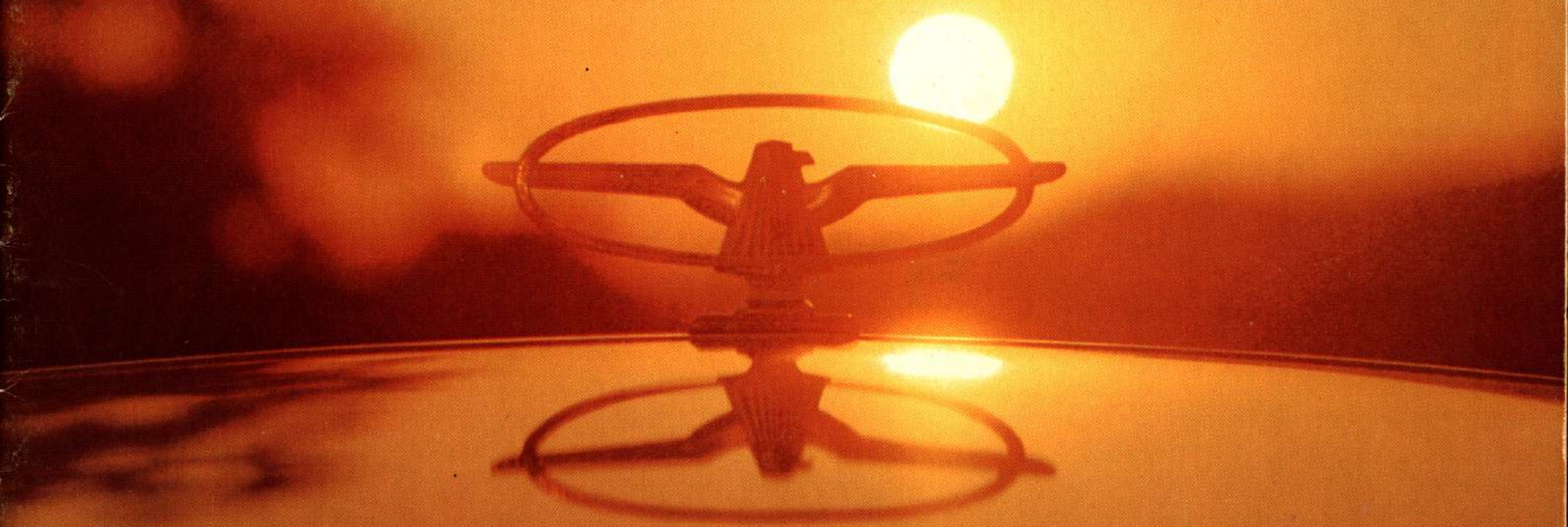

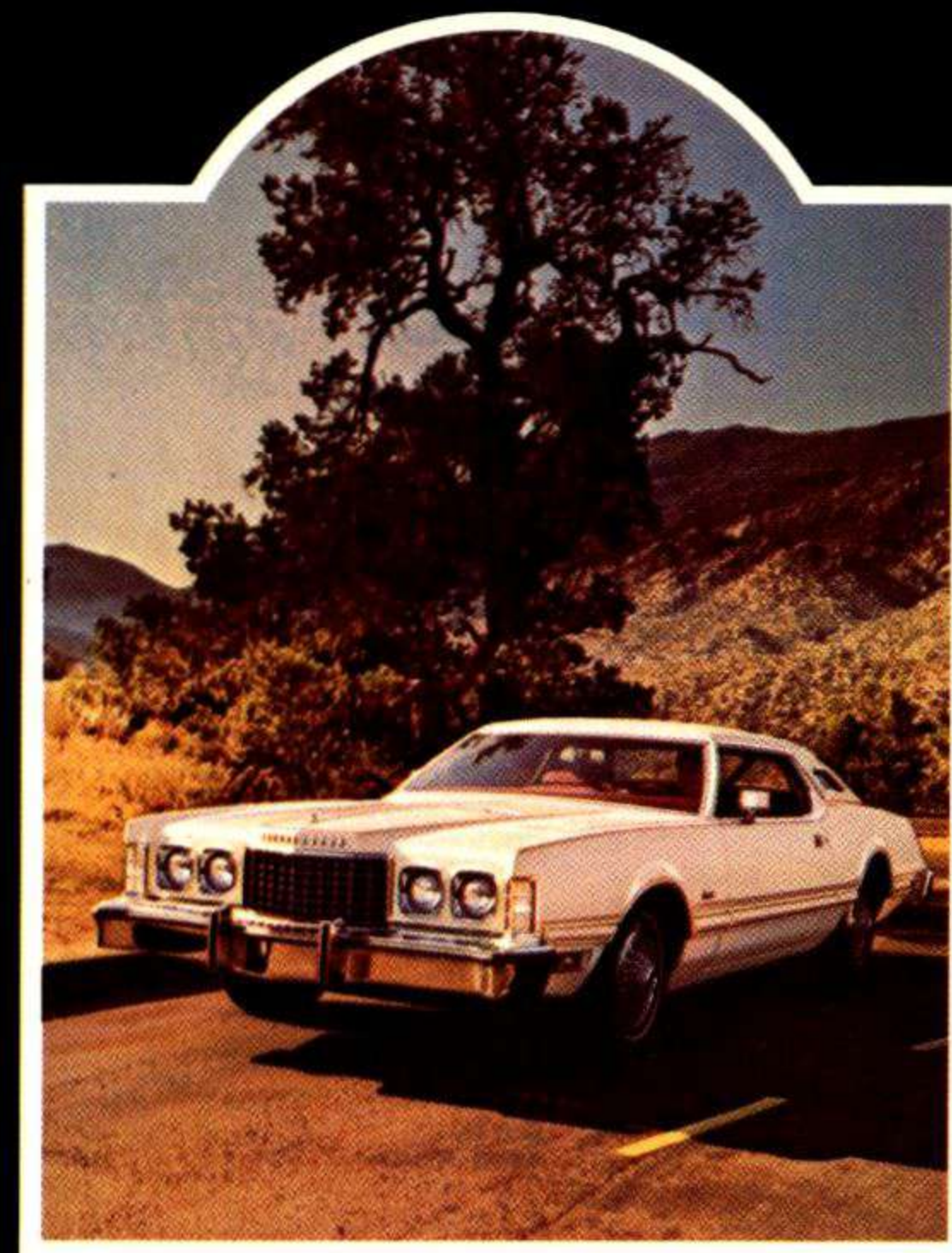

Thunderbird ride, in other words. Personal, luxurious driving. With advance-design roadabilities like a low center of gravity. Long wheelbase. Posi-ride rear suspension. Front and rear stabilizer bars.

Soundproofing puts thick insulation under the roof and hood, and in areas of the body . . . to keep noise outside. You also ride

on white sidewall steel-belted radial ply tires . . . which have been tested to give the average driver 40,000 miles of tread life under normal driving conditions.

A smooth-running 460-cu. in. 4V V-8, SelectShift transmission, power steering and power brakes put you in complete command. The 460 V-8's solid state ignition provides a strong spark for cold weather starting, good hydrocarbon emission control and reduced maintenance.

There's peace-of-mind thoughtfulness, too. Steel Guard Rails in side doors. Front outboard retractable lap/shoulder belts. Impact-absorbing Front and Rear Bumper Systems. See all Lifeguard Design Safety Features listed on page 13.

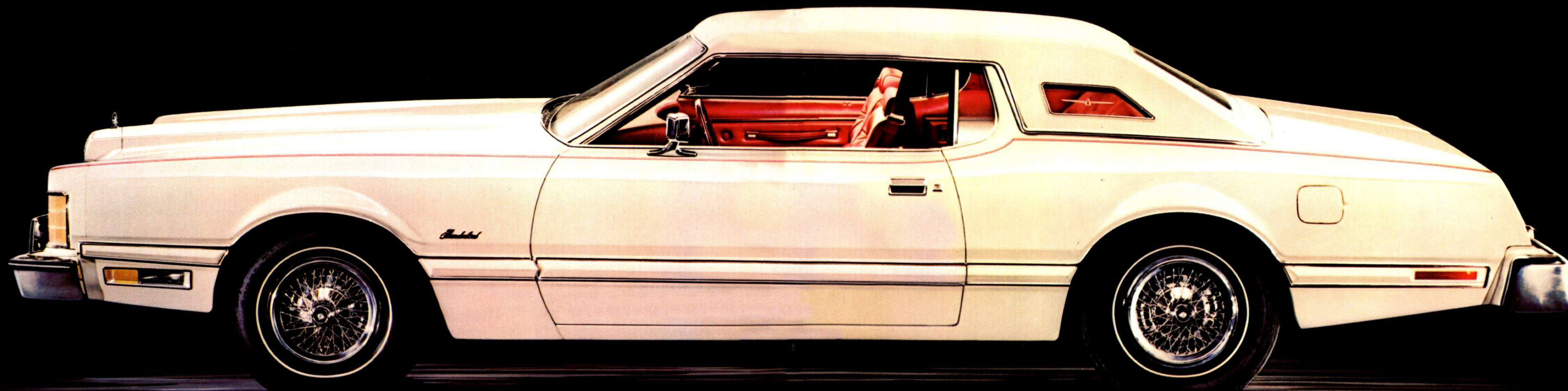

We consider this split bench front seat one of the most sumptuous in motordom. Foam cushioning cradles you in luxurious softness. Driver and passenger can adjust their respective seats to requirements. Each has his own fold-down center armrest. And an automatic seat back release is a Thunderbird basic feature.

The restful reclining passenger seat, a blessing on long trips, is optional. So is the superbly tailored Red upholstery—soft leather seating surfaces with supple vinyl trim. Black, Gold, Medium Blue, Medium Green, Saddle, Tan or White are other leather-trim colors available. Lustrous Aurora Cloth and vinyl trim, in six decorator colors, is standard. 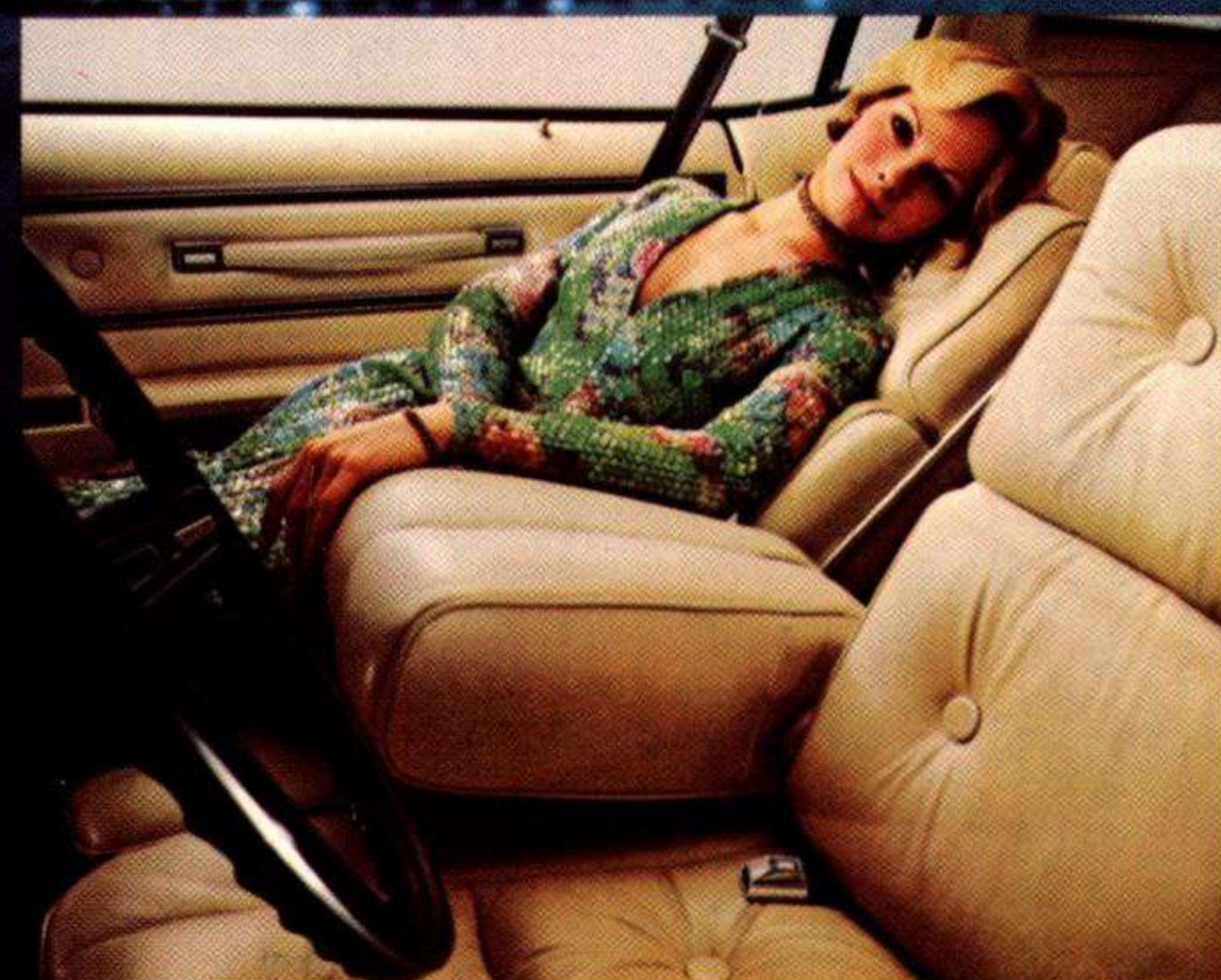

Turnpike Group. Makes driving more pleasurable. Manual reclining passenger seat—adjusts to angle up to maximum 35°. Includes fingertip speed control—lets you drive (foot off accelerator) at any cruising preset speed above 30 mph. Simple rocker switch controls on steering wheel let you turn system off or on and even accelerate or coast. Touching brake also disengages system. Steady speeds save fuel. Trip odometer rounds out Group.



Power-Operated Sunroof. Touch a switch for a window to the heavens. Touch again—it closes snugly. **Power-Operated Glass Moonroof.** New one-way glass version. See page 9.



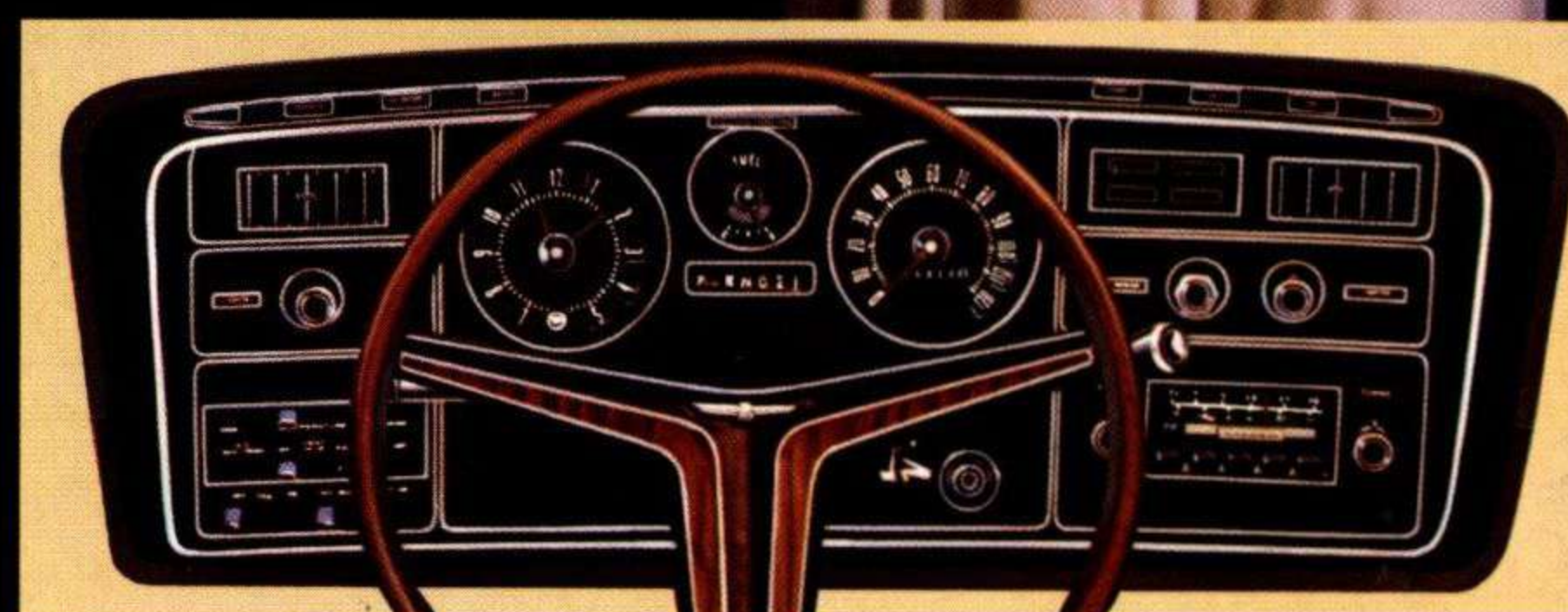
Quick Defrost Windshield / Rear Window. New Gold film, laminated in glass, quickly helps melt snow and ice. **Electric Rear Window De-icer** uses fine heating elements to help clear rear window.



Power Mini-vent Windows. Push-button operated, front window vents open as far as you wish for virtually quiet, draft-free air circulation.

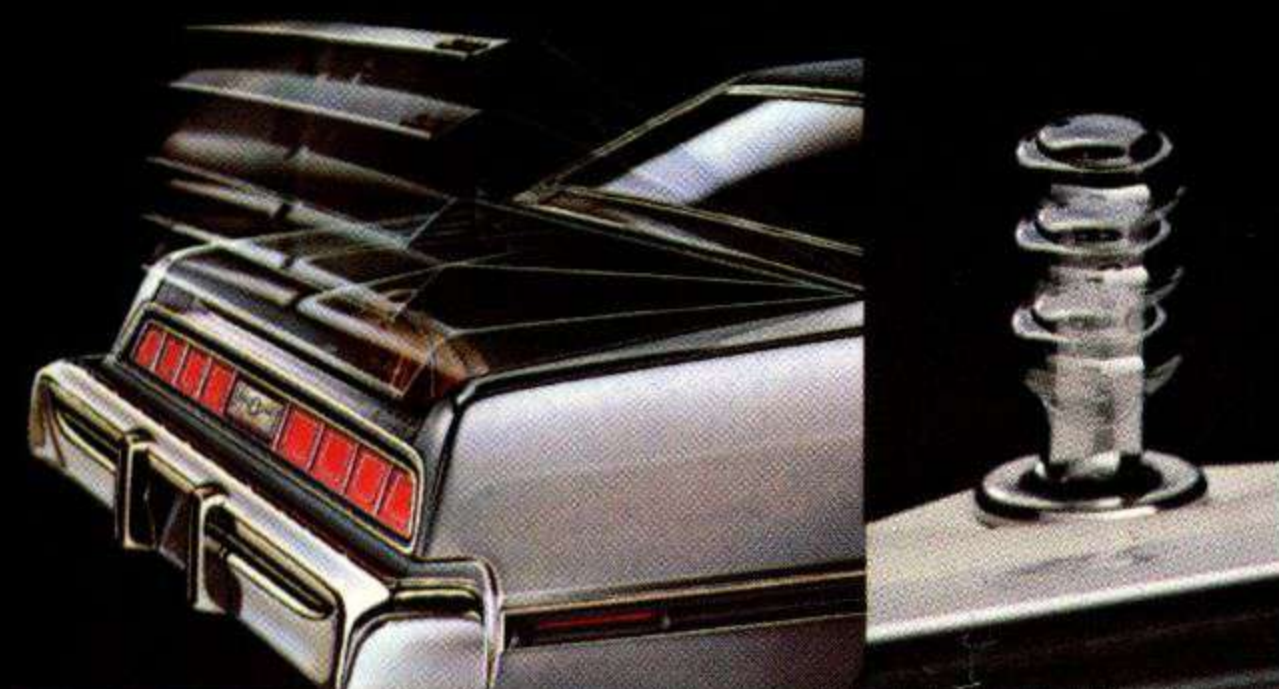


Light Group. Many assists. Dual overhead map lights focus high-intensity beam to ease map reading for navigation. Illuminated Visor Vanity Mirror—luxury for the lady. Warning lights for headlamps on, low fuel and door "ajar," plus a warning buzzer for alert when headlamp switch is left on. New Autolamp System, also included, is detailed in 3-sequence picture below.

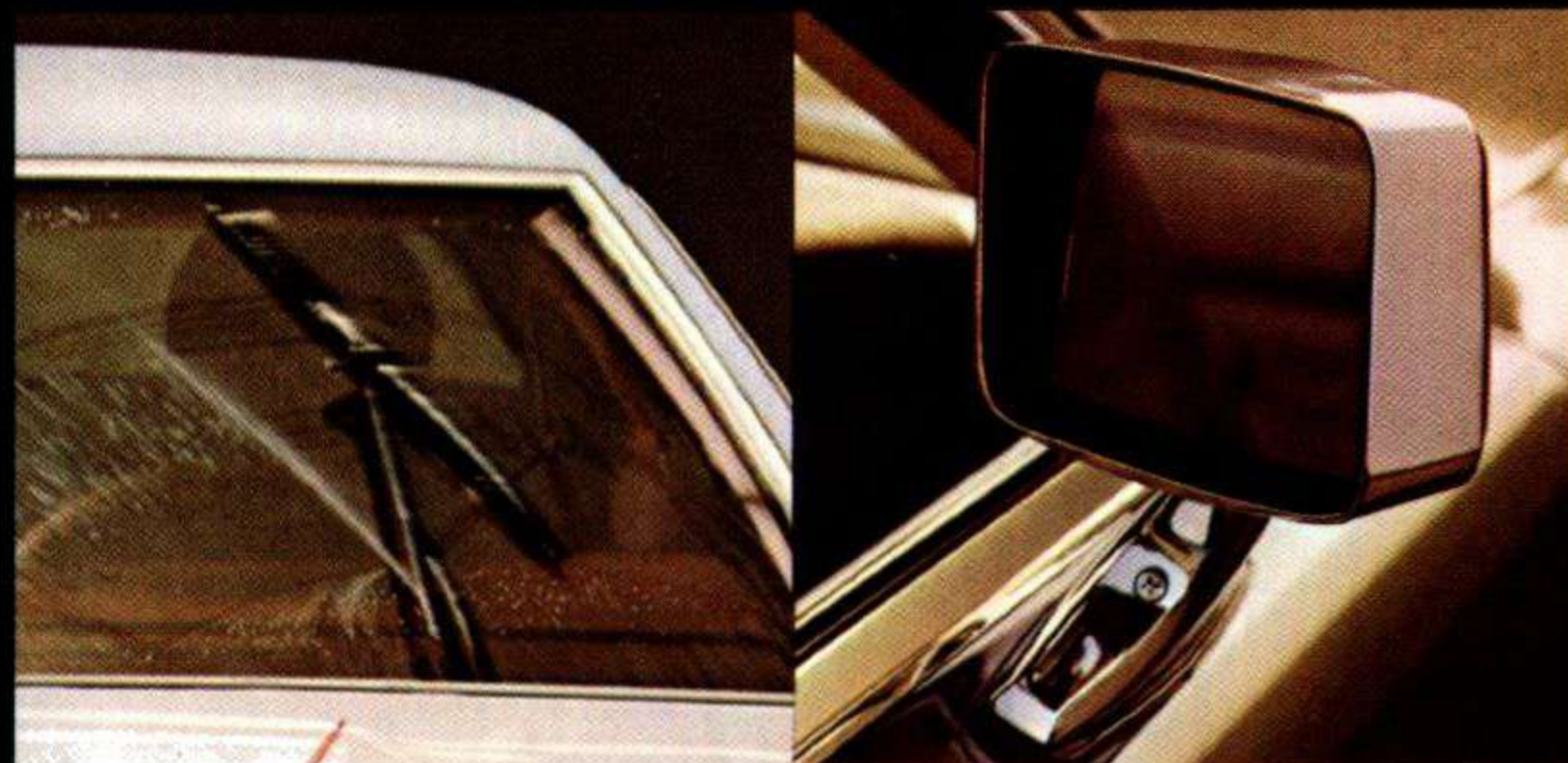


Thunderbird sound systems, each with four speakers, to surround you with rich, concert-quality sound. AM/FM stereo, or AM/FM stereo radio with tape player—which lets you play your own favorite selections for uninterrupted listening pleasure. **Power Antenna.** Handy switch lets you raise and lower from inside car.

Automatic Temperature Control. Available for standard SelectAir Conditioner. Lets you set climate you prefer for year-round control.



Power Lock Group. Features electric power door locks with master control, and electric trunk lid release actuated by switch inside glove compartment. A real convenience on rainy days.



Convenience Group. Two handy items. Remote control right-hand mirror, adjustable from driver's seat. And interval windshield wipers which let you regulate pause between sweeps from 2 to 10 seconds to handle road splatter, light rainfall, for best visibility.



New Autolamp On/Off Delay System. Included with the Light Group detailed above, automatically turns driving lights on or off

in response to light conditions. The Autolamp System also lets you leave headlamps on for up to 90 seconds so they will help light

your path away from the car. Delay period can be adjusted for 30, 60 or 90 seconds. Headlamps turn off automatically.

Add as you wish. Thunderbird variations are endless.

Power Antenna. Adjusts from inside car.

Anti-theft Group. Electronic theft-deterrent system sounds horn when Thunderbird security is violated. Includes lockable hood latch and decals.

Dual Bodyside/Hood Paint Stripes. Dual stripes follow upper bodyside contour and hood accent sculpture line. Shown here in White.

Color-Keyed Wheel Covers. A nice styling touch with Glamour Paints.

Exterior: Blue Starfire (Code 3P) with Blue Odense grain vinyl roof. **Interior:** White leather seating surface with vinyl trim (Code KQ).

Deluxe Bumper Group. Includes front and rear bumper rub strips with white styling pin stripe, and rear bumper guards. Front bumper guards standard.

Exterior Decor Group. Protective wide bodyside molding with padded Odense grain vinyl inserts color-keyed to standard vinyl roof. Front cornering lamps and partial wheel lip moldings are included.

Space Saver Spare Tire. Makes more luggage compartment room available. Includes collapsible spare tire, wheel, and pressurized inflating canister.



Trailer Towing Package, Class III. Quiet, even-keel Thunderbird ride makes it a natural for trailering. Package includes heavy-duty suspension, optional axle ratio, heavy-duty cooling with constant-full radiator, heavy-duty alternator, wiring harness and towing decal. Lets you tow trailers up to 6000-lb. GTW with a tongue load up to 700-lb.

Smooth, Quiet Ride: Full Coil Suspension with Front and Rear Stabilizer Bars — smooth, road-gripping stability plus extra-large shock absorbers. • Strong Body/Frame Construction — closed box-section members give Thunderbird one of the strongest frames in luxury car class • Extensive Soundproofing — thick insulating layers of fiberglass and other materials shield against road noise.

Safe Driving/Peace-of-mind: Front Outboard Retractable Lap/Shoulder Belts • Remote Control Left-Hand Mirror—adjusts inside the car • Front Bumper Guards with rubber inserts • Inside Hood Release • Spare Tire Lock — deters theft • Plus all Ford Motor Company Lifeguard Design Safety Features at right.

Performance/Handling: 460-cu. in. 4V V8, which runs on regular gas • Solid State Ignition — better starting, longer plug life, reduced maintenance and better emission control • Power Front Disc Brakes — use same concept jet planes use for straight, fade-resistant stops • SelectShift Cruise-O-Matic Transmission — smooth power flow, can be shifted automatically or manually • White Sidewall Steel-Belted Radial Ply Tires.

Appearance: Opera Windows • Odense Vinyl Roof in nine colors • Simulated Woodtone Accents • Deluxe Seat Belts • Full Wheel Covers • Unique Thunderbird Identification including Hood Ornament • Bright Moldings at rear hood edge, door belts, drip rails and vinyl insert bodyside and wheel lip moldings.

Economy/Durability: 61-amp. Alternator — maintains battery charge even at low engine speeds. Automatic Parking Brake Release — prevents premature lining wear • Service-Saving Features like: extended periods of operation between major chassis lubrications, oil changes, and oil filter changes. Details are contained within the Owner's Manual. Other economy features include: self-adjusting brakes, 2-year engine coolant-antifreeze, long-life Motorcraft Sta-Ful battery, corrosion-resistant aluminized muffler, zinc-coated underbody parts, use of regular gas.*

Solid State Ignition

Easy starting's made even easier. And quick, thanks to new Solid State Ignition—standard with the 460-cu. in. 4V V-8.

It replaces conventional ignition parts like points, cam and condenser with highly reliable, low-maintenance electric components. Results? A stronger spark for quick starting. And reduced service maintenance.

You'll enjoy more dependable cold weather starting. It also helps eliminate many major causes of engine misfiring so emissions will be reduced.

Front Outboard Retractable Lap/Shoulder Belts

The new 3-point restraint system for front outboard passengers features integral lap belts and shoulder harnesses joined at a tongue. To secure the belts, you insert the tongue into a buckle.

Lap belts extend from retractors that automatically lock when the lap belt is being worn, so belts won't be pulled out farther. Yet they allow belts to retract to keep a snug fit for optimum safety.

The harness webbing has one end also fixed in a retractor. This webbing passes through a guide above the shoulder so it will attach properly when hooked into the lap belt connector. You can bend. Stretch. Reach into the glove box except during deceleration. That automatically locks for restraint by a mechanically actuated inertia sensor.
