Ford's new contoured frame puts passengers within the frame rails for greater protection. Gives greater leg-room for rear-seat passengers.



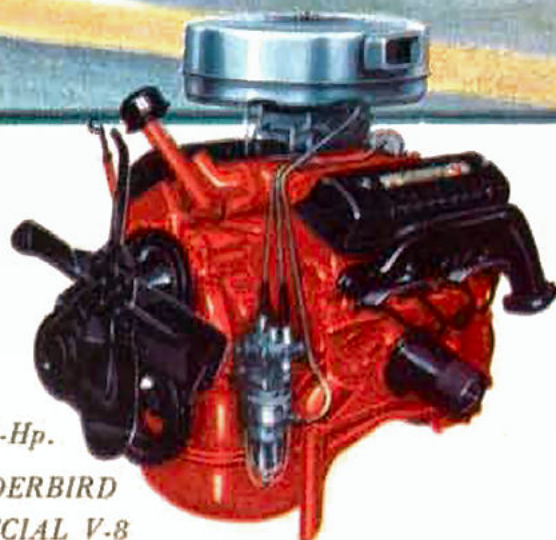
Spectacular performance—heart of the new Inner Ford

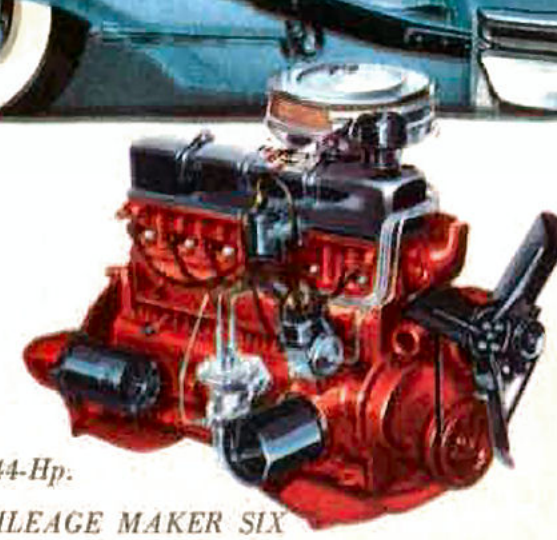

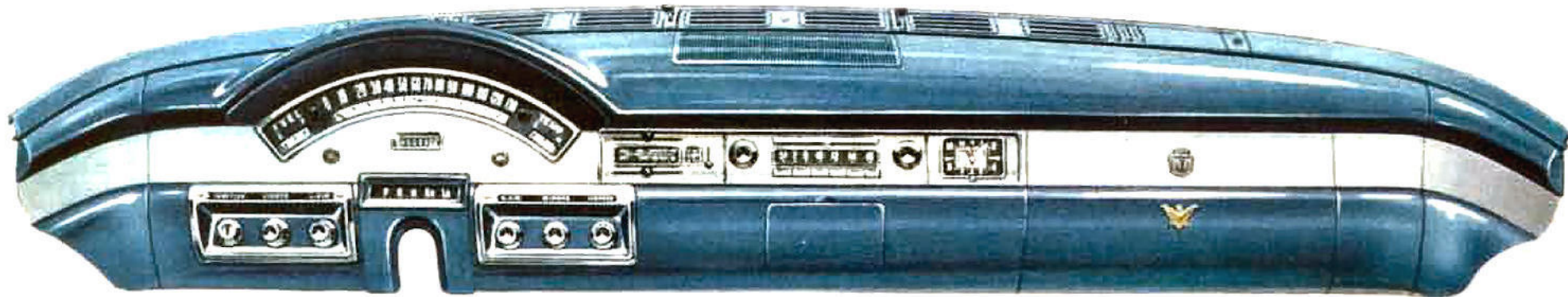
