When it's time to work hard, El Camino is eager to help, with a cargo capacity of 35.5 cu. ft. and a payload capacity of up to 1,250 lbs.* El Camino even boasts double-wall construction in crucial areas and air adjustable rear shocks to help prevent "bottoming out" under maximum loads.

Come playtime, El Camino travels to family fun or formal occasions, thanks to its stylish trim and sleek design. And if towing is your pleasure, El Camino proves you can take it with you, up to 6,000 lbs. worth of trailer, cargo and equipment, when the vehicle is properly equipped.

El Camino packs plenty of punch for the performance-minded, too. This year's new standard electronically fuel-injected 4.3 Liter V6 engine has been engineered to give you nimble response. Or if you'd rather, choose the even more muscular available high-compression 5.0 Liter V8 with electronic spark control, also new for 1985. All powertrains feature the convenience of standard automatic transmission, power steering and low-drag front disc brakes.

There are several models to choose from, including standard El Camino, El Camino SS Sport Decor and the dra-



matic El Camino Conquesta. Whichever you select, you'll find your El Camino is a vehicle filled with creature comforts that really likes to truck.

The first thing you'll notice as you relax in El Camino's standard notchback bench seat is its couchlike quality. If you prefer individual seating, reclining buckets or a 55/45 split bench are available to you. All seats are complemented by lush, standard color-keyed cut-pile carpeting, padded armrests, sunshades, headliner and trim moldings, in any one of the five newly available colors you choose.

Next, you'll want to check out El Camino's instrumentation. You'll find all system controls close at hand, with easily readable gages mounted in an instrument panel of classic design. The column-mounted multi-function switch deserves special attention; this handy lever puts windshield washer/wipers, turn signals, dimmer and available speed control a fingertip away from the steering wheel.


And don't overlook El Camino's other thoughtful touches—like vinyl door-pull straps, lighted ashtray and glove compartment, and a generous storage area hidden behind the driver's seat and under the pickup box next to the spare tire. Every new 1985 El Camino delivered by a Chevrolet dealer in the United States comes with a one-year, \$10,000 seat belt insurance certificate from MIC General Insurance Corporation at no additional charge. \$10,000 will be paid to the estate of any occupant who suffers fatal injuries as a result of an accident involving that vehicle while wearing a GM seat belt. Buckle up every time you drive.

These vehicles are also available under the GMC nameplate Caballero.

A word about assembly, components and optional equipment in these Chevrolet products.

The Chevrolet El Caminos described in this catalog are assembled at facilities operated by General Motors, GM de México. These vehicles incorporate thousands of different components produced by car and truck groups and various component divisions of GM and by various suppliers to General Motors. From time to time during the manufacturing process, it may be necessary, in order to meet public demand for particular vehicles or equipment, or to meet federally mandated emissions, safety and fuel economy requirements, or for other reasons, to produce Chevrolet products with different components or differently sourced components than initially scheduled. All such components have been approved for use in Chevrolet products and will provide the quality performance associated with the Chevrolet name.
