Chevette Models.

First, there's the neat little 2-Door Hatchback Coupe. It has a four-foot-wide hatchback, a fold-down rear seat 26.3 cubic feet of cargo area with the rear seat down, swing-out rear side windows* and lots of life. There's full foam seat comfort for four people. And if you are really watching your bucks, Chevette Scooter could be right up your driveway.

Then, add two doors, three inches to the wheelbase and almost three inches more rear-seat leg room than the 2-Door and you've got the Chevette 4-Door Hatchback Sedan. With the rear seat folded down, there's 1.1 cubic feet more load space than with the 2-Door.

Chevette Interiors.

help improve ventilation.

Shhhh. You'll find that extensive sound-deadening treatments have been used throughout the Sedan and Coupe, including an insulating blanket added to the front floor area.

Chevette Standard Features.

1. High Energy Ignition. A solid-state system that eliminates points and ignition condenser, yet delivers a high-voltage spark that helps extend time between recommended tune-ups.

2. Built-in diagnostic connector. Helps facilitate the servicing of the engine electrical system.

3. Coolant recover system. Helps prevent loss of coolant.

4. Delco Freedom Battery. Never needs refilling. Sealed side terminals help resist corrosion.

5. Full Coil suspension system. Puts a resilient coil spring at each wheel that's been computer-selected for the specific model and equipment weight.

6. Front disc/rear drum brakes. A self-adjusting system. Front disc brakes are fade resistant and have audible wear sensors to let you know when to replace linings.

7. Rack-and-pinion steering. Helps provide responsive steering. Short 30.2-foot turning circle on Coupe makes it easy to manoeuvre and park.

8. Flow-through ventilation system. The addition of a new duct in 1979 helps improve low-level air flow.

9. Inner fenders. Bolt-on front fenders feature plastic inner shields for road splash protection.

10. Double-wall construction. Provides two layers of steel in doors, hood and hatch lid.

11. Four-Speed manual transmission. Provides four, fully synchronized forward ratios with floor-mounted shift selector.

12. Visible ball joint wear indicators. Located on front suspension lower control arms for visible check of ball joint wear.

13. Radial ply tires. New standard P155/80R-13 glass-belted radial ply tires.

14. High-pressure compact spare tire. Takes up less space in the storage compartment than conventional spare tire.

15. Convenient column-mounted "Smart Switch." Fingertip control for turn signals, headlight dimmer, windshield wipers and washers.

EXTENSIVE CORROSION-RESISTANT TREATMENTS.

There is extensive use of galvanized steels and Zincrometal® panels. An oil base wax coating is used for the frame, an abrasion-resistant coating for the lower body and special coatings, primers and sealers are used in strategic areas.

ACOUSTICAL TREATMENTS.

A torque-tube drive design contributes to effective isolation of road shock and noise from the passenger compartment. An insulating blanket has been added to the front floor area of Hatchback Sedan and Hatchback Coupe models. And there are over ten other Amberlite® Plastisol® mastic or spray-on sound deadener treatments used throughout Chevette.

A WORD ABOUT ENGINES.

The Chevettes shown in this catalogue are equipped with GM-built engines produced by various divisions. Please refer to the Chevette Power Teams Chart on this page and see your dealer for details.

ENGINE SELECTION.

For 1979, Chevette continues to offer a choice of a standard 4-cylinder engine or an available higher output version. However, there have been many improvements and refinements to this year's power teams.

1.6 LITRE L4 (98 CU. IN.) STANDARD ENGINE.

This modern 1.6 Litre overhead-cam engine with 4-Speed manual transmission is standard. For 1979, engine refinements provide increased horsepower, good drivability with a more positive cold drive-away response and increased acceleration.

A new two-stage 2-barrel carburetor replaces last year's monojet configuration and helps provide smooth operation at low and intermediate operation. Also, a "tuned" aluminum inlet manifold and refined cylinder head inlet and exhaust porting help enhance the engine's breathing system.

1.6 LITRE L4 (98 CU. IN.) (HIGH OUTPUT)

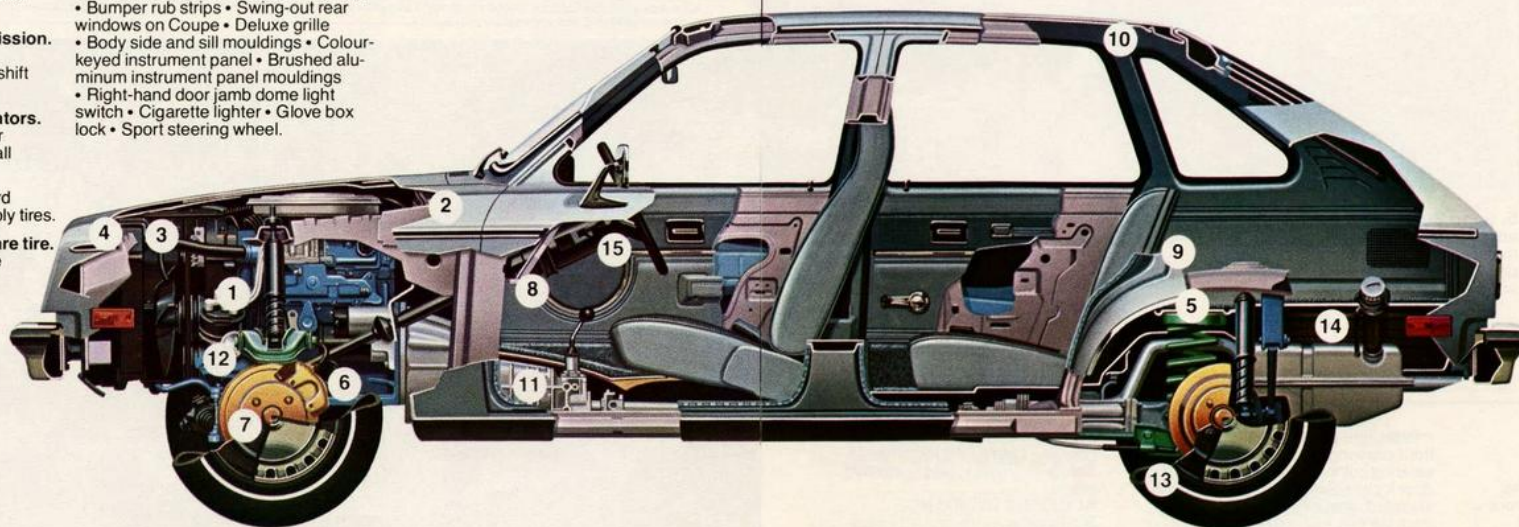
The available High Output version of the 1.6 Litre engine features a high-speed camshaft, dual-takedown exhaust manifold that helps tune exhaust impulses for good engine breathing, freer exhaust flow.

NEW REPLACEABLE AIR CLEANER ELEMENT.

For 1979, there is a new 80,000 kilometres, (50,000-mile) replaceable air cleaner element to help reduce maintenance costs.

OTHER STANDARD ENGINE FEATURES.

Carburetor outside air intake ducts cooler outside air through the air cleaner directly into the engine's carburetor to help assure a denser fuel-air mixture for improved performance in different speed ranges after warm-up. Fuel evaporation control system stores fuel vapours normally lost to atmosphere from the fuel tank and carburetor after engine is shut down. Carburetor mixes hot air from the manifold heat stove with outside air during warm-up for improved cold engine operation. Catalytic converter handles most emission control functions outside the engine so the engine can be initially tuned for better overall performance.

1. Air conditioning. Cooling, heating and defogging in one easily operated unit.

4. AM/FM radio. Delco-GM AM/FM radio with push-button tuning. Windshield antenna included with factory-installed radios.

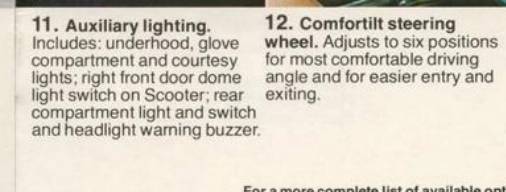
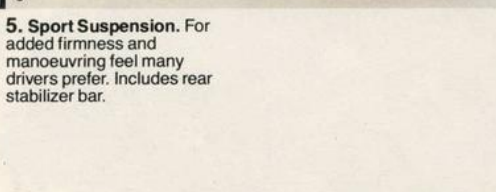
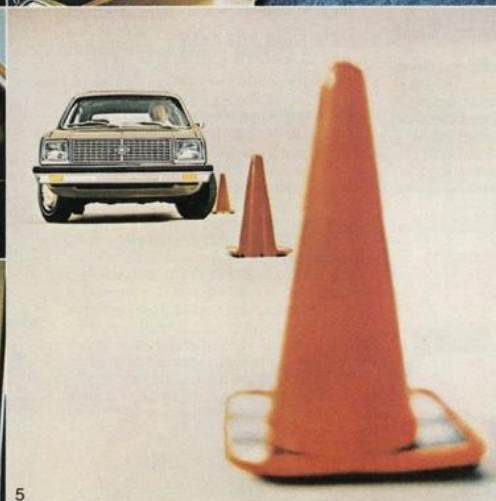
