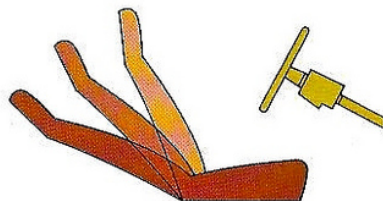

Sportwagon country is most anywhere you want to drive.

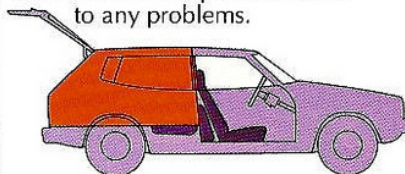
FLAT-LOADING WAGON.

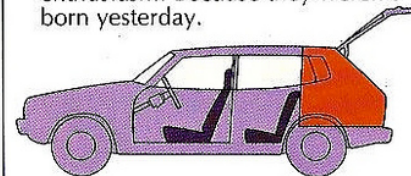

FLAT-OUT FUN FOR THE FAMILY.

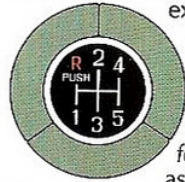
There's a load of sportiness to match the haulability. For starters, front wheel drive helps deliver sure traction and slick handling. Then great features like a big rear deck with an easy-open liftgate combine to bring you a totally delightful performance package.

5-SPEED PERFORMANCE.

You've heard of 3-speed shifts. And 4-speed shifts. Well, the new F-10 brings you a fully synchromesh 5-speed standard. This front-mounted transaxle (gearbox and differential combined) is tailored to the engine's torque curve and paired with a slow-turning 3.47 final drive ratio. The end result is excellent economy plus performance.

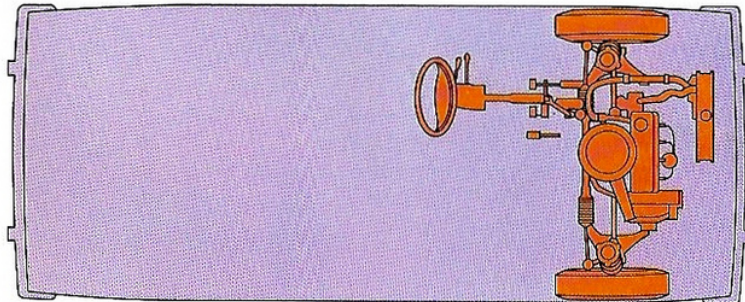


A low first gear gets you off the dime quick. The next four gears—count 'em, four more—shift slick as you accelerate. Close ratios keep engine revolutions up at efficient levels for maximum response.

FRONT WHEEL DRIVE & TRANSVERSE-MOUNTED ENGINE.

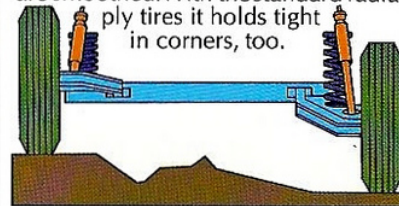
For certain cars, front wheel drive is the only way to go. It helps deliver bonuses in traction and handling. Now Datsun engineering brings you a highly refined front wheel drive to pull you through the tightest maneuvers.

We put the engine crossways to save room. It's located directly over the front axle for maximum weight on the driving wheels. So you enjoy excellent traction and stability.



FULLY INDEPENDENT SUSPENSION.

Our little Hatchback offers a smooth ride. All four wheels react individually to whatever the road dishes out. Bumps are smoothed. With the standard radial ply tires it holds tight in corners, too.



COMFORT, CONTROL, CONVENIENCE.

Looking for comfort you can relish? Slip into the fully reclining highback bucket seats. Luxuriate in soft vinyl upholstery. (It even covers the door panels.) Treat your toes to nappy nylon carpeting.

Tinted glass all around tempers the heat and lets the flow-through fresh air system work to best advantage. A resettable trip odometer, tachometer and pushbutton AM/FM radio are also standard equipment.

HANDY HATCH & OTHER STANDARDS.

The F-10 hatch gives your loads a wide welcome. It opens easily, stays up on two gas-filled supports. A simple flip of the rear seat gives you 23.3 cu. ft. of flat floor space for an amazing assortment of wagon type loads.

Electric Rear Window Defogger. Tiny electrical wires attached to the hatch window are heated to dissipate condensation.

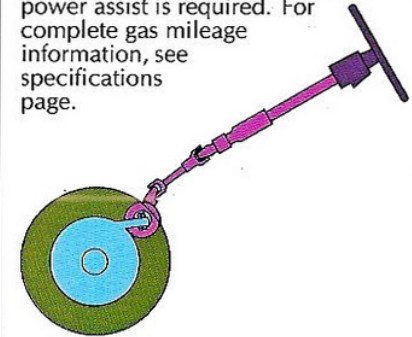
Power Assisted Front Disc/Rear Drum Brakes. You get sure, straight stops. And in emergencies a diagonal twin circuit system brakes on both sides, front and rear.



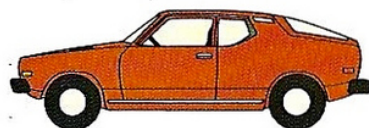
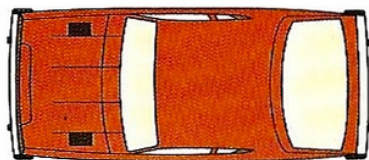
RACK AND PINION STEERING.

Since both propulsion and steering are done by the front wheels, the F-10 uses a proven rack and pinion steering system. Similar to that employed on Datsun's famous 280-Z. This simple, efficient device delivers precise, easy control for freeway maneuvering and shopping center parking.

With its 18:1 ratio and 3.2 turns lock-to-lock, the F-10's rack and pinion works so efficiently that no power assist is required. For complete gas mileage information, see specifications page.



DATSUN F-10 SPECIFICATIONS



Fuel System: Two-barrel, downdraft carburetor. Mechanical diaphragm fuel pump. Paper element type air cleaner and fuel filter. Fuel tank capacity 10.6 gal. (9.2 gal. Sportwagon).

Electrical System: 12V, 60 Amp/Hr. battery, 50A alternator, magnetic shift starter motor. (Transistorized ignition system — California.)

Lubrication System: Full pressure feed, full flow cartridge type oil filter and trochoid gear type oil pump. Oil capacity 3.4 quarts.

Clutch: Dry single plate, diaphragm-spring. Hydraulic control.

Transaxle: 5-speed manual. (4-speed Sportwagon.) All synchromesh on forward gears, with floor gearshift.

Suspension and Axle: Front: Independent strut type with coil springs, tension rods, telescopic shock absorbers and stabilizer bar. Rear: Hatchback: Independent trailing arm. Sportwagon: Semi-floating rear axle. Semi-elliptic leaf springs with shock absorbers.

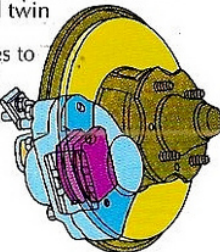

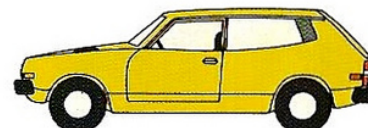
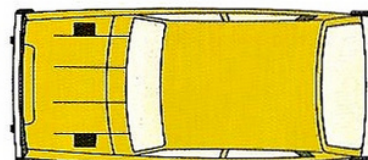

Body: All steel unibody construction with crush zones, front and rear. Full vinyl upholstery. Laminated anti-glare windshield glass. Tempered tinted side window glass. Lift-up rear hatch on Hatchback, liftgate on Sportwagon.

Instruments: Variable illumination of control knobs and instruments. Speedometer with odometer and resettable trip odometer. Tachometer and electric clock (Hatchback). Temperature gauge. Engine oil pressure warning light. High beam warning light. EGR, parking and brake system warning light.

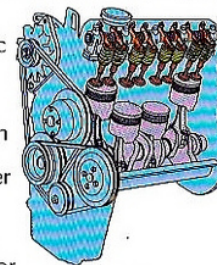
