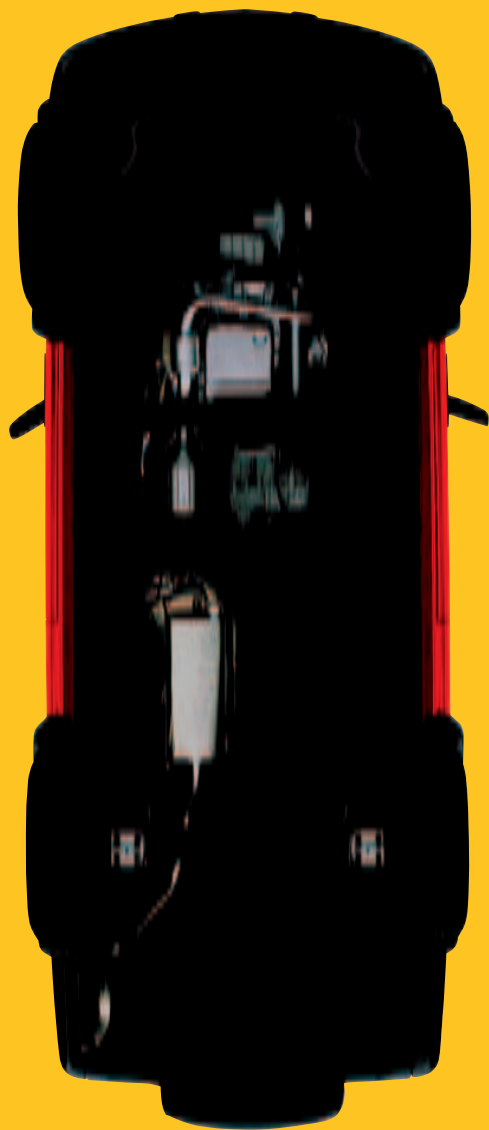
• **VORTEC 4300 V6 ENGINE**

Blazer's standard 190 horsepower Vortec 4300 V6 engine combines smooth power and the torque required for serious hauling. With 250 lb.-ft. of torque, even a heavily loaded Blazer gets off the line with ease.



• **AUTOTRAC SYSTEM**

The available Autotrac 4x4 system offers the driver the choice of operating in an automatically controlled four-wheel-drive mode or the traditional 2HI, 4HI or 4LO manual functions, depending on personal preferences and driving conditions. A Neutral setting is also included.



■ Technology **STRONG WHERE IT COUNTS.**

With a rigid steel ladder frame, Blazer is certainly very solid in this department. And strength is added in the boxed side rails to provide support where it's needed most. The result? A compact SUV with oversized capabilities.

LESS MAINTENANCE

Blazer includes a series of long-life features, like platinum-tipped spark plugs that are designed to last 166,000 km,* and Dexron-III automatic transmission fluid that has a lifespan of 83,000 km.* In addition, the serpentine accessory drive belt has a self-adjusting belt tensioner that is designed to extend its life to 166,000 km,* and the DEX-Cool engine coolant lasts 5 years or 240,000 km.*

PASSLock THEFT-DETERRENT SYSTEM

Standard on Blazer is the PASSLock passive theft-deterrent system. If the correct key is not used, or the ignition lock cylinder is tampered with, the fuel system is disabled.

STEEL LADDER-TYPE FRAME

The frame's boxed side rails provide additional strength where it's needed most.

AUTOMATIC EXTERIOR LIGHT CONTROL

When ambient lighting conditions change, Blazer turns the driving lights on or off automatically, for added safety and convenience.

CORROSION-RESISTANT BODY PANELS

Two-sided galvanized steel is used on all exterior body panels, except the roof, to help prevent corrosion.

STAINLESS STEEL EXHAUST SYSTEM

An aluminized stainless steel exhaust system is designed to resist corrosion and help enhance the system's durability and lifespan.

STANDARD FOUR-WHEEL DISC BRAKES WITH ABS

Blazer features four-wheel disc brakes with an anti-lock braking system (ABS). It helps you maintain steering control during hard braking, even on most slippery surfaces.

RETAINED ACCESSORY POWER

Power features, such as windows and the sound system, will continue to operate for up to 20 minutes after the ignition is turned off and the key removed, thanks to retained accessory power.

4.3L VORTEC V6 ENGINE

The standard 190 hp Vortec 4300 V6 features multi-port fuel injection (MPFI), helping the engine deliver excellent performance, as well as smooth, dependable operation and quick cold-weather starts.

SECOND-GEAR START

The standard four-speed automatic transmission provides a second-gear start feature. It reduces torque for more controlled acceleration in slippery conditions.

4x4 TRACTION

The standard 4x4 system allows you to shift on the fly from 2WD to 4x4 HI and back, with just the push of a button. The available Autotrac system adds an automatic four-wheel-drive function, in addition to the traditional 2HI, 4HI, Neutral and 4LO settings.

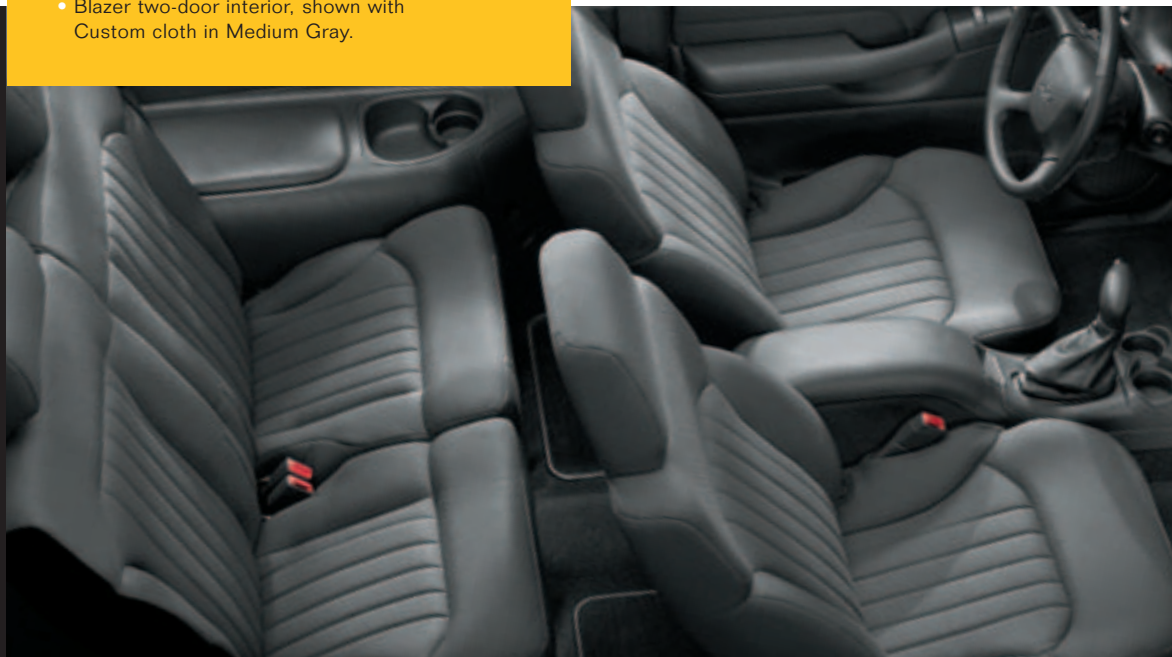
