




Comfortable AS A LIMOUSINE!




Full Wheel Covers have a classic simplicity that complements the classic beauty of your Thunderbird. Made of stainless steel, they are durable and easy to clean.



Exclusive pre-heated carburetor air system and water-jacketed intake manifold keep the fuel-air mixture at ideal temperature level for maximum combustion efficiency. 

superhighway speeds. A "D₂" setting lets you start in intermediate for sure-footed acceleration on ice or gravel. You can move into "L" position for effective engine braking at any driving speed. And with gas-saving rear axle ratio, you get "built-in" overdrive economy.

Overdrive (for 300-hp engine only) saves gas while it saves your engine, especially on long trips. It is a combination of standard 3-speed transmission and an automatic fourth gear, allowing the engine to loaf while the car is traveling at higher touring speeds.



The convertible offers you the best in weatherproof soft tops—two in soil-resistant, satin-grained vinyl and one in fade-resistant rayon.

- ② Black rayon with black lining
- ③ Light blue vinyl-clad with black lining

These numbers as well as the color symbols correspond to those identified in the upholstery chart. In this way all exterior and interior colors are harmoniously color-keyed.

Super-Filter air cleaner, Full-Flow oil filtration, automatic choke, free-jetting overhead camshaft valves, hydraulic valve lifters. Cross-Flow cooling system with 180° thermostat. Engine electronically balanced under its own power for optimum smoothness.

350-hp Thunderbird 420 Special V-8 (optional) . . . 420-cu. in. displacement, 4.20" bore x 3.70" stroke, 16 valves, 4-barrel carburetor, dual exhaust, aluminized mufflers. Features preheated carburetor air induction system with Super-Filter air cleaner, water-jacketed direct-line intake manifold and in-block wedge-type combustion chambers, 16 valves, 4-barrel carburetor and steep-top pistons for exceptional performance and economy. Three-stage pressurized cooling system with 140° and 180° thermostats, Full-Flow oil filtration, automatic choke, free-jetting overhead aluminized valves with hydraulic valve lifters. Engine electronically balanced while operating under its own power for optimum smoothness.
