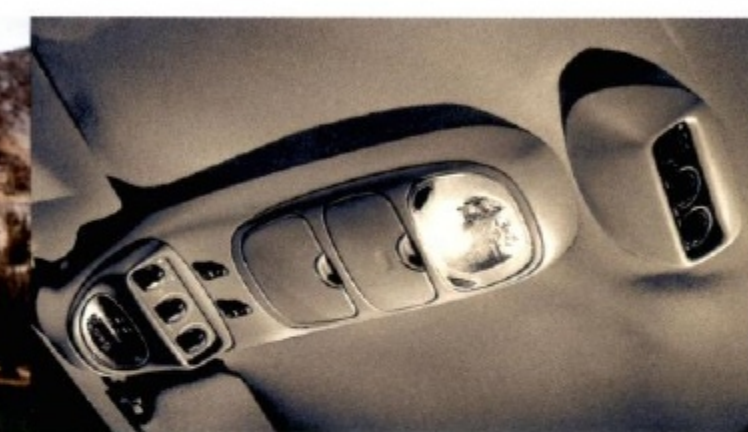

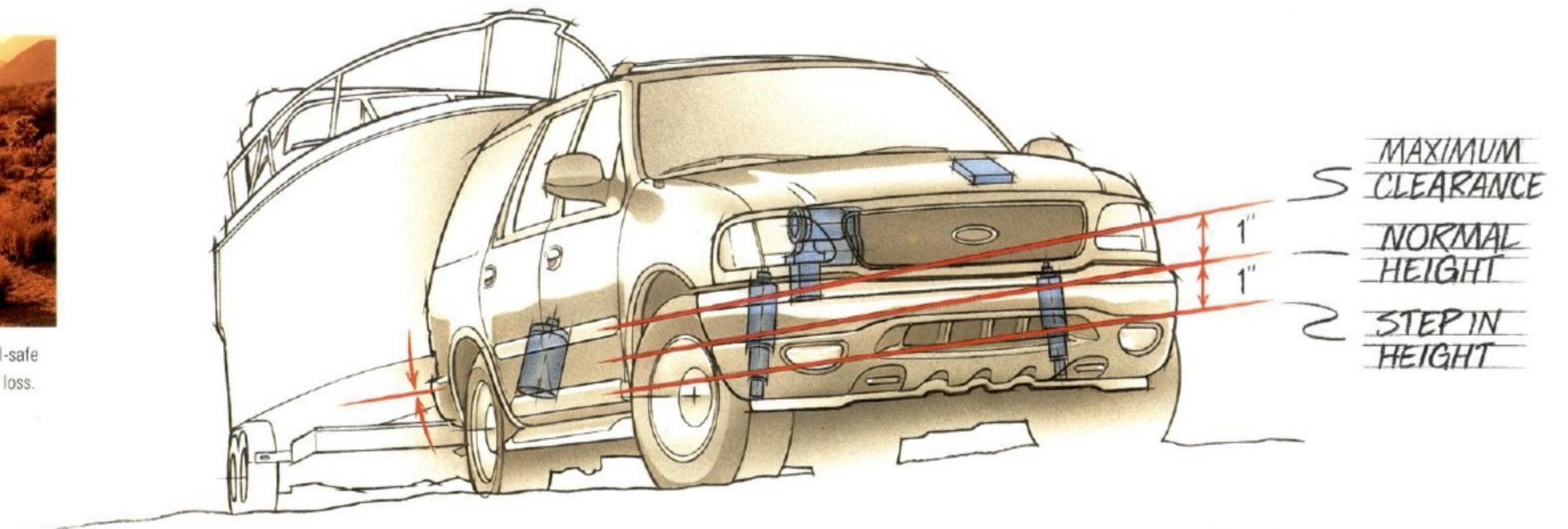

Expedition can also be equipped (standard in the 4x4 models) with Control-Trac, a computer-controlled traction system, which provides 4-wheel traction capability in all weather conditions. Expedition also allows for 100,000-mile tune-up intervals* and has increased horsepower and torque.

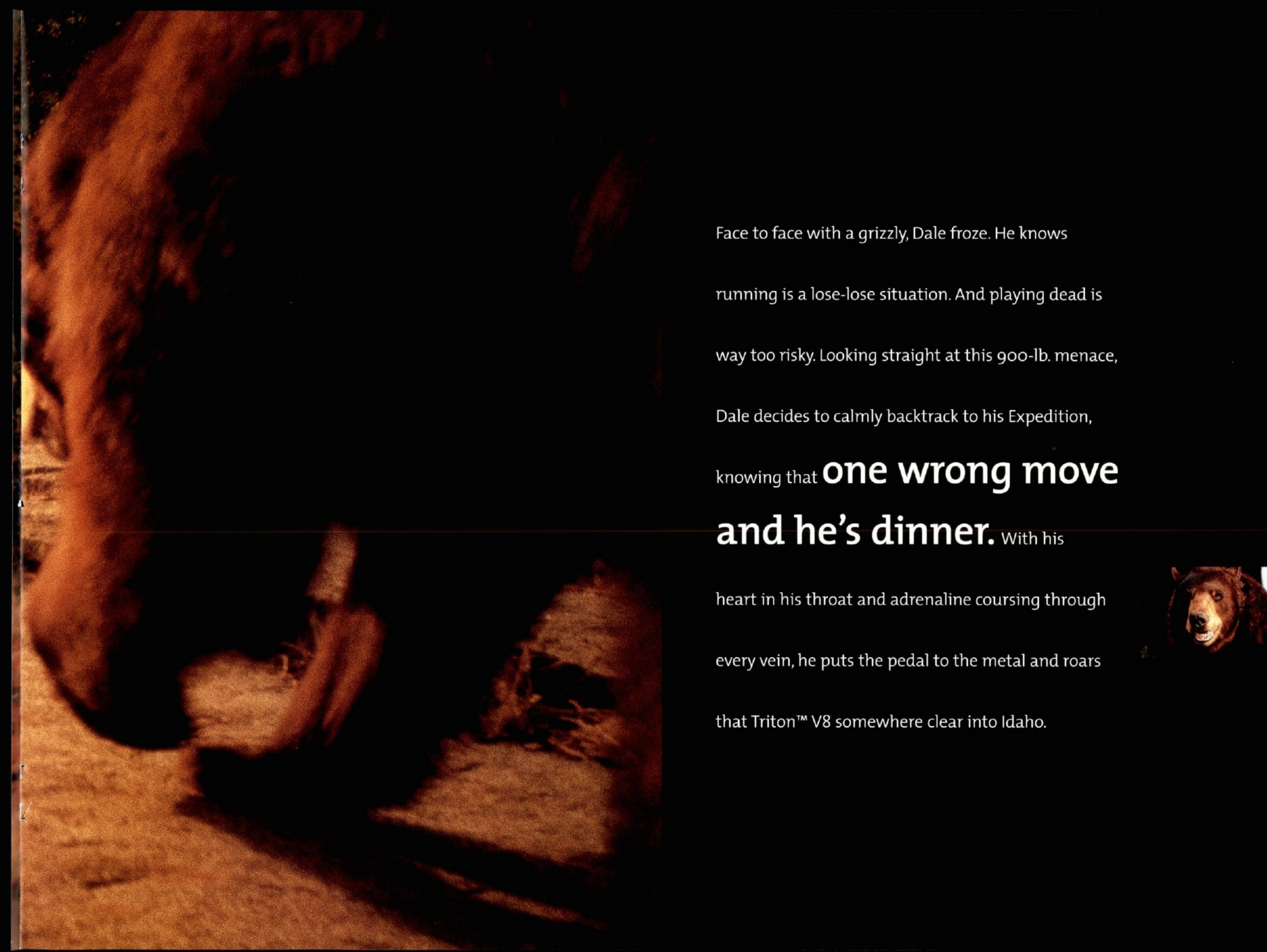
