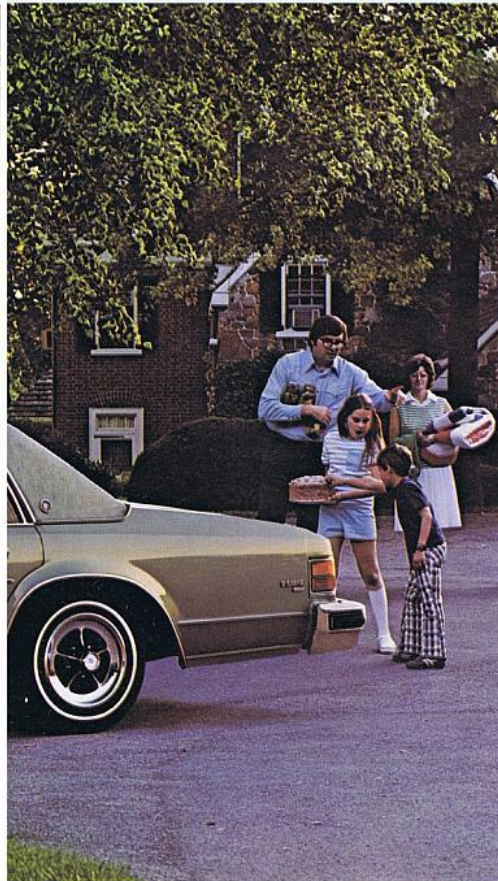

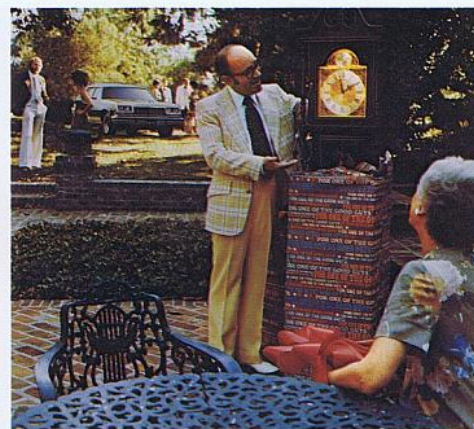
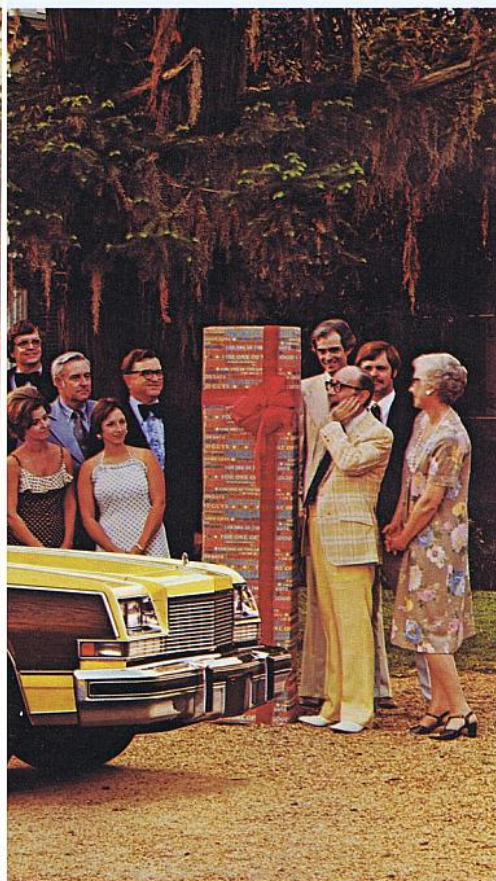

this year, Riviera is available with four-wheel disc brakes. A rather special distinction.

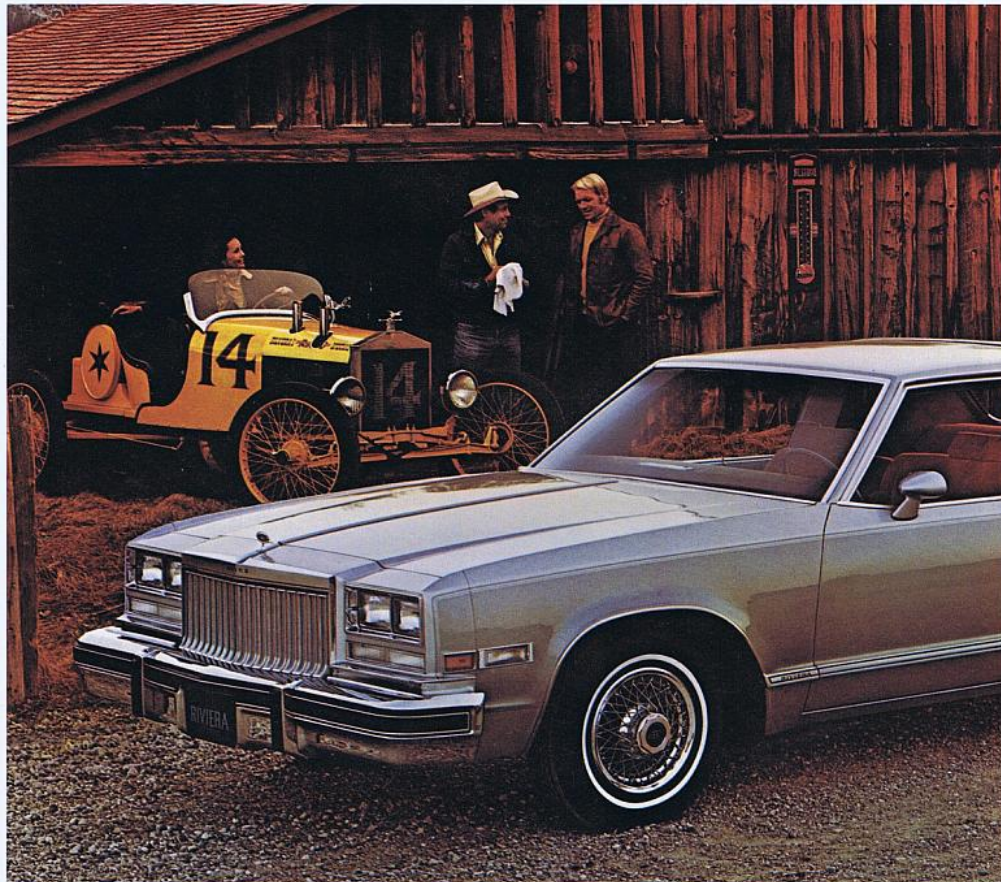

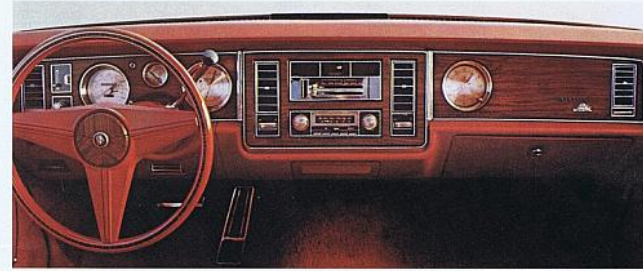

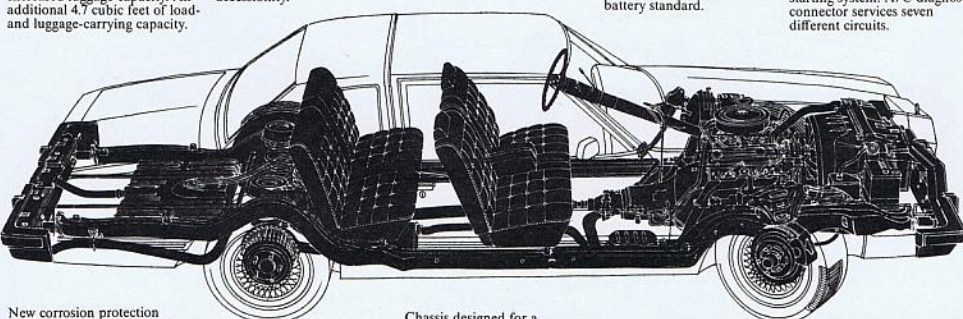

An all-metal, electric sunroof is available on all full-size Buicks. A distinctive new touch for Wagons and Sedans. Or you can order any full-size Buick with our Astrorooft, which is like having three roofs in one:

At the touch of a button, you can electrically retract the glass section. Or, with

another touch of the button, you can slide the glass back to its original position and have a glass-topped driving compartment. Or, you can draw the sunshade and have a well-tailored tight-fitting headliner overhead.

Riviera features yet another interesting roof treatment. If you order the available Landau vinyl top, illuminated coach lamps are included.

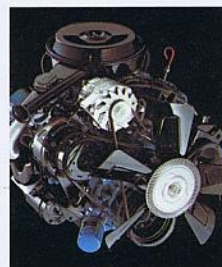

BUICK POWER PLANTS.

A spunky V6 is standard equipment on all LeSabres except the special new Sport Coupe. (More about that momentarily.) As available equipment, we offer three V8's. A new 5.0 litre, a 5.7 litre 4-barrel or the brand-new 6.6 litre that takes the place of the former 7.5 litre V8 engine. And for Estate Wagon, Electra and Riviera, a 5.7 litre is standard and the 6.6 litre available.

We couple these engines with things like radial tires and Buick's High-Energy Ignition system.



NEW MODELS.

LeSabre Sport Coupe. Today that the new LeSabre Sport Coupe handles well would be something of an under-statement.

It comes with the new 5.0 litre V8. White-stripe radial tires. Special suspension and steering linkage.

Inside, there's custom trim and a Rallye steering wheel. Outside, chrome wheels,



amber lights, and downright mean-looking black accents.

LeSabre Sport Coupe. All in all, it's not exactly what you'd call your typical family bus.

THE LeSABRE V6 HIGHWAY ECONOMY PACKAGE.

On the other hand, if your tastes are a little more pragmatic than exotic, you might want to consider the new LeSabre economy package. Which offers you a specially tuned V6, specially calibrated automatic transmission and a lower 2.56 axle ratio. In addition, this package offers a larger, 20.4 gallon fuel tank in place of the standard 17.5 gallon tank. But keep in mind that this option is not geared for incity driving. It's primarily a highway cruising package and that's where its economical benefits are most apparent. If in doubt about ordering the package, just ask your Buick salesman. Describe your driving situation, and see what he recommends. Yes, LeSabre is an economical car. But the nice thing is, it's also a full-size Buick.

NEW INSTRUMENT PANEL LIGHTING.

The new instrument panel design for Riviera, Electra and Estate Wagon Limited includes functional warning lights shown and "flood-



lighting". Tiny lamps on the underside of the dash "flood-light" the driver's instrumentation and controls.

ESTATE WAGON LIMITED.

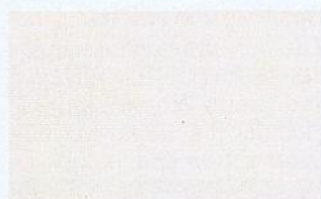
Here, the difference between a station wagon and an Estate Wagon becomes clearly evident.
