Dual reclining front bucket seats in cashmere or black are standard on both Champs illustrated on page 4. The Custom model comes with cloth-and-vinyl seats; while our Champ Hatchback comes standard with all-vinyl version.

With a back seat big enough to accommodate passengers and packages. With carpeting—even in the Custom model's hatch area.

And the hatch is where the Champ really carries on. With the seat up, 6.5 cu. ft. With the seat down, 27.4 cu. ft. Stow away! Champ makes it easy with a folding rear seat with one-touch release.

And to keep valuables out of sight, there's a rear shelf security panel, in the Premium and Custom models.

One thing you won't keep out of sight is the good looks of the Champ Custom. Not with exterior highlights

like body-side tape stripes and bright trim around the windows. Plus steel-belted white sidewall tires. Powered by a 1.6-litre MCA-Jet engine.\*

The 1.4-litre engine provides the power for our easy-to-own Champ Hatchback. 
# THE MAKING OF A CHAMP.



**Front-wheel drive** sends power directly to the front wheels. You're essentially pulled rather than pushed through curves and corners. You'll also appreciate front-wheel drive in the snow or on wet, slippery roads. The Champ knows how to handle itself.



**Rack-and-pinion steering** offers a responsive, precise system not found on most American-made cars. Rack-and-pinion steering is demanded by serious sports-car drivers. Like those on the Grand Prix circuit, who need good handling. Rock up another plus for the Champ.



**Dual diagonal braking system** helps provide Champ with straight-line stopping power. Dual diagonal braking provides two separate systems for opposing front and rear wheels. In addition, power front disc brakes are standard.




**Instrumentation and controls** help make Champ your command performer. There are slide switches for headlights and wipers. Plus a trip odometer, and the added security of an inside hood release. **MCA (Mitsubishi Clean Air-Jet Engine System** gives you fuel efficiency. How? The extra jet valve injects an additional amount of air to create an extra-lean, swirling mixture of fuel and air into the combustion chamber for more even and complete combustion.




