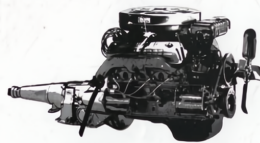

Each '62 Ford (Galaxie or Wagon) goes 30,000 miles between lubrication of major chassis components, such as suspension, steering linkage, front wheel bearings and universal joints. '62 Fords have a new 30,000-mile fuel filter plus a new coolant, which means normally no need to change permanent antifreeze for two years or 30,000 miles, whichever comes first. And Ford's superscreening Full-Flow oil filter lets you drive 6,000 miles between oil changes; you also go 6,000 miles between minor lubs. This means the average Ford owner will normally need to see his Ford Dealer only twice a year for the maintenance and routine inspections which Ford Dealers can best provide.

GALAXIE SEDAN POPULAR OPTIONS

For Galaxie owners who want top economy, the standard Mileage Maker Six is recommended. Those who want performance can have it as lively as they like with the Thunderbird 292 and 352 Special, both regular gas V-8's, or the brilliant Thunderbird 390 Special. (New for '62 are the "390" High-Performance and Super High-Performance V-8's with up to 401 hp. Your Ford Dealer has the details.) Most favored transmission option is Fordomatic, with dual-range Cruise-O-Matic and gas-stretching Overdrive available with most engines. Almost automatic choices are MagicAire Heater and Console Range Radio. (For all '62 Ford options and accessories, see pages 18-21.)

New Ford 6-passenger wagons feature the newest, quickest and easiest-folding second seat in the wagon world! To convert it, simply (1) release dual safety latch (which operates from either side of the car to save you steps). (2) Push the seat forward and over on top of the cushion. (A torsion bar assist makes this child's play . . . helps you again when you raise the seat.) Back plate slips neatly into place by itself, and you have flat, level loadspace from front seat to tailgate!

9-PASSENGER SEAT FOLD-DOWN

To convert Ford 9-passenger wagons, (1) rotate second seat cushion forward and lower support legs to rest squarely on floor. (2) Release safety latches behind seat back and flip down.

(Second seat is divided so one-third may be lowered to provide a "walk-through" to the rear and still leave two-thirds up for passengers.)

With second seat down, (3) simply slip out third seat foam cushions and flip down seat back. Loadspace provided totals 93½ cu. ft.—over 10 feet to end of open tailgate (over 8 feet with tailgate closed)!

SELECTAIRE CONDITIONER. Ford's all-in-one, air-conditioning-heating system. Provides the finest air conditioning available to cool, filter and dehumidify incoming fresh air. Capacity sufficient to pleasantly cool a five-room house. Three-speed blower. Adjustable selector provides precise control. Taking over for efficient cold-weather heating and defrosting, after simple adjustment, is the built-in heater. (With V-8's only.)



BACKUP LIGHTS AND BUMPER GUARDS. Many Ford owners pair these two options. Backup lights, centered in Ford's big, circular taillights, illuminate drive path for safer, easier night driving.
