1963. The first Riviera was a new breed of American automobile—a classic from the very beginning.

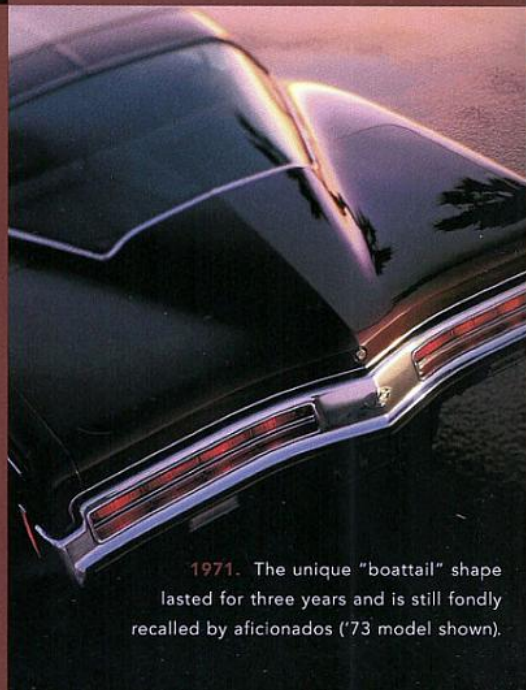
