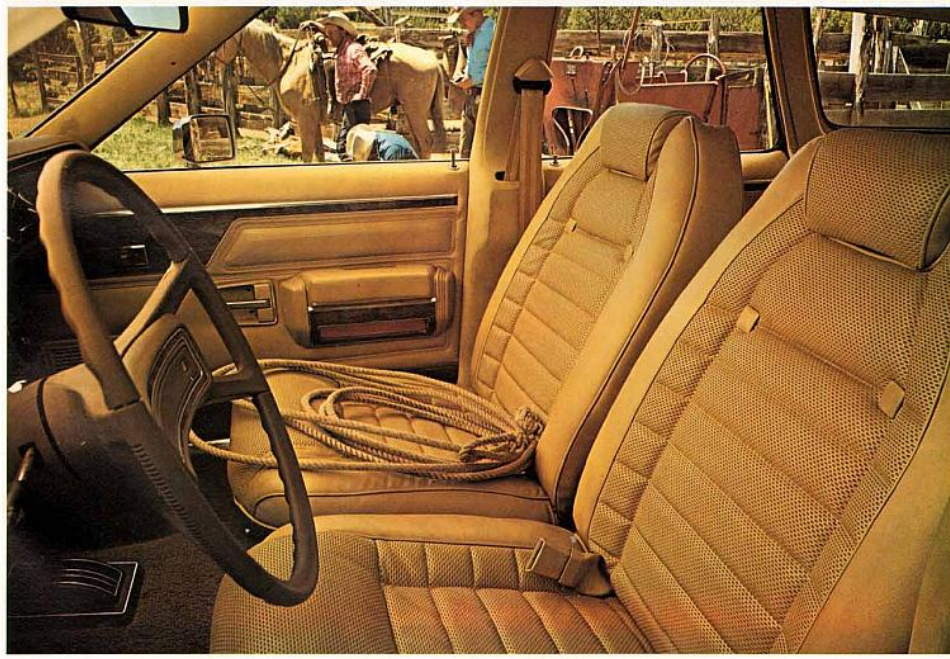

When you buy a new 1981 AMC automobile with Ziebart® Factory Rust Protection from an authorized AMC dealer, American Motors Corporation warrants to you that it will pay for the repair or replacement of any part it supplies, except exhaust system components, which proves under normal use and service to have developed perforation from corrosion within five (5) years from the date of delivery or first use, whichever occurs first. There is no mileage limitation.

All we require is that the automobile be properly maintained in accordance with the conditions set forth in the Owner's Manual. All repairs and parts replacements under this warranty must be performed by an authorized AMC dealer. You must notify your dealer as soon as you are aware of perforation due to corrosion.

Corrosion other than perforation which is due to defective factory materials or workmanship is covered by the full 12-month or 12,000-mile (20,000 km) AMC New Automobile warranty.

Perforation from corrosion due to accident, damage, abuse or vehicle alteration is not covered under this warranty.

Collision-damaged panels must be repaired or replaced with new factory-approved or authorized parts and rust-protected within two (2) months to be included in this warranty.

For service under this warranty, you must take your automobile to an AMC dealer for examination and approval by a service representative of American Motors prior to repair or replacement of any part.

Warranty Coverage

This warranty gives you 12-month or 12,000-mile (20,000 km), whichever comes first, coverage on many items not covered by most warranties. It covers wiper blades, brake linings, light bulbs — everything we put on the automobile except tires. If any part American Motors supplies is wrong on your 1981, you won't have to pay for the parts or the labor. You are responsible to see that your automobile is maintained, at your expense, according to the 1981 Owner's Manual and Maintenance Schedule booklet.

Service Adjustments

Any needed service adjustments required during the first 12 months or 12,000 miles (20,000 km) of normal use, whichever comes first, and which are not required as part of normal scheduled maintenance will be performed by an authorized AMC dealer without charge to the customer.

Warranty Service For owners Who Move or Travel

If you move or are traveling, any AMC dealer in the fifty United States or Canada will perform warranty repairs for you.

Warranty Coverage For Subsequent Owners

Subsequent owners of an AMC automobile are eligible for any unused warranty coverage. A subsequent owner need simply present the warranty folder (properly filled out) to an authorized AMC dealer to obtain warranty repairs.

Tire Policy

The tire manufacturer provides a limited warranty for the tires supplied with your new automobile. Specific warranty information and tire adjustments are handled directly with owners by the tire manufacturer's distributors, dealers or retail stores. Your AMC dealer will assist if you need help in securing an adjustment.

Pre-Delivery Service

Your AMC dealer has serviced and tested your automobile for starting, handling, and braking and overall performance in accordance with AMC's Dealer Pre-Delivery Service Procedure. In addition, many other checks, inspections, adjustments and final clean-up services have been performed to assure your auto meets the quality standards of AMC products.

A Loaner Automobile

If your automobile needs warranty repair work and "same day" (morning to evening) service cannot be completed as promised or if warranty repairs require that it be kept overnight, your AMC dealer will provide you with a free loaner automobile until your auto is ready. To qualify, you must comply with your dealer's work schedule.

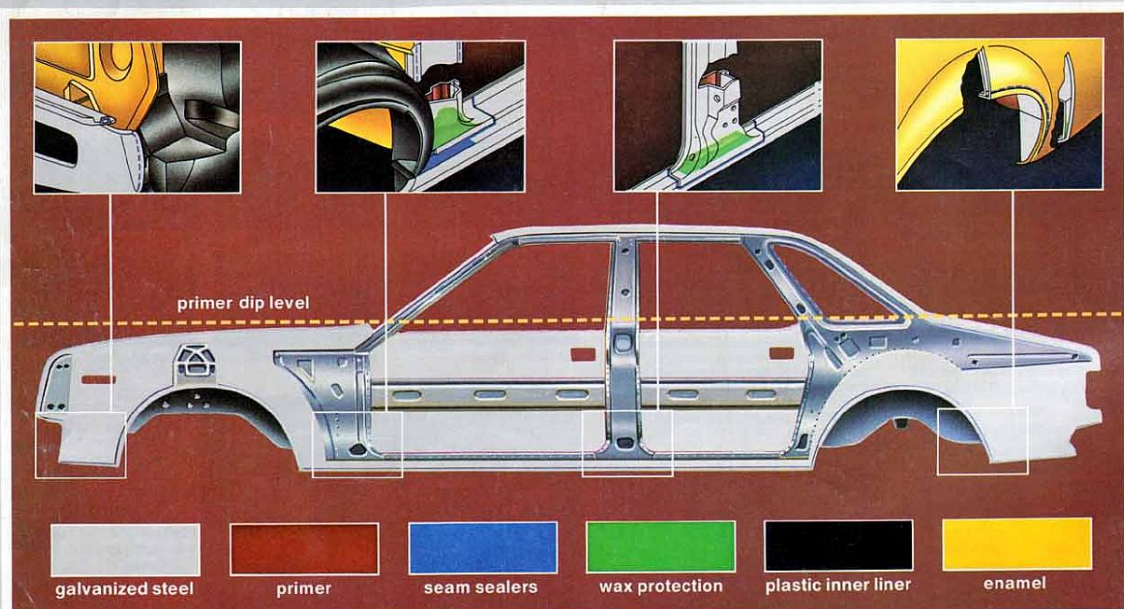
Special Trip Interruption Protection

If you're 100 miles (160 km) or more from home and a servicing AMC dealer can't provide "same day" warranty repairs for your automobile, interrupting your trip, we will reimburse you for reasonable extra lodging and meal costs up to \$150, based upon your actual expenses. Submit receipts to the AMC dealer who serviced your automobile. He'll handle the paperwork that generates a direct reimbursement from American Motors to you.

Ziebart[®] Factory Rust Protection

American Motors gives you a full five (5) year warranty which covers perforation due to corrosion for five years from date of delivery or first use, whichever comes first. As the illustration below indicates, American Motors makes extensive use of galvanized steel — a zinc-coated steel that provides excellent protection against corrosion.
