## Unmistakably Thunderbird.

A totally new expression of Thunderbird elegance, designed to satisfy the most discriminating buyer, is clearly apparent this year. Thunderbird for '77 has a new look, a new size and a new price that's thousands less than last year. But it's still unmistakably Thunderbird.

Thunderbird still has the things that make Thunderbird famous—the special luxury, the features, the appointments. They're all there. Its new suspension system and wide tread add new agility and sureness to the legendary quiet and comfort of the Thunderbird ride.

Note the distinctive effect achieved by the unique new Thunderbird wrapover roof when you combine Polar White (Code 5D) with the two-piece Red vinyl roof. Dual sport mirrors, dual accent paint stripes and wire wheel covers add tasteful dress-up touches. And that's only a start.

There's a whole new world of better idea amenities to help you tailor Thunderbird to your own requirements.

**New Size.** Thunderbird is leaner. About 10 inches shorter than it was a year ago. Even so, there's room to seat six passengers in incomparable Thunderbird comfort and luxury.

The trimness is a major factor in performance advantages. Combined with a shorter wheelbase, wide tread, steel-belted radials and rear stabilizer bar, you get a reassuring solid feel of the road. Thunderbird's agile in traffic, and easy to park.

**New Power.** A responsive 302 CID V-8 is standard. Or, you can add more spirit with optional 351 and 400 cubic-inch V-8's. Other standard features include power steering, power front disc brakes, and the smooth SelectShift automatic transmission. And there's a wide array of power options like: power windows - power door locks - power seats - and power moonroof, your window to the sky.

**New Look.** Under the new wrapover roof, we've added new visibility. With large coach windows. Smart new opera windows. Wide-sweeping front passenger windows. The unique roofline rides above a racy stretch of tautly sculptured metal, which runs from the traditional Thunderbird full-width taillights to a new chrome-plated grille. And it's topped with a hood ornament incorporating a contemporary Thunderbird insignia.

**New Interiors.** Thunderbird's tradition of luxurious interiors is enhanced by this year's new interior styling. Burled walnut woodtone appliques grace the instrument panel. There are inset instruments which feature European graphics. AM radio is standard. Deep-cushioned seats are available three ways: Bench (standard), split bench and bucket. (See pages 7, 8 and 9.)

It all adds up to a new Thunderbird classic. When America needs a better idea, Ford puts it on wheels.

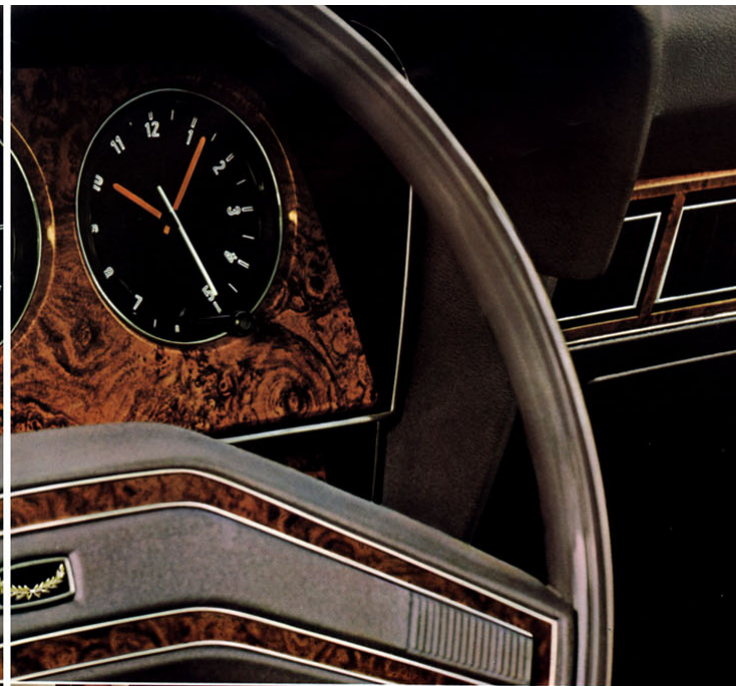

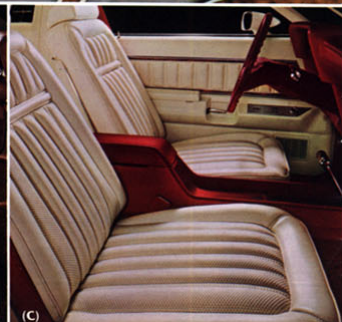
