


A TOUGH FRAME HELPS MAKE A TOUGH TRUCK

EASY RIDER SUSPENSION

F Series works hard ... and rides easy. The secret is in the Twin-I-Beam independent suspension*. Each forged I-Beam is matched to big coil springs to independently cushion the ride. Load-adjusting progressive rear leaf springs help keep the ride smooth ... with or without a load on board. And they help to absorb driving and breaking forces whilst controlling axle motion.






PUT YOURSELF IN THE COMFORT CAB

You also get a choice of transmissions on the F100 when fitted with the 4.9 litre V8 engine. Stick with the standard floor-mounted, four speed manual . . . or take the option of convenient 3 speed automatic transmission (available at extra cost).
