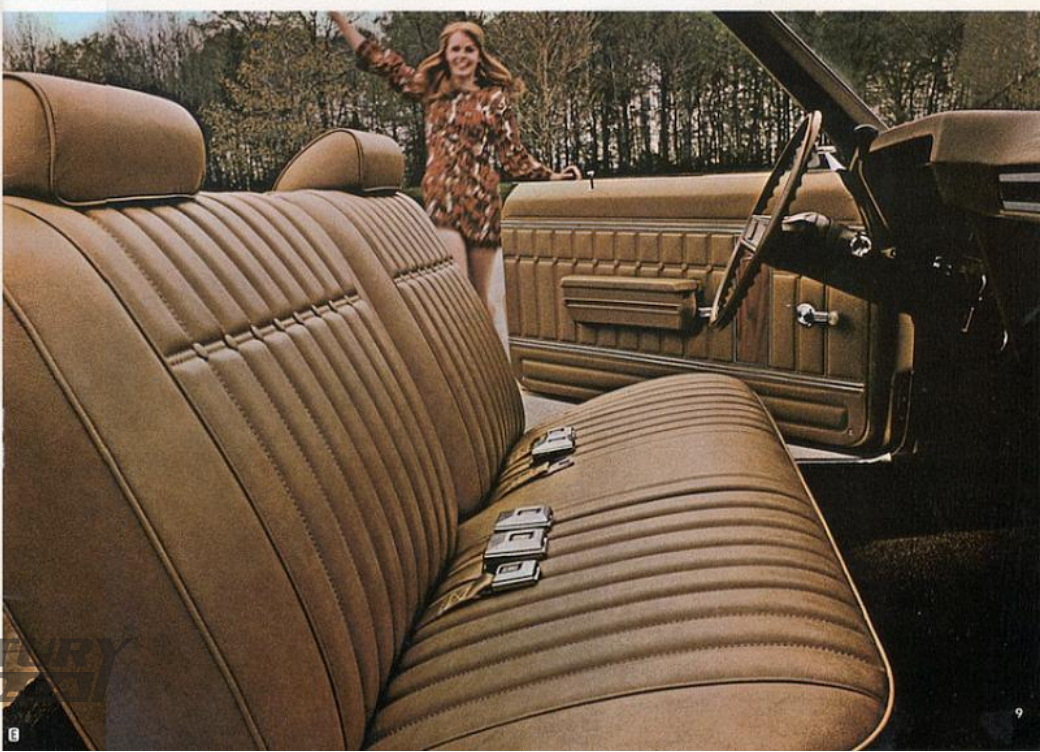

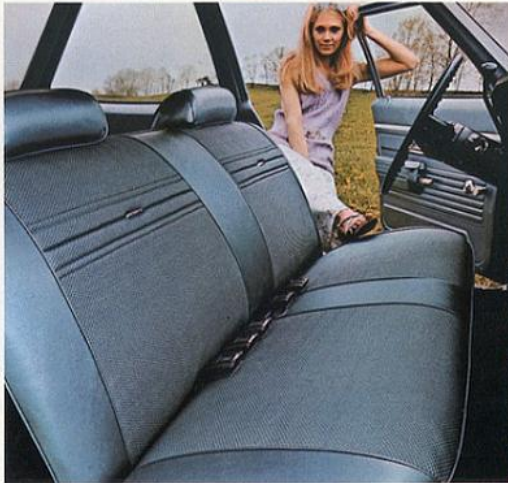

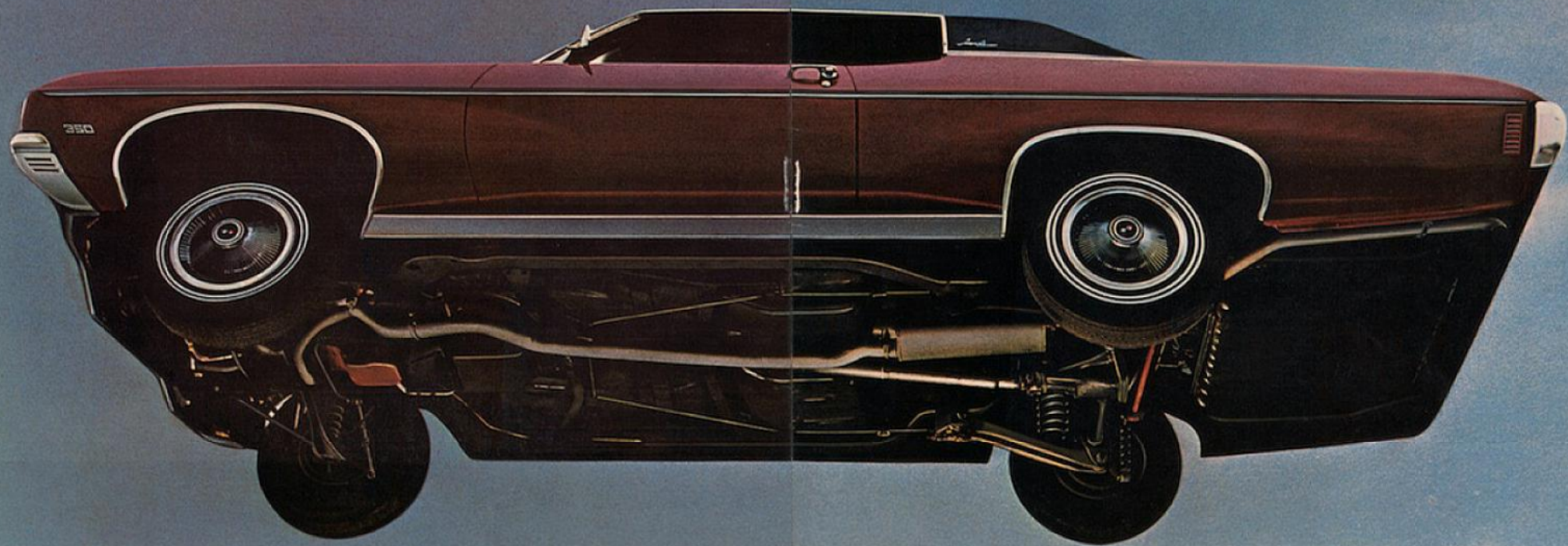

And with complete up-and-down control.

Then you get still more.

Precise Ball-Race steering.

Built-in leveling of acceleration and braking forces.

No more rocking-chair ride.

Then, a rugged, perimeter-type frame. It's not only strong, but the basis for your Big Chevrolet's low centre of gravity.

Not only that, but the wheels sit wider apart than ever before. For broad-base stability.

Your Body by Fisher is secured to the frame by up to fourteen mounting and cushioning points to isolate your ride from the road even more.

One other thing. The 119-inch wheelbase. It's very big on smooth rides.

Your maintenance is down . . . your longevity is up.

You'll be pleased at how easy your Chevrolet is to get along with.

Without even asking (or paying extra) you get an awful lot of thoughtful features that keep your Chevrolet looking nicer for longer with a minimum of maintenance.

Improved long-life exhaust system

Now a big part of the exhaust system is aluminum.

And what that means to you is your engine's silent partner will last longer.

Fenders inside fenders

Beneath every fender you see is another. It's the steel one inside that takes the beating from road salt, grime, sludge and slush.

Not the fender you see.

Flush-and-dry rocker panels

Water (rain, car wash) flushes out your rocker panel area below the doors. Salt and road grime go down the drain — a special outlet at the rear.

Then a flow of air dries out the rocker panels as you drive.

You hardly know that anything has happened, until you look for the rust. And don't find it.

Self-adjusting Safety-Master brakes, corrosion-resistant brake lines

The brakes adjust themselves which means you don't have to pay to have it done. And the brake lines resist corrosion.

You can build your own Chevrolet. For convenience, luxury, or just for fun.

Every Big Chevrolet comes with a lot of great standard equipment and features.

But as you might want to order something more. Add a luxury here, an extra convenience there. You name it:

A. New Headlight Delay System. With this delayed action headlight switch your headlights will stay on for about two minutes after you leave your car.

Long enough for you to get where you're going. Securely.

Then, of course, this special switch shuts them off. (There's a buzzer to automatically remind you if you leave your key in the ignition with headlights on — day or night).

B. New Finger-tip Windshield Washer Control. Select any of four programmed wash-and-wipe or wipe-only cycles with an easy-to-reach button on your turn signal lever.

Without taking your eyes off the road.

How you push the button with your finger tip determines which cycle you select.

You can also order a new windshield washer fluid monitor — available with Auxiliary Lighting — to remind you when to fill your washer reservoir. (Remember all the times you've pushed a wash button and didn't get so much as a squirt?)

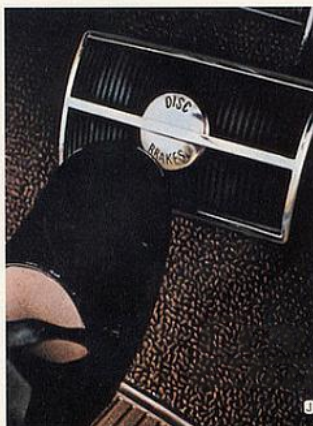
C. New Hidden Antenna. When you order a Chevrolet with factory installed radio or tinted windshield the antenna is embedded in the windshield glass.

D. New Electric Power Trunk Lock Release. Release your trunk lock from inside the car. Electrically.

E. New Electric Power Door Lock System. A control at both front doors electrically locks all doors automatically. (You can unlock them from there, too).

F. New Automatic Seat Back Latch Release. Say you're coming up to your Caprice or Impala Coupe with a big bag of groceries.

When you open your door both seat back latches are released.



Fold either front seat back forward for rear seat access with one hand and no unlatching.

(There's also a manual release for operation from inside the car).

Available when you order the new Electric Power Door Lock System.

G. New Stereo Tape System with AM/FM and FM Stereo Radio or AM Radio. You insert the tape cartridge right into the radio dial area. Goodbye separate tape player.

H. Variable-Ratio Power Steering. Makes your Big Chevrolet handle like a limousine on the straightaway; like a sports car on turns.

And that's the best way.

I. Four-Season Air Conditioning. Cool comfort in the hottest weather. Also available: one-setting, fully automatic Comforton. Both systems remove up to 98% of airborne dust and pollen.

J. Power Disc Brakes. Caliper-type (self-adjusting) disc brakes at the front wheels, Safety-Master (also self-adjusting) drum-type brakes, rear.

And both pairs are power-assisted for effortless, steady stopping.

(Standard on Caprice Coupe, Caprice Sport Sedan, Kingswood Estate Wagon and Impala Custom Coupe).

K. Electro-Clear Rear Window Defroster. Flick a switch. Electric heat defogs and defrosts your rear window.

Quickly, silently. Clearly, a desirable convenience (Caprice Coupe and Impala Custom Coupe only).

L. Comfortilt Steering Wheel. Tilts to seven different angular positions for different drivers. Comfortilt can be a great tension reliever on long, one-driver expressway trips, too.

Makes slipping in and out of the driver's seat as easy as it sounds.
