Valiant Duster Small enough but big enough. Here comes Duster.

Duster. A brand-new Plymouth. A whirlwind out to prove that a compact car can deliver handsome styling and big performance in a hardy sporty package.

Duster. A new sporty look in compacts. Sporty from the thrust of the distinctive new grille to the smooth sweep of the curved sides setting off the ventless windows. And the swept back roof line blends into a short rear

deck with a unique "Duster" emblem in back.

As for power, Duster starts off fast with a new 198 cubic inch Six. The 225 Six is optional. Or order the standard 318 V-8 if you go for the V-8 model. And if you really crave all-out performance, you can order the red hot Duster 340 with wide tread tires, disc brakes and special sports striping, shown in upper right hand corner.

Also new for '70: A fully-synchronized, 3-speed, column-shift, manual transmission, standard with the 318 V-8. (The floor-shift version is optional at extra cost for 318 and six-cylinder Dusters; standard on Duster 340.)

Knees under chins don't make it. Extra leg room makes it. Duster makes it. Extra head room makes it. Duster makes it. Under that sporty exterior

Duster has room for five. A real rear seat—for adults. Extra knee room. Head room. Elbow room. Duster makes it very roomy.


Now to the outside. Another Duster bonus: 188.4 inch overall length, 108 inch wheelbase. Makes handling very nimble. Makes parking a breeze. Duster makes it very compact.

Spotty interiors and a dash of luxury make it. Duster makes it.

Duster spices up an already very comfortable interior with some very tasty touches. Full length, optional color-keyed deep loop carpeting. And a choice of 5 different seating arrangements: from the standard vinyl bench seats, to the optional cloth-and-vinyl bench, all-vinyl split bench with fold-down center armrest, all-vinyl split-back bench and the all-vinyl bucket seats.

In addition, Duster has a new ignition switch on the steering column. It locks the engine, transmission and steering wheel when you remove the key.


Duster also has a new Lane Change Signal Device. (A slight pressure on the end of the turn signal tells other drivers you're going to switch lanes on the highway.) And a new optional steering wheel with the horn activator mounted in the rim.

And new standard features like the Lane Change Turn Signal. (Touch the turn signal lever and tell drivers behind you you're going to change lanes.)

And a new optional Steering Wheel with rim-mounted horn activator. (Just squeeze the wheel to sound the horn.)

Power? Choose our new, standard economy engine, the 198 cubic inch Six. Or the 318 V-8, standard on the V-8 model. There's also an optional mid-power engine, the 225 cu. in. Six.

And a new 3-speed transmission, synchronized in all forward gears. It comes standard with column-mounted shift in the 318 V-8 model.

Naturally, the choice extends to interior options, too. So, if you're after a compact price and compact sensibility, go to it. Go Valiant.

Automatic transmission in a console makes it. Optional. Torqueflite automatic transmission. Three speeds smooth. Shift for yourself, or let it do the work. Make it even handier and order the optional center console with storage compartment.



Deluxe Wheel Covers make it. Stainless steel for that look of luxury. 14 inches. Shown here with C78 x 14 whitewall tires. Also available with all eight other Valiant/Duster tires as described under "Rallye Wheels."



Deluxe steering wheels make it. Three spokes with partial horn ring. Spokes padded with foam, and covered with special-grained butyrate. For a luxury look that really makes it.



Power you don't need makes it. Standard in the 6-cylinder Duster and Valiant is our new 198 cu. in. Six. For more authority, take our standard 318 cu. in. V-8 for V-8 models. Or optional 225 cu. in. Six. The 340 V-8 is strictly for the Duster 340. (What else?)



Three-on-the-floor makes it. New for '70. A three-speed fully synchronized manual transmission. Standard on the column with the 318 V-8. Optional on the floor with any Duster engine. (Standard on Duster 340.)




Tachometers make it. Seen in the best circles. For the serious driver who likes to know what's going on all the time. The dial reads from 0-6000 rpm. And reads fast.



Air certainly makes it. Chrysler Airtemp air conditioning. Go dust-free, pollen-free and untroubled by hot weather. (Not available with 198 cu. in. Six.)



Keeping your eye on the road makes it. Fender-mounted turn indicators. Right out from the top of the fender. Where you can see them, and where your eyes off the road. In addition, Valiant light packages also include trunk and glove box lights, ignition switch with time-delay light, and ashtray, map and courtesy lights.



In this case, hindsight makes it. Our outside rear-view mirror. Controlled from inside the car. No rolling down the window in the rain to adjust it. The mirror is recessed for protection against the elements.



Guarding against dings makes it. Rubber insert bumper guards, front and rear. Because your fellow man is prone to err.



Stopping on a disc makes it. Standard Valiant brakes are the bonded-lining type. But if you order the trailer-towing package or want the ultimate in stopping efficiency, consider optional disc brakes. Standard on Duster 340.



Hot Rallye Wheels make it. Mag-style. Painted silver. With stainless-steel trim rings. Chrome-plated center. And chrome wheel nuts. Shown here on optional E70 x 14 fiberglass-belted tires. Other tires available in black or whitewalls are: 6.95 x 14, or the C78 x 14, optional D78 x 14 or the optional E70 x 14 (E70 x 14 blackwall standard on Duster 340).



Sporty Wire Wheel Covers make it. With raised chrome-plated center. 14 inches. Available with E70 x 14 or D78 x 14 tires.



Keeping your ear to the sound makes it. AM radio. Push-button selector. Lots of transistors. Big extra feature. Small extra price.


