three exceptional ways to express your individuality. It features a brand-new town-car type roofline . . . giving a greater feeling of privacy and noticeable increase in headroom. Four-Door Landau and Two-Door Hardtop are two other impressive versions.

Special Brougham Option exterior features you see here include: color-keyed wheel covers, bodyside moldings with protective color-keyed vinyl inserts, color-keyed stone shields and grille panels (not visible in the view illustrated) and H78 x 15 belted dual-band white sidewall tires. The *single-band* white sidewall tires illustrated are optional Michelin steel-belted radials. They're available alone, or as part of an all-new Turnpike Convenience Group which also gives you Fingertip Speed Control and manual reclining passenger seat.

Special Brougham Option, available on Two-Door models, features both distinguished interior appointments and comfort (front seat shown on the facing page, rear seat illustrated in (A) at right) and unique exterior decor (shown below and on page 2). 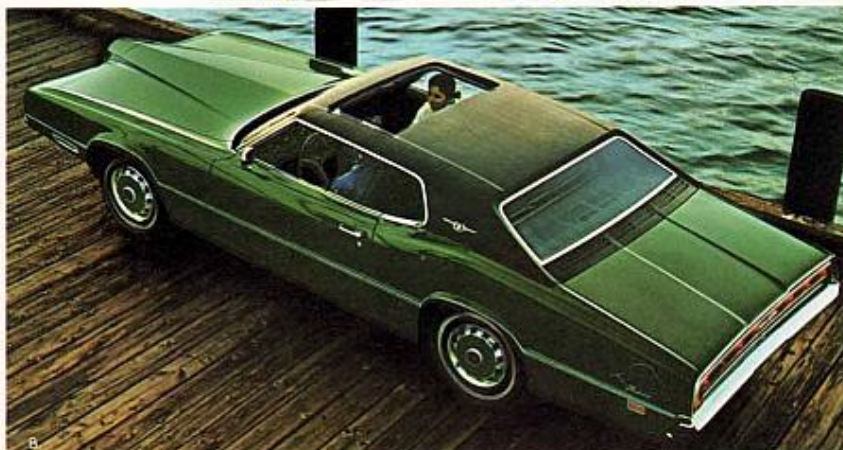

bench seat with individual center armrests. High seat backs eliminate need for separate headrests. Deeply padded, molded foam backs are contoured for firm, comfortable support. Driver and front passenger seats are individually adjustable. 6-Way Power adjustment and Manual Reclining Passenger Seat options also are available. Reclining Seat, especially welcome by co-pilots on long trips, tilts back to any desired position to a maximum 35° adjustment.

Turnpike Convenience Group, new optional feature (below) that has your comfort in mind. It includes: Automatic Fingertip Speed Control (A), which lets you cruise (with your foot off the accelerator) at any preset speed above 30 mph. It

pays off in reduced fatigue especially on long trips. Simple rocker switch controls on the steering wheel let you turn the system on or off, set speeds and even accelerate or coast without touching the floor accelerator; Michelin single-band, white sidewall, steel-belted radial ply tires (B); and Manual Reclining Passenger Seat (C).

Exterior Appearance Group, another new option (shown on Four-Door Landau opposite), features color-keyed wheel covers, stone shields and grille panels, bodyside moldings with protective color-keyed vinyl insert and wheel lip moldings.

Two-Door version, low-back bench (facing page) comes in black, dark red, dark blue, light gray gold, medium ginger, dark green. Vinyl with soft leather seating surfaces, plus High Back Bucket Seats, is available in black, dark red and medium ginger.

On the Four-Door Landau, Brougham interior cloth and vinyl comes in black, dark red, dark blue, dark green, light gray gold and dark tobacco. Vinyl and leather trim comes in black, dark red and tobacco. On each version High Back Split Bench Seat option (page 8) is required.

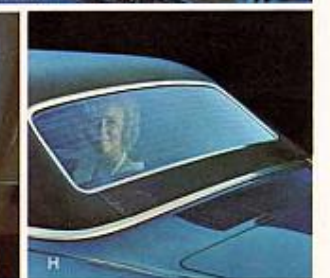
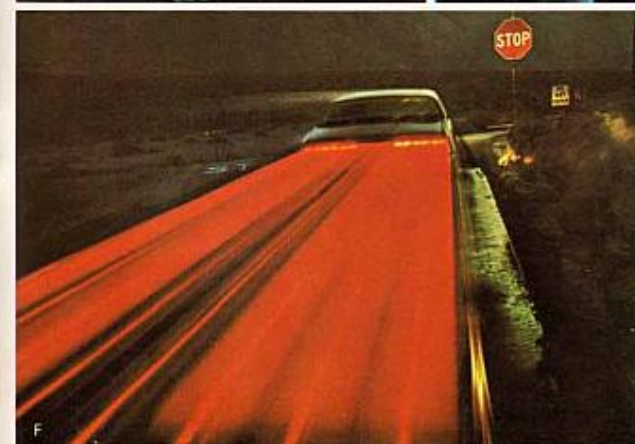

New Thunderbirds are designed to go 6,000 miles (or 6 months) between oil changes and minor lubrications; 36,000 miles (or 3 years, whichever comes first) between major chassis lube. Other '71 Thunderbird service-savers include: 24-month engine coolant-antifreeze, self-adjusting brakes, long-life Sta-Ful battery, shielded alternator, rust- and corrosion-resistant aluminized mufflers and galvanized underbody parts. The '71 Thunderbird needs so little service it's just good sense to see that it gets the best—at your Ford Dealer's. His factory-trained mechanics and special tools add up to the greatest service combination available for your Thunderbird.

NOTE: Your new 1971 Thunderbird comes equipped with factory engineered and approved parts, such as the dependable Autolite Sta-Ful battery, Autolite Power-Tip spark plugs, Autolite shock absorbers, and an Autolite 6000-mile oil filter.
