(A) LTD Country Squire Wagon

Good news for big wagon owners...from the Wagonmaster.

If you have a large family, love the outdoors or need a double-duty work-and-play vehicle, Ford can fix you up in style. For 1979, the Country Squire, LTD and LTD Custom 500 Wagon models have been completely redesigned. You can carry six people in comfort (eight with optional dual facing rear seats). There's

plenty of cargo capacity as well. With the second seat down you get a cargo volume index of 2 598¹ (91.7 cu. ft.). And even with the seats in use, there's space between the second and third seats for cargo storage. Standard power team is a 5.0 litre (302 CID) V-8 with variable venturi carburetor and SelectShift automatic transmission. Also standard are power steering, power front disc/rear drum

brakes, and steel-belted radial ply tires.

(A) LTD Country Squire Wagon. Shown in Dark Cordovan Metallic (8N), a new paint choice. In addition to its distinctive Cherrywood vinyl bodyside trim, the Country Squire has the Landau chrome-plated grille design, dual rectangular headlamps with wraparound parking lamps.

(B) LTD Wagon shown in Midnight Blue Metallic (3L). And for those of you who prefer a Tu-Tone color exterior, you may choose from 3 new Tu-Tone combinations. Also new for '79 are the distinctive grille and single rectangular headlamps.

(C) 3-Way Magic Doorgate, another Better Idea that originated with the Wagonmaster. It opens like a door (window up or

down) for close-up loading, or swings down like a platform (for tailgate picnic, as an example). Power tailgate window is standard.

(D) Dual Facing Rear Seats. An exclusive for Ford Wagons. Seats are longer than last year and legroom is improved. This option now includes a rear bumper step pad, carpeted footwell, and cargo light with courtesy switch (light and switch

FORD LTD WAGON INTERIORS

New standards of LTD luxury.

Here's wagon luxury you can feel as well as see. The LTD interior seat fabrics are rich looking. A case in point is the new Interior Luxury Group option offered on the Country Squire.

(A) Interior Luxury Group in velour cloth. The color is Dark Red (MD), one of the five choices in the Squire. Note the individually adjustable reclining split bench seats—each with its own center armrest. Other luxurious features of this option group include elegantly finished door panels with full length armrests and carpeted lower sections. Seat backs have assist straps and map pockets. Upper trim panels of the front and rear doors feature assist straps which are both functional and decorative. Also included in the group is a Luxury Sound Insulation Package, luxury carpeting, and Luxury Group Instrument Panel.

(B) DuraWeave vinyl trim. Shown in Cordovan (MY). DuraWeave is Ford's exclusive "wonder" fabric that looks and breathes like fine cloth but has the wear and cleaning characteristics of vinyl. This optional fabric is offered also in Dark Red, Medium Wedgewood Blue, Pine Green, and Camel with flight bench seat (shown) or split bench seats.

(C) LTD Wagon interior—bench seat. The standard LTD Wagon and Country Squire interior trim†† is all vinyl on a bench seat. Shown here in Pine Green (BR). For other color selections, see (B). LTD Custom 500 wagon standard interior bench seat (not shown) is available in cloth with vinyl upper bolster or all vinyl, in both blue and camel.

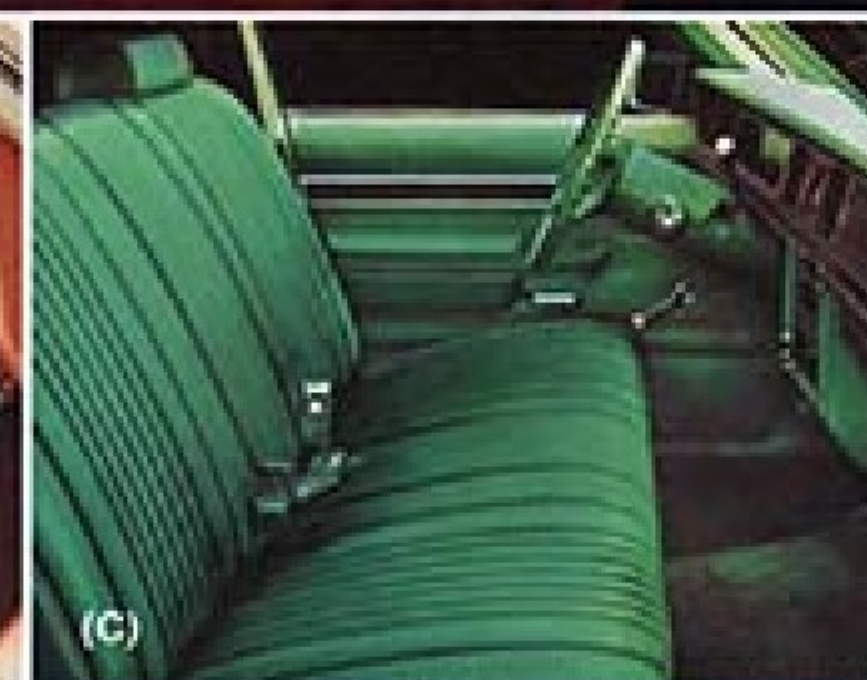
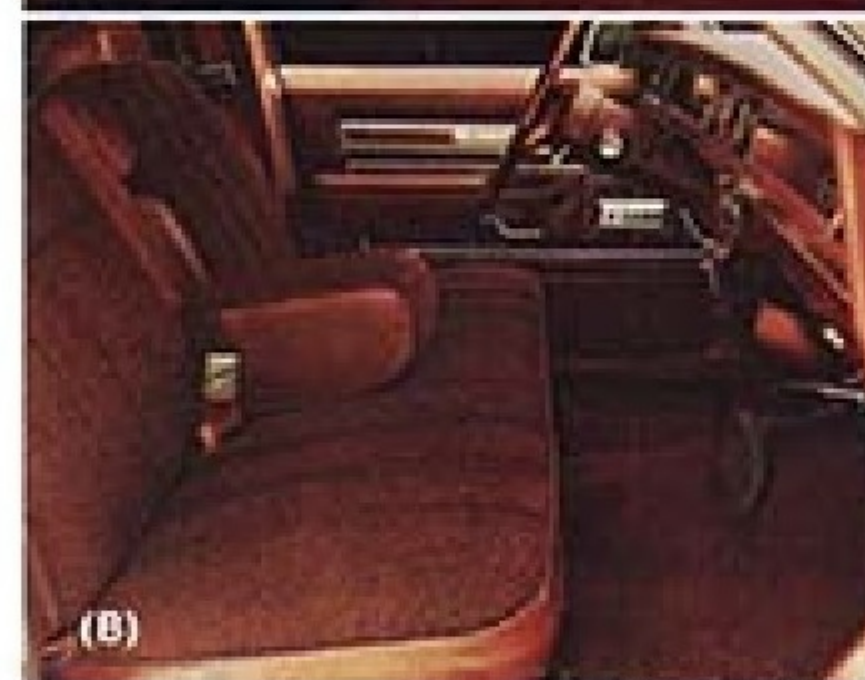

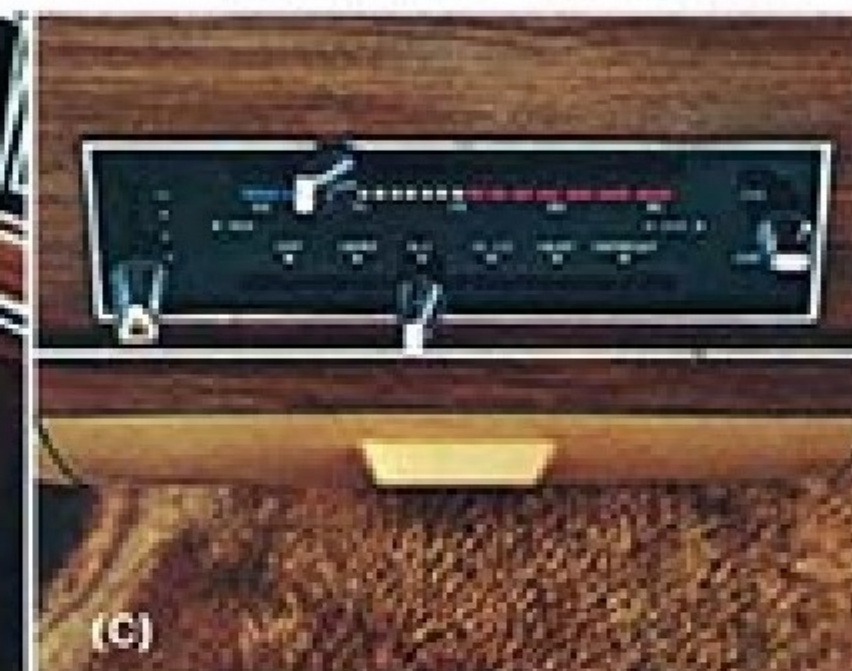

(A) Fairmont Squire

Another popular seller from the Wagonmaster.

The 5-passenger Fairmont 4-door wagon, built by Ford-North America's Wagonmaster—has a lot going for it. Fairmont Wagon's popularity stems from the fact that it offers so much for so little. Good, solid wagon attributes like space, convenience, comfort and style. With the rear seat folded down you get 2.241¹ (79.1 cu. ft.) of cargo space. The load platform is almost 2.1 m (7 ft.) long and up to

1.2 m (4 ft.) wide [914 mm (36 in.) between wheelhousings]. Altogether, Fairmont has a lot of space for passengers or cargo or both.

(A) Fairmont Squire. Shown in Burnt Orange Glow (5N), the Squire Option is the top of the Fairmont wagon line and offers our finest in looks and luxury. It features woodgrain vinyl bodyside and liftgate, woodtone rail surround, deluxe wheel covers, bright window frames, bright belt moldings, bright

LH outside mirror, hood ornament, Squire script and Interior Accent Group.

(B) Lockable storage box, an option, gives you a convenient, concealed space (camera and gadget bag fit neatly) to stow valuables safely out of view while traveling.

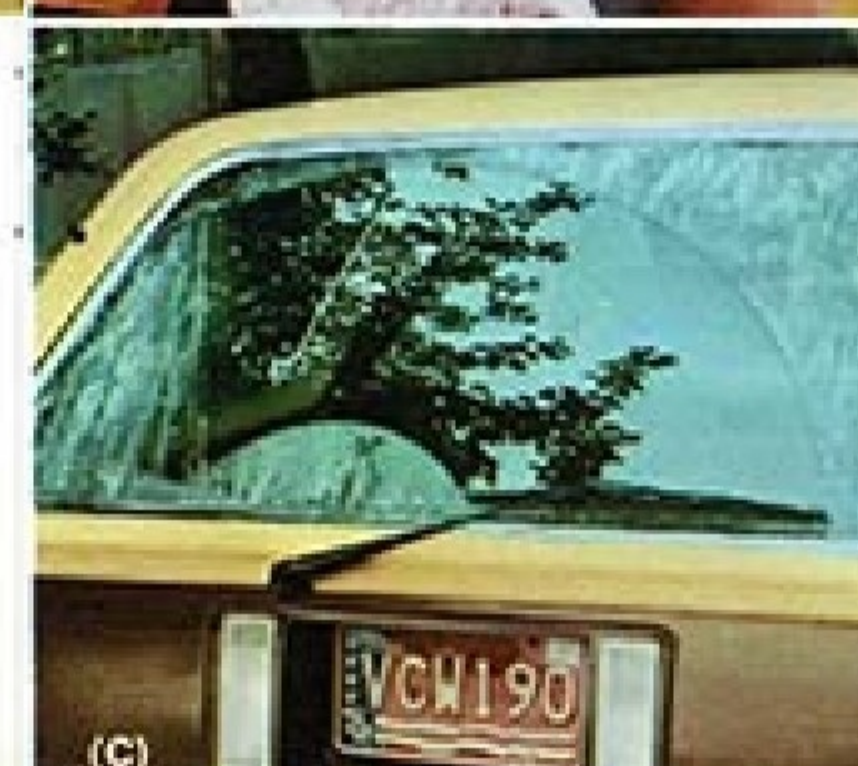

Pinto Wagon... A new design...inside and out.

For 1979, Pinto features a striking new front grille with integral parking lamps. Single rectangular headlamps. Stylish new hood and fenders plus the new bumpers with black end sections. Inside, there's a brand-new instrument panel cluster. And Pinto is roomy. Roomy enough to accommodate four adults, plus 887¹/₂ (31.3 cu. ft.) of cargo, with the rear seat up. Or two adults and 1 620¹/₂ (57.2 cu. ft.) of cargo

with the rear seat folded down. Pinto has 2.3 litre overhead cam 4-cylinder engine and a 4-speed manual floor-mounted transmission. It also has rack and pinion steering and 2 408 mm (94.8-inch) wheelbase so it handles easily, even in tight spots.

plication of corrosion resistant primer paint, also on the entire body
- aluminumized wax sprayed into hard-to-reach lower body areas, the inside surfaces of doors and quarter panels
- protective vinyl coating behind the wheel openings and along the lower bodyside area.

The DURAGUARD System is backed by a no-extra-charge 36-month unlimited distance manufacturer's warranty against corrosion perforation. This warranty, transferable to succeeding owners, covers the cost of both labour and materials for repair of perforation of parts caused

by corrosion. Exhaust system parts excluded. The basic 12 month/20,000 kilometre warranty covers corrosion, other than perforations, that are due to defective factory materials or workmanship. Ask your dealer for details.
