Why we built the Chevette.

Simply put, we built Chevette because we believe it is time for a new kind of car, this kind of car, from the North American automotive industry.

Chevette is international in design and heritage, incorporating many engineering concepts proved around the world.

It exists, in a word, for *efficiency*: efficiency of size, space, fuel, service, operation, performance.

Consider these points.

It is protected by 17 anti-corrosion methods.

Its wheelbase is 94.3 inches. And overall length is 158.7 inches.

Its turning circle, compared with that of any foreign or domestic car, is among the smallest.

It can carry cargo up to four feet wide.

It is well insulated against noise.

It is basically a metric car. And, as you know, the metric system is on its way to becoming the standard of North American measurement.

It comes with a clear, simple self-service booklet.

It's a two-door hatchback, with seating for four in the Chevette Coupe, also the Rally, Sport and Woody versions. A perky two-passenger version, the Scooter, is also available.

It has much more to recommend it, which you'll see in the following pages.

How we built the Chevette.

Construction, corrosion protection, acoustical insulation, more.

INTERNATIONAL IN DESIGN.

The 1976 Chevette is Chevrolet's first metric car, the forerunner of North America's cars of tomorrow. Most of its components conform to the international metric standard of measurement. Many of its design and engineering features have been proved in similarly built General Motors cars around the world. Even though it is international in design concepts, Chevrolet has tailored Chevette to North America's driving needs, and it incorporates traditional built-in Chevrolet value.

COMPREHENSIVE CORROSION TREATMENTS.

Chevette includes the kind of anti-corrosion treatment you'll appreciate with passing time and miles. And all the corrosion treatments described here won't cost you a penny extra. They're standard.

WAX BASE SPRAY. Rust and corrosion forming on the inner side of doors, rocker panels and rear quarter panels can often be a problem. Chevette utilizes a water-repellent wax coating to help protect the lower surfaces of these vital areas against rust.

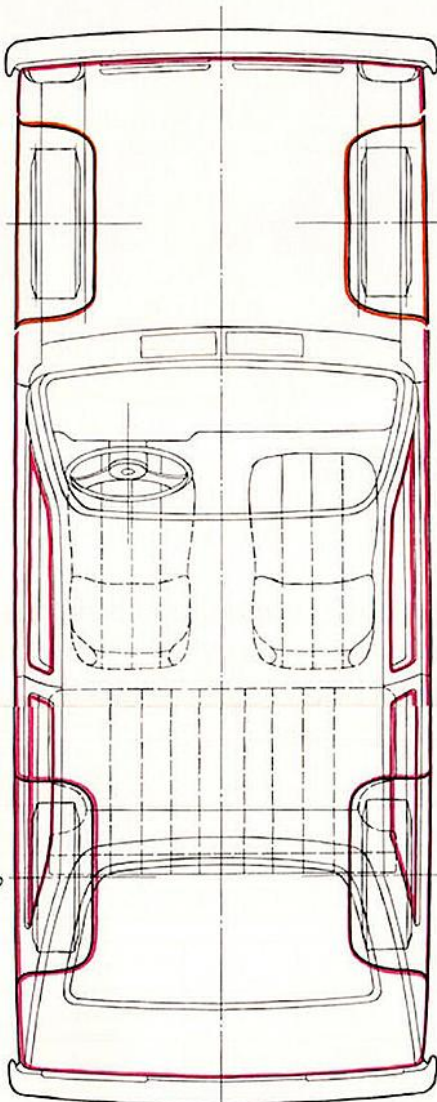
EPOXY PAINT. Even though corrosion-resistant epoxy paint is more expensive than ordinary paint, its ability to expand and contract without cracking makes it the right kind of protection for Chevette's front and rear coil springs.



HIGH-STRENGTH BUMPERS.

Chevette's lightweight steel bumpers are mounted directly on shock absorbers which, in turn, are mounted directly into solid underbody rails. This design helps cushion minor impacts.

MORE CHEVETTE VALUE FEATURES. Aerodynamically designed front spoiler. Flush-style exterior door handles.



FRONT INNER FENDER PLASTIC LINERS. Durable and corrosion resistant, they help protect the front outer fenders from nicks, dents and scratches caused by stones kicked up from underneath.

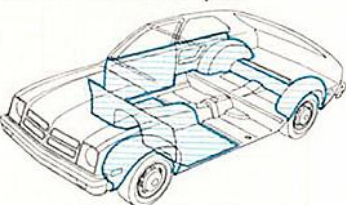
ZINCROMETAL. This metal has the dual advantage of combining a rust-resistant galvanized coating on the inner side with long-lasting paint finish adhered on the outside. You'll find this quality metal used for Chevette's cowl side panels, hood, roof side rails and rear quarter panels.

ZINC-RICH PRIMER. Before Chevette's Magic-Mirror acrylic lacquer finish is applied, selected areas of the quarter and rear end panels, underbody, side rails, hatch and doors are sealed by a zinc-rich primer to help protect against moisture and rust.

GALVANIZED METAL. Chevette's front side rails, front valance and rocker panels are fabricated from galvanized metal for protection against rust.

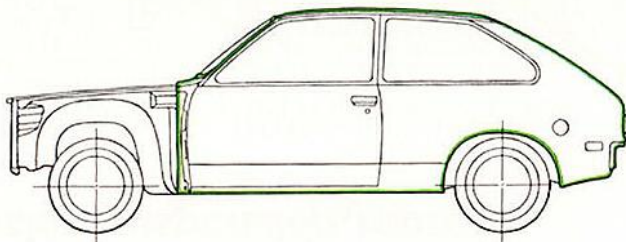
OIL BASE COATING. Each of Chevette's rear springs is firmly seated

in a housing that is protected by a corrosion-resistant oil base coating. It's little inner things like this that you like to find in an economy car.

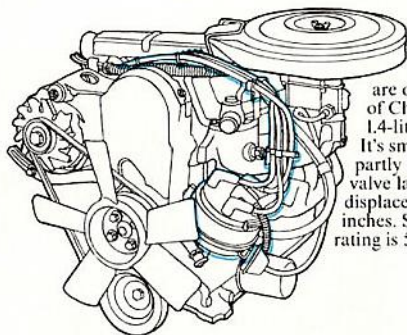


ACOUSTICAL INSULATION. There are acoustic insulators on the lower dash, front floor, rear wheelhousings and rear quarter trim. Spray-on sound deadener is applied to front and rear wheelwells, door inner surfaces and other sensitive areas. And when the available Custom Interior is ordered, additional sound insulation is included.

STRONG, UNITIZED BODY. We also combined the hood and grille into a single unit to make the engine compartment items more accessible for service. Bolt-on front fenders can be removed if needed, for repair or replacement.



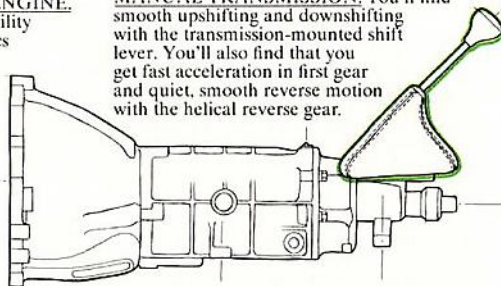

1.4-LITRE 4-CYLINDER OVERHEAD-CAM ENGINE.

Efficiency and driveability are outstanding characteristics of Chevette's standard 1.4-litre single OHC engine. It's smooth and quiet, too, partly because of hydraulic valve lash adjusters. Engine displacement is 85 cubic inches. SAE net horsepower rating is 52.

FULLY SYNCHRONIZED 4-SPEED MANUAL TRANSMISSION. You'll find smooth upshifting and downshifting with the transmission-mounted shift lever. You'll also find that you get fast acceleration in first gear and quiet, smooth reverse motion with the helical reverse gear.



HIGH ENERGY IGNITION.

Standard on every Chevette, the High Energy Ignition delivers up to 35 percent hotter spark to the plugs than with conventional systems, for responsive ignition performance.

CATALYTIC CONVERTER.

Takes over most of the emissions control so engines can be tuned for smooth, responsive, efficient performance.

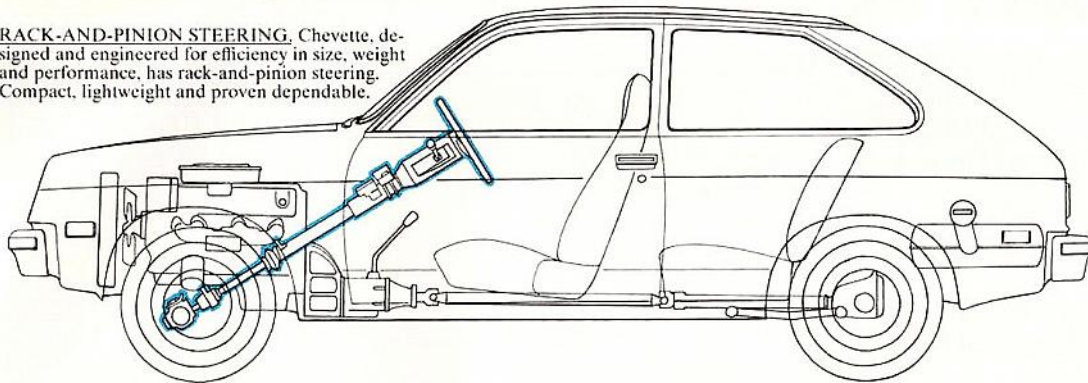

RACK-AND-PINION STEERING. Chevette, designed and engineered for efficiency in size, weight and performance, has rack-and-pinion steering. Compact, lightweight and proven dependable.



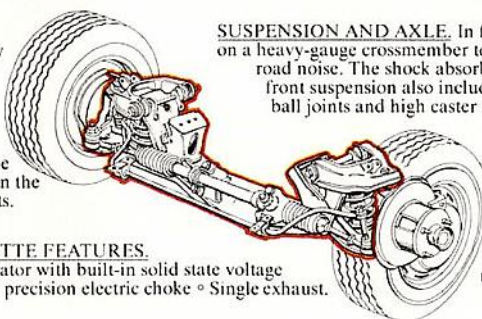
FRONT DISC/REAR DRUM BRAKES.

Another of Chevette's value features is its hefty front disc brakes. They're fade resistant, smooth operating and resist the effects of water. They also have built-in audible wear sensors to alert you when the disc pads need replacement. Coupled with the front discs are rear drum brakes and dual master cylinder. The parking brake handle is conveniently located on the driveshaft tunnel between the front bucket seats.

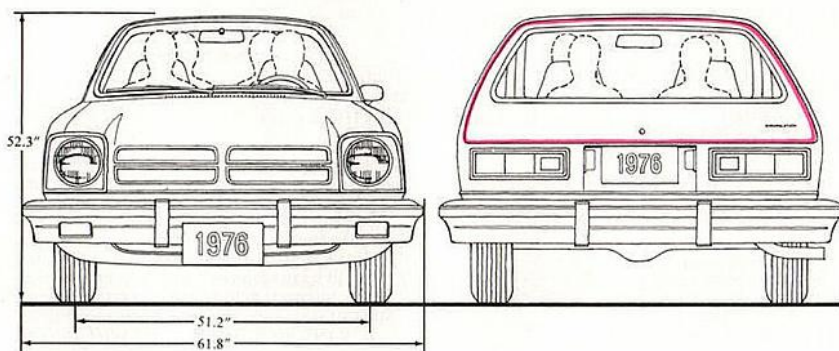
MORE CHEVETTE FEATURES.

Delcotron generator with built-in solid state voltage regulator • New precision electric choke • Single exhaust.

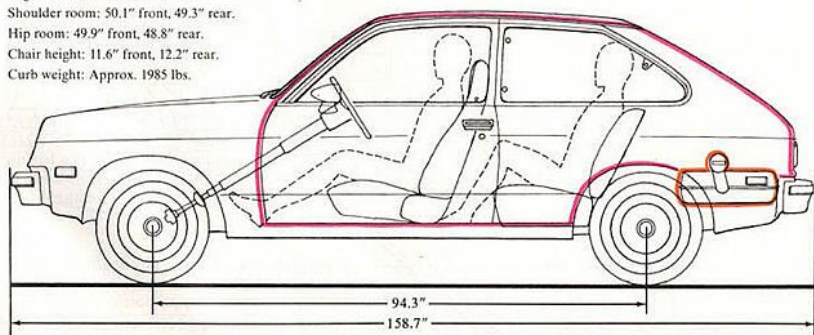
SUSPENSION AND AXLE. In front, the suspension is mounted on a heavy-gauge crossmember to help isolate road shock and road noise. The shock absorbers are outboard mounted. The front suspension also includes a stabilizer bar, low-friction ball joints and high caster suspension geometry. Variable rate coil springs are standard in the rear, as is the new torque tube rear axle. The torque tube likewise helps isolate road shock and road noise. Also helps permit a low height of the driveshaft tunnel to provide added rear-seat head room and a full-width rear seat.

FULL-WIDTH HATCH.

Loading a Chevette through the rear hatch is easy because of its 48-inch width and 27.5-inch height with the hatch open. Dual pneumatic hatch supports are standard (except Scooter).

TRI-COLOUR TAILLIGHTS.

Here's another of the international features standard on Chevette: red, amber and white taillights which quickly signal to the driver behind what your driving intentions are. The red taillights glow when your headlights or parking lights are on. Apply your brakes and



the red taillights show a brighter glow. The bright amber taillights will flash with your turn signals or hazard warning flasher. Put your Chevette in reverse gear and the white backup lights light up.

10-GALLON GAS TANK.

Combine Chevette's fuel efficiency with this size gas tank and you can drive many miles between fill-ups.

SO MUCH ROOM IN SO LITTLE SPACE.

Every inch of the Chevette is designed for efficiency. Its exterior is trim and compact, with needless overhang and bulk eliminated. There's interior comfort for four passengers in the Chevette Coupe, also the Rally, Sport and Woody versions. And with Chevette's special front bucket seats, you sit chair-high for added comfort and easy over-the-hood viewing. Fold the rear seat down and you get wagon-like stowage for 26 cu. ft. of cargo.

COMPACT TURNING CIRCLE. Chevette gives you a turning circle of only 30.2 feet. Here's a convenience you'll appreciate every time you park, back or make a limited-space turnaround.

FREEDOM BATTERY.

The new Delco Freedom battery never needs refilling with water. It has a sealed top, no filler caps, and side terminals which resist corrosion buildup.



DO-IT-YOURSELF SERVICE.

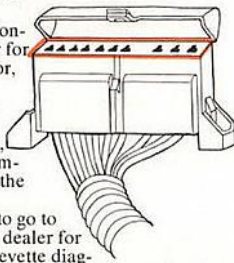
When you buy a 1976 Chevette you also receive a miniature service manual with instructions on how to perform minor service work yourself. Very practical. Can be very cost saving.



BUILT-IN DIAGNOSTIC CONNECTOR. Do-it yourselfers can diagnose the following functions of Chevette's electrical system: High Energy Ignition primary circuit, and the complete cranking system including the ignition switch operation and neutral start switch.

The available Four-Season air conditioning also has its own diagnostic connector for checking voltage at the blower motor, low blower contacts at relay, high blower relay coil, the resistor, the air conditioning system voltage, the control to the compressor circuit and the compressor.

If you prefer to go to your Chevrolet dealer for service, the Chevette diagnostic connectors can help the mechanic diagnose functions accurately and quickly.



FINGERTIP "SMART SWITCH."

Chevette's new Smart Switch, located within fingertip reach on the steering column, lets you activate the turn signals, headlight dimmer, windshield wipers and washers, and lane-changing/"flash-to-pass" signal.

Chevette Coupe.

This is the basic economy version of our four-passenger Chevette lineup. But don't let its low price sticker imply we've skimped on quality and features. Standard is the efficient 1.4-litre 4-cylinder OHC engine, along with wall-to-wall carpeting, full-width hatch with dual supports, fold-down rear seat, glove compartment, bright bumpers and trim mouldings, acoustical insulation, and more.



Chevette Sport Coupe.

If you like your car to have a trim, sporty appearance, this version was designed for you. Bold sport stripes, black accents plus all the standard features of the coupe, including your choice of 14 bright exterior colours.



Chevette Rally Coupe.

This car looks like a performer, and it has the special equipment to do it. Standard are the larger 1.6-litre 4-cylinder OHC engine, special suspension with rear stabilizer bar, special instrumentation with tachometer and temperature gauge, sport shifter, sport steering wheel and passenger assist grip. Special identification, Rally-style wheel covers and black rocker panels give this Chevette a look all its own.



Chevette Woody Coupe.

The Woody has the stylish look of a mini-Estate wagon. It has wood-grain vinyl exterior trim, a Custom Interior with wood-grain vinyl accents on the instrument cluster, a sport steering wheel and day-night rearview mirror. Included, too, are bright window mouldings, wheel trim rings and a deluxe grille with bright accents.

EXTERIOR COLOURS. For any of the above Chevettes, choose from antique white, silver, light blue metallic, dark blue metallic, lime green, bright yellow, cream, burnt orange, medium orange, firethorn metallic, light red, black, dark green metallic and buckskin.

Chevette Scooter.



Introducing the Scooter, our lowest priced Chevette and a new kind of all-purpose, economy car just right for today's needs like shopping, commuting and pleasure driving. It has two full foam-cushioned front bucket seats (a rear seat can be ordered), efficient 1.4-litre 4-cylinder OHC engine and synchronized 4-Speed manual transmission. There's less standard equipment than on the Chevette, but Scooter's price is less, too.

SCOOTER COLOURS. Select from light blue, antique white, cream and light red.

What it's like inside Chevette.

Just because Chevette Coupe is economical in price and efficient in size doesn't mean its interior has to be less comfortable, less attractive than you want your car to be. Take a look at the front seats. They're thick foam, contoured buckets for comfort and support. The front retractors for the combination seat-and-shoulder belt are hidden in the body pillar rather than on the floor or on the roof panel. Inertia-type seat locks* securely hold the backrest in a sudden stop but allow easy entry into the rear seat.

Also, the rear seat† is full width with thick foam cushions. Front and rear seats are upholstered in soft vinyl in your choice of black, dark blue, light buckskin or

dark firethorn.

Other standard features inside the Chevette Coupe include: generous head, shoulder and hip room for four passengers; flow-

through ventilation; built-in heater/defroster; choice of accent colours for the instrument panel, cowl panels and carpeting*; and a specially designed steering wheel that helps provide visibility for all instrumentation.

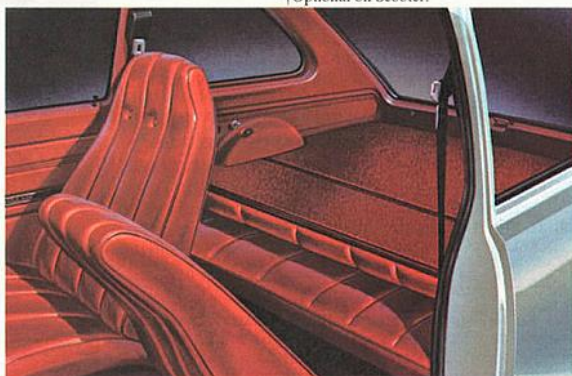
The instrument panel is cluster-designed for easy viewing with a speedometer that indicates both miles per hour and kilometers per hour, a fuel gauge, and warning lights for temperature, generator and oil pressure. (Special instrumentation with tachometer and temperature gauge is available.)

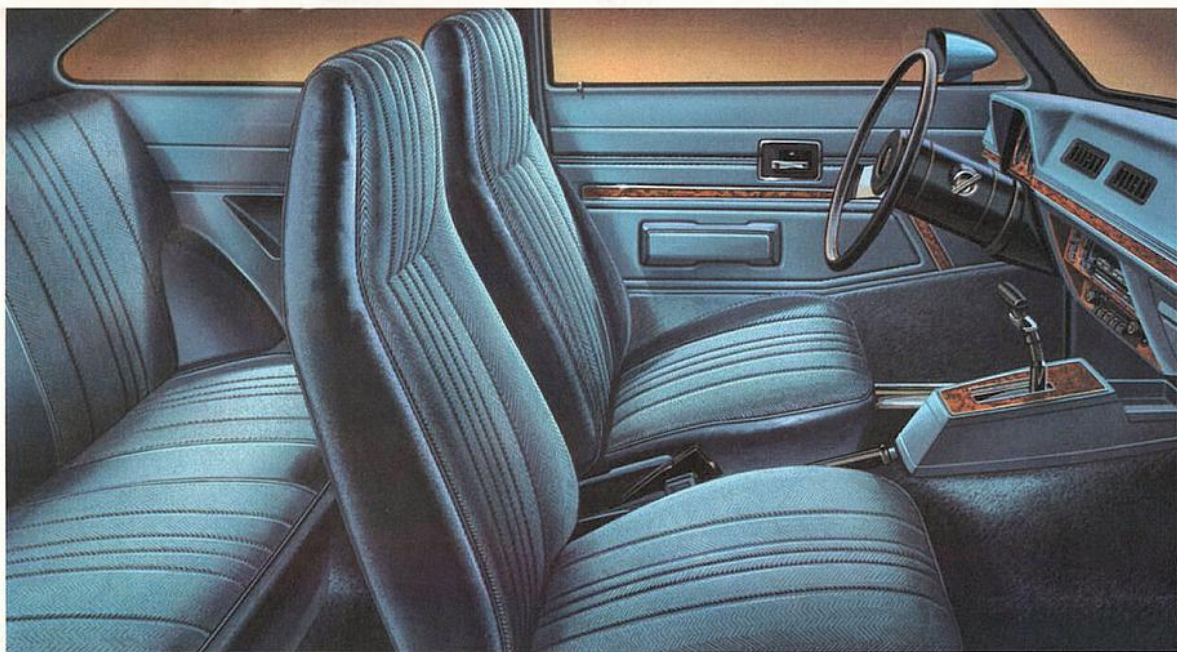

A floor-mounted 4-Speed manual transmission is standard. The colour-keyed carpeting is standard, too, on Chevette Coupe (a luxury usually not found in small, economy cars). There's even a glove compartment with a latch-type door.



The rear seat on Chevette Coupe folds down to give a roomy wagon-like area for carrying larger items. There's also out-of-sight storage under the easily removed floor panel, where the spare tire is hidden from view.



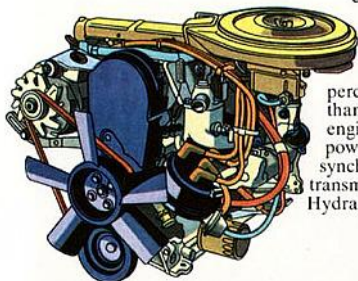
If you like the special touch of added comfort and beauty, Chevette's Custom Interior is right for you. The seats are available in new rattan-pattern all-vinyl in black, light buckskin, dark blue, dark firethorn or white. Or choose Rutledge sport cloth-and-vinyl in black, light buckskin, dark blue or dark firethorn. Also included: deluxe door trim, wood-grain vinyl accents on the instrument cluster, sport steering wheel, day-night rearview mirror, colour-keyed carpeting for the cargo area and added acoustical insulation.

The Scooter interior is a basic 2-passenger design with roomy rear area cargo space. Standard upholstery choices are all-vinyl or cloth-and-vinyl; floor coverings are rubber mats; the glove box is an open compartment.



What you can add to Chevette.

Chevrolet offers a wide selection of available options to personalize your new Chevette. Some are described here and there are more on the back cover. Availability often depends on the model and other equipment selected. Your Chevrolet dealer can answer any questions, particularly for Scooter.



1.6-LITRE 4-CYLINDER OHC ENGINE. This new, single over-head-cam engine produces about 15 percent greater horsepower than the standard 1.4-litre engine for an SAE net horsepower rating of 60. The fully synchronized 4-Speed manual transmission is standard. Turbo Hydramatic is available.

TURBO HYDRA-MATIC TRANSMISSION. Shifts automatically through three speed ranges or may be shifted manually. Tunnel-mounted shift lever.



SPORT STEERING WHEEL. Vinyl-covered with cushioned centre. Included with the available Rally equipment and available Custom Interior.



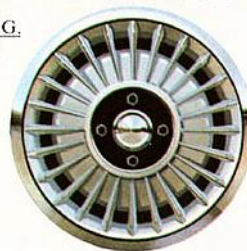
TWIN SPORT MIRRORS. Body-coloured. Both can be adjusted from inside the car by remote control.

AM/FM RADIO. An AM radio and a rear seat speaker are also available. All radio equipment is Delco-designed for Chevette.

ELECTRIC REAR WINDOW DEFROSTER. Electrically clears the large rear window of mist and steam.

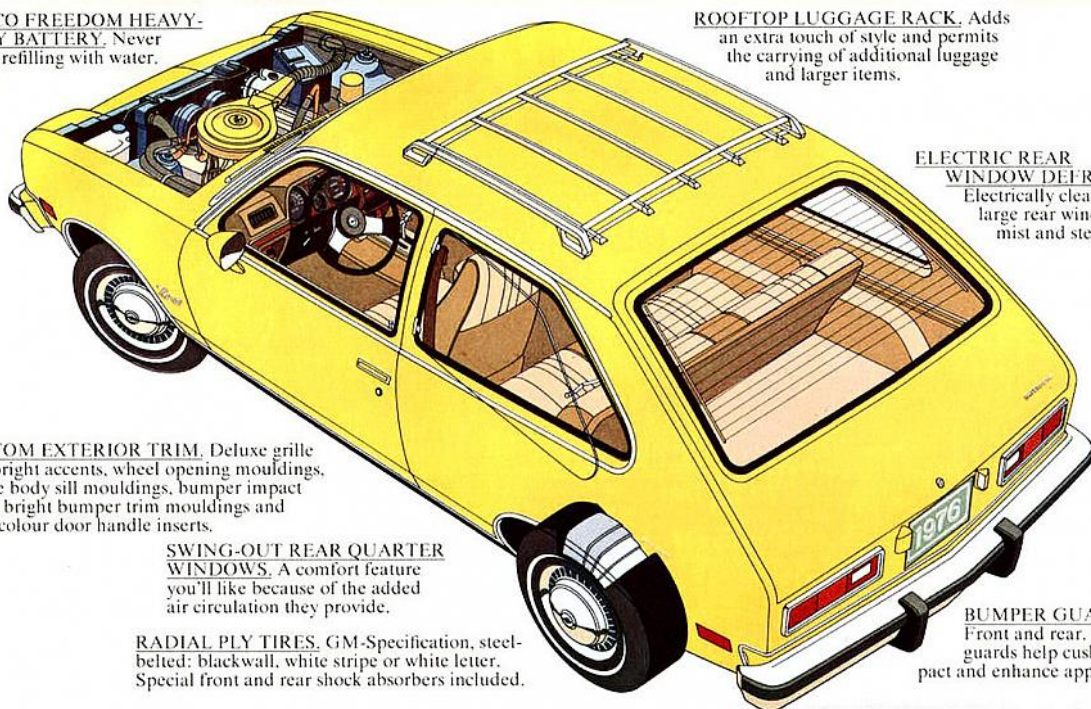
