Handy Tips for the Handylady of the House

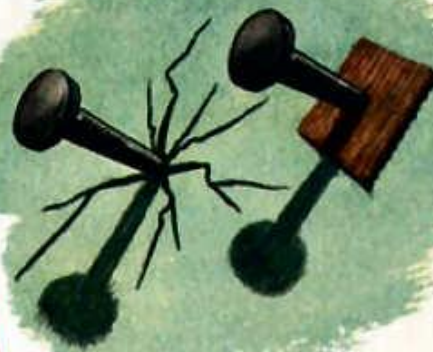
HOLD NAILS SAFELY

Here's an easy way to hold a nail in a hard-to-reach position: put the nail in a slotted piece of cardboard. Rest the cardboard in position and drive nail part way in. Remove strip—finish driving nail.



SURFACE PROTECTION

You can avoid damage to the face of the wood when pulling nails if you will place a pad of cloth or rubber under the hammer head. This cushion will prevent dents or mars in the finish.



NAILING IN PLASTER

Nails will drive into plaster without cracking the surface if you'll remember to stick a piece of masking tape or scotch tape over the spot where you intend to drive the nail. Remove tape after nail has been driven in.

HANDY STORAGE FOR LITTLE THINGS

A row of large-mouth screw top jars, hung under a shelf with a nail through the lid, makes ideal storage for little things like screws, nails, rubber bands, pins, etc. Peanut butter or mayonnaise jars are handy for this.

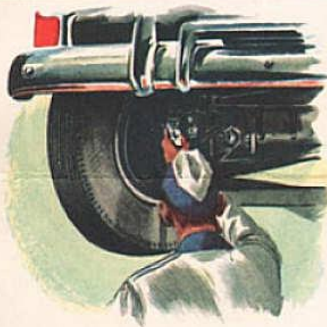

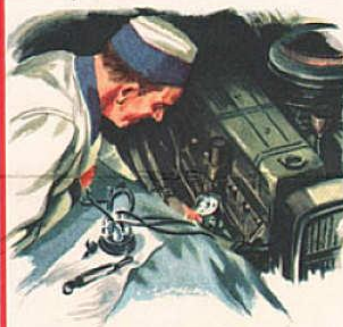
