

Windsor Four-Door Hardtop


Subtle luxury...a Windsor interior feature



SIX DIPS SEAL OUT RUST FOR THE LIFE OF YOUR CHRYSLER—Chrysler's Unibody is dipped six times in rust-resistant chemicals and rinses. Every vital body part, both inside and outside, is coated with a tough protective shield that seals out rust, keeps your Chrysler showroom new for years and years.



PERMANENT CHASSIS LUBRICATION

Through advance lubricants and special seals, your 1962 Chrysler will require attention only at 32,000 mile intervals—roughly 3 years of normal driving.

4,000 MILES BETWEEN OIL CHANGES

No need to spend irksome time and money changing oil every 1,000 miles. The 1962 Chrysler has improved its lubrication system so that now you need change your oil only at 4,000 mile intervals.

NEW POWER BRAKES—Power brakes on the 1962 Chrysler have a new vacuum suspended unit that provides higher maximum power assist and permits easier access to the fluid reservoir. This means greater braking power than ever before as well as giving new safety protection against any kind of "brake fade."




TORSION-AIRE SUSPENSION

Torsion-Aire cushions bumps, prevents any dipping and swaying, and grips the road for greater stability on curves. This unique combination of torsion bars in the front, widely spaced leaf springs in the rear, and Chrysler Corporation's famous Oilflow shock absorbers all around, represents one of the most important automotive engineering achievements of the present day.

1. REMOTE-CONTROL OUTSIDE MIRROR—Move the control inside and the mirror moves outside to suit your angle of vision. This accessory is specially convenient if more than one person drives the car. (Standard on New Yorker. Optional on Windsor and Saratoga.)

2. CONSTANT-CONTROL POWER STEERING—Works like a dream to make driving easy, fingertip easy. Gives firm, accurate feel of the road. (Standard on New Yorkers. Optional on Windsor and Saratoga.)

4. POWER WINDOWS—You can control all four windows electrically from the driver's seat. Each passenger also has a control of his own. (Optional equipment.)



REAR VIEW MIRRORS—Chrysler Mirrors offer panoramic views of the road from inside or outside your car. Highly polished glass gives you freedom from distortion to assure maximum safety—day and night. Prismatic mirrors are also available.

REAR WINDOW DEFOGGERS—A full and safe view to the rear can be maintained in rainy or damp weather with a rear window defogger available on every Chrysler. A steady flow of air over the inside surface of the back window combats a tendency to "steam up."



SAFETY LOCKS—When "child-guard" rear door safety lock is in operation, the lever turns freely on the lock shaft and the door cannot be opened by the handle in the normal manner. Available on every Chrysler.



SAFETY BELTS—The Chryco safety belts available on every Chrysler surpass all established strength requirements and meet all SAE specifications. They ensure safe travel and confidence to both driver and passengers. Seat belt anchors are standard equipment.

TRANSMISSIONS—Pushbutton Torque-Flite, fully automatic torque converter with 3-speed gear set, standard.

SUSPENSION—Time-tested Torsion-A/RE suspension, standard. Ball-joint pivots (front) with Oriflow shock absorbers.

FUEL SYSTEM—Carburetors: dual down-draft on Windsor and Saratoga, four-barrel down-draft on New Yorker. Automatic intake manifold heat control, automatic choke, dual filtration units. Fuel capacity—19.1 Imperial gallons. 18.0 Imperial gallons for Town and Country Wagons.

Generator: 35 amps. for Windsor and Saratoga; 35 amp. alternator for New Yorker. Waterproof ignition. Electric windshield wipers and directional signals.

COOLING SYSTEM—Thermostatic by-pass control. Pressure vent radiator cap. Coolant capacity, 14.0 Imperial quarts.

BRAKES—Total-Contact with Cyclebonded lining. Drum diameters: 12" on New Yorker and all Town and Country Wagons, 11" on Windsor and Saratoga. Power brakes standard on New Yorker; available at extra cost on all Windsor and Saratoga models.

STEERING—Manual, worm and 3-tooth roller, standard on Windsor and Saratoga. Constant-Control power steering with quick 3 1/2 turns lock-to-lock, standard on New Yorker, available on Saratoga and Windsor.

DRIVE—Hotchkiss drive through rear springs. Hypoid rear axle with 2.76 to 1 ratio. (Windsor and Saratoga) (2.93 New Yorker).

WHEELS AND TIRES—Safety-Rim wheels. Standard tire sizes: Windsor and Saratoga—8.00 x 14, except Newport Town and Country Wagon, 8.50 x 14; New Yorker—8.50 x 14, except Town and Country Wagon, 9.00 x 14. Chrome stainless wheel covers standard.
