Available for either XL is the optional 7-Litre Sports Package. It comes with a 428-cu. in. V-8, 4-barrel carburetor, hydraulic lifters, special dual, low-restriction exhaust, power front disc brakes, Wide-Oval Sports Tires, special suspension system and simulated wood-grain sports steering wheel. Get the optional 4-speed stick for 100% manual shifting, or SelectShift Cruise-O-Matic for manual *with* automatic. For luxury there is the Stereo-Sonic Tape System, power steering, power windows and the Convenience Control Panel.



Fingertip Speed Control, built into turn signal lever, lets you set speed (from 25 to 80 mph) and cruise with your foot off the accelerator. At all times you can override the control by braking or accelerating. Afterward, control's built-in "memory" returns car to your pre-selected speed—automatically.

Power Seats (both full-width and bucket models) give you 6-way adjustment at a touch of the seat-side switch: up, down, forward and back, and tilt up or down. In addition to the great selection of optional sizes in standard models, there are these special "Tailored Tires": Wide-Oval Sports Tires,* which put more tread on the road for better traction and handling, give a car a low, sporty look; Radial Ply Tires—a Ford exclusive—run cooler than conventional ply tires and deliver substantially greater tread wear; White Sidewall Tires add their own touch of smartness to any new Ford.





Convenience Control Panel groups all these: warning lights to tell you when a door is ajar, to remind you to fasten seat belts, when fuel is low (down to four gallons) or that parking brake is engaged. Also included (at right side of panel) is a control switch for Power Door Locks, which locks or unlocks all doors instantly at your touch.

New Comfort-Stream Ventilation (standard on LTD's) draws in fresh air at the cowl, continuously forces smoke, stale air out through special vents in each front door. All this while you ride in Ford quiet with windows up! Three-speed blower in the system increases air volume as desired. Adjustable outlets in instrument panel.




Twice-a-Year Maintenance

'67 Fords are designed to go 6,000 miles (or 6 months) between oil changes and minor chassis lubrications; 36,000 miles (or 3 years, whichever comes first) between major chassis lubes. Other '67 Ford service-savers include: 36,000-mile (or 2-year) engine coolant-antifreeze, self-adjusting brakes, long-life Sta-Ful battery, shielded alternator, rust- and corrosion-resistant aluminized muffler, galvanized underbody parts.

PRICES: Heater-defroster is included as standard equipment on all models. However, heater-defroster may be deleted on car order if desired at an appropriate price reduction (except LTD or with Comfort-Stream Ventilation). All power assists, optional equipment and accessories as well as some items illustrated or referred to as options, optional or available are at extra cost. For the price of the Ford model you desire, consult your Ford Dealer.

Double-Yoke Safety Door Latches and Safety Hinges are strong, tight-gripping to help keep doors closed in the event of impact. Positive Door Lock Buttons must be raised, disengaging the locks, before door handles will operate and doors can be opened.



Impact-Absorbing Steering Wheel with Deep-Padded Hub adds importantly to safety of the driver. Conveniently placed on the steering column are (right side) switch for 4-Way Emergency Flasher and (left side) new Turn Signal Lever with Lane-Changing Signal Feature to indicate movements from one lane to another on the highway.



Dual Hydraulic Brake System with Warning Light. Dual master cylinder plus separate lines to front and rear brakes provides extra protection. In event one line is damaged, other remains to provide partial braking while red light on instrument panel warns driver of need for service.



Thick-Laminate Safety Plate Glass Windshield, new Padded Windshield Pillars on either side, Padded Sun Visors overhead and Padded Instrument Panel combine to provide an added measure of protection for driver and passengers.

*Every 6 months or 6,000 miles: Change oil and oil filter; clean air cleaner; air cleaner oil filter; check transmission oil levels. Every 12 months or 12,000 miles: Replace air filter on closed crankcase ventilation system; clean emission system and carburetor spacer; replace emission system and carburetor gaskets; inspect and repair exhaust system. Change engine coolant and check radiator hoses. Every 26 months or 36,000 miles: Replace air filter on open crankcase ventilation system; adjust automatic transmission bands; lubricate steering linkage and ball joints; clean and repack front wheel bearings.

Ford Motor Company's 3-Point Warranty Plan

1. 5-year or 50,000-mile warranty on car power train, steering, and suspension.
2. 2-year or 24,000-mile warranty on the entire car.
3. Only one dealer certification per year regardless of how many miles you drive.

FORD MOTOR COMPANY NEW VEHICLE WARRANTY BASIC FACTS Ford Motor Company warrants to owners that their selling Ford dealer (or if owner is traveling or has moved, any Ford dealer), using genuine new Ford or Ford authorized reconditioned parts, will repair or replace, free of charge including related labor, the following parts in Ford-built vehicles which are found, in normal use and within the following time and mileage limits (whichever comes first) to be defective in either workmanship or materials: (A) Any part of any vehicle within 24 months or 24,000 miles, and (B) power train parts in any car or light truck, and suspension or steering parts in any car (except Broncos), within 5 years or 50,000 miles (4,000 miles or 90 days on Cobra 427 V-8 engines and related power train components).

Power train parts include: engine block, head and internal parts, water pump, intake manifold, transmission cases and internal parts, torque converter, driveshafts, universal joints, differentials, and driving axles and their wheel bearings. Suspension and steering parts include all parts of the front and rear suspension systems, steering gear and linkage, power steering pump, road wheels and front wheel bearings and seals. Related items such as ignition, electrical, cooling, fuel and brake systems, engine or transmission controls or linkages, steering column and wheel, clutch assembly, shock absorbers or load leveling system are excluded. The owner is required to obtain certain maintenance services* and, every 12 months, a written certification from Ford or Lincoln-Mercury dealer that he has presented evidence that such services have been performed.

The warranty does not apply to tires or tubes (adjustments are provided by tire companies), or to normal maintenance services or normal replacement of service parts such as filters, spark plugs, ignition points, wiper blades or brake or clutch linings, or to normal deterioration of soft trim, appearance items, hoses, belts or molded rubber or rubber-like items.

The warranty applies to vehicles normally operated in the U.S.A. and Canada.
