Considering the comprehensive specification of the Scorpio and the Scorpio 4x4, further refinements might appear superfluous. There are, however, one or two specialised items which some owners may wish to add. The Scorpio Executive and the Scorpio 4x4 Executive are designed to meet their particular needs.

Both of the Scorpio Executive models provide the opulence and comfort of leather trim, together with the convenience of Cruise Control and the high security of an Anti-theft Alarm. In addition, the Scorpio Executive is fitted with distinctive 15" aluminium alloy wheels and wide 195/65HR tyres, giving an extra edge to the road holding and even better looks. The Scorpio 4x4 Executive features the wide, spoked alloy wheels and low profile 205/60 VR 15 tyres which are a feature of the Scorpio 4x4.

Settling into the welcoming embrace of a leather driving seat is rather like sinking into your favourite armchair. The main difference is that you probably spend far more time in your car than you do relaxing at home! Your passengers will appreciate being able to share this pleasure. Along with the driver, the front seat passenger can alter the rake of his seat, and adjust the thigh support, side bolster cushions and pneumatic lumbar pad. (With leather trim these adjustments are manual and heating elements cannot be fitted.) The rear seats feature integral head restraints, a central armrest and power adjustment of the 60:40 split-fold seat-back.

Cruise Control is a simple and relaxing means of maintaining a steady pace when travelling on motorways or major trunk roads. At the appropriate speed, Cruise Control is selected to regulate the accelerator setting, which will then remain constant. The concept is highly effective, particularly on long journeys, and also perfectly safe, since braking or accelerating instantly overrides the setting. When accelerating, the system remains active — that is, when you take your foot off, the Cruise Control reverts to its pre-set speed.

The standard Scorpio models already feature the most advanced high security lock system currently available. Executive versions boost vehicle security to an even greater level by adding an Anti-theft Alarm. With characteristic Ford efficiency, the alarm switches on automatically when the driver's door is locked, and gives audible confirmation

that it is primed.

Even greater luxury, enhanced convenience and security. These are the benefits that distinguish the two Scorpio Executive models from the standard versions.
